NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees have split the first two games of their three-game set vs. the Mets.
 - Are 34-14 at Yankee Stadium this season, including 29-9 since 4/21.
 - Are a Major League-best 24-6 (.800) when they face a left-handed starter in 2018...are 12-1 in games vs. left-handed starting pitchers since 5/25.
 - Are 29G over .500, 1G shy of their season high (30G over .500 twice, at 61-31 on 7/12 and 62-32 on 7/14).
 - Are 10-7 in Interleague play this season.
- **RHP Sonny Gray** (5.1IP, 3H, 3R/2ER, 3BB, 6K, 1HR, 1HP) started and earned his seventh win of the season...has won back-to-back starts for the first time this season.
 - Is 2-0 with a 1.59 ERA (11.1IP, 2ER) in his last two starts.
 - Has won both career starts vs. the Mets, posting a 3.18 ERA (11.1IP, 4ER).
- **RF Aaron Judge** (3-for-4, 1HR, 1 double, 1RBI) has recorded at least 3H in back-to-back games for the second time of his career (also 6/10-11/17)...hit his 26th home run of the season on a solo shot in the seventh...was his 82nd home run in his 276th career game, trailing Ryan Howard (257G) for fastest to reach the mark (in terms of games played) in Baseball history.
 - Is hitting .371 (65-for-175) with 44R, 13 doubles, 18HR, 44RBI and 40BB in 48 home games this season.
- **3B Miguel Andújar** (3-for-4, 3R, 2 doubles, 1RBI) has 45 extra-base hits in 91 career games, the fourth-most by Yankee through 91 career games (Joe DiMaggio-63XH, Bob Meusel-52XBH, Gary Sánchez-46).
 - Has hit safely in 14-of-16 games this month.
- **C Austin Romine** (1-for-4, 2RBI) hit an RBI single in the fourth...is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with 3 doubles, 2HR, 20RBI and 4BB with RISP this season.
- **LF Giancarlo Stanton** (1-for-4, 1R) is batting .359 (42-for-117) with 17R, 7 doubles, 7HR, 20RBI and 10BB in his last 29 games to raise his season BA from .241 to .278, highest since 4/1 (.286).
 - Is hitting .365/.422/.750 (35-for-96) with 5 doubles, 1 triple and 10HR vs. left-handed pitchers this season.
- **Yankees hitters** are batting .330/.391/.585 with RISP in their last 10 games (since 7/9).
- **SS Didi Gregorius** hit an RBI triple in the fourth...is batting .412 (14-for-34) with 8R, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR and 7RBI in his last nine games (since 7/9-G2) to raise his season BA from .252 to .268, his highest since 5/12 (.268)...during this span has struck out just once in 37PA.
- **1B Greg Bird** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 2RBI) is 8-for-14 (.571) with 2 doubles, 2HR, and 15RBI with RISP since 6/26.
 - Of his 33 hits this season, 18 have gone for extra bases (9 doubles, 2HR, 8HR).
 - Has 14RBI in his last nine games.
- **RHP Jonathan Holder** tossed a perfect seventh inning (1K)...has allowed only 2ER in 38.1IP (19H, 5R/2ER, 5BB/1IBB, 32K, 0HR, 1HP) over 32 appearances since being recalled from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on 4/21.
- **LHP Chasen Shreve** (1.0IP) earned his first save of the season after entering the game with the bases loaded and no outs.
- Today marked the Yankees' 17th home sellout in 48 gates in 2018, the second-most sellouts in a season at the current Yankee Stadium (20 in 2011)...have 10 sellouts in their last 13 gates since 6/16.

NEW YORK METS NOTES

- The Mets fell to 2-3 in the Subway Series and 1-1 at Yankee Stadium this season...are now 15-35 in their last 50 games...are 5-9 in Interleague play this season...are now 10-15 all-time at the current Yankee Stadium and 2-5 in their last seven games in the Bronx (since 4/26/15).
 - Are 2-29 when allowing six-or-more runs this season.
 - Are now 16-10 when scoring six-or-more runs this season.
- **Mets pitchers** allowed their first home run since the eighth inning on 7/14 vs. Washington...Judge's home run in the seventh snapped a team streak of 25.0IP without allowing a home run.

- **LHP Steven Matz** (5.0IP, 9H, 5ER, 1BB, 3K) has lost three consecutive starts with a 4.58 ERA (17.2IP, 9ER) over the stretch...had his streak of four starts (since 6/26) of allowing 3R-or-fewer snapped today...allowed a season-high 9H, the most hits allowed since 7/26/17 (also 9H)...suffered his eighth loss of the season, which ties a career high (went 9-8 in 2016).
 - In nine road starts this season, is 3-3 with a 3.00 ERA (45.0IP, 15ER).
 - In five career starts vs. the Yankees is 1-3 with a 7.18 ERA (26.1IP, 21ER)...has allowed 5R-or-more in three of those five starts...is 0-2 with a 9.00 ERA (11.0IP, 11ER) in two career starts at Yankee Stadium.
- **LF Michael Conforto** (1-for-3, 2R, 1HR, 1RBI, 1BB, 1K) has scored a run in five straight games (since 7/13), his longest such streak of the season and the tied for the second-longest streak of his career (scored at least 1R in six straight games from 5/17-24/17)...is batting .313 (5-for-16) with 6R, 1 double, 2HR, 7RBI and 3BB over the stretch.
 - Is hitting .281 (43-for-153) with 17XBH in 44 games on the road this season, while hitting just .156 (22-for-141) with 6XBH in 43 games at home this season.
- **SS Amed Rosario** (3-for-4, 1R, 1RBI) snapped an 0-for-12 streak with his fifth-inning infield single...tied his career high with 3H (sixth time, last on 7/10/18 vs. Philadelphia)...tallied his 19th multi-hit game of the season...is tied for the team lead with 7SB (also Nimmo).
- **RF Brandon Nimmo** (0-for-3, 1RBI, 2HP) was hit twice today...is tied for the Major-League lead with 15HP this season (also Miami's Derek Dietrich).
- **DH Asdrúbal Cabrera** (0-for-3, 1K) was ejected following his strikeout to end the top of the fifth by third base umpire Hunter Wendelstedt.
- **Hitting Coach Pat Roessler** was ejected with two out in the top of the third inning by home plate umpire Larry Vanover.
