RHP Julio Teheran has 999 strikeouts and is looking to become the ninth pitcher in franchise history to fan 1,000 in a Braves uniform.

Of the eight with at least 1,000 strikeouts, only five did so in baseball's modern era: John Smoltz (3,011), Phil Niekro (2,912), Warren Spahn (2,493), Tom Glavine (2,091) and Greg Maddux (1,828)... All five are in the Hall of Fame.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Diamondbacks continue a four-game set tonight with the sixth meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves are 2-3 against the Diamondbacks this season, but have been outscored by just one run, 17-16, in the five games.

A The teams split the first two games in this series, with Atlanta winning 7-6 on Thursday before Arizona took last night, 5-3.

A The Diamondbacks won two-of-three games at SunTrust Park earlier this season, winning a 2-1 and 3-0 game to open the series, before the Braves took a 5-1 decision in the final game before the All-Star break.

A The Braves have not won a series in Arizona since taking three-of-four in 2012...They are 6-10 overall since 2013 here, including 0-4-1 in series play.

A RHP Julio Teheran beat Arizona earlier this season, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings in a 5-1 win on July 15...The righty is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (14 ER/46.1 IP) in eight career appearances, all starts, against Arizona.

A RHP Clay Buchholz is set to face the Braves for the fourth time in his career and for the first time since April 28, 2016 at Turner Field while with Boston...The righty is 1-1 with a 6.06 ERA (11 ER/16.1 IP) against the Braves...Buchholz is unbeaten in his last four starts, going 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA (2 ER/28.0 IP).

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled RHP Chad Sobotka from Triple-A Gwinnett...The club now has 35 active players on the roster.

A Sobotka appeared in six games earlier this season with the Braves, compiling a 3.68 ERA (3 ER/7.1 IP) while striking out 12.

TEHERAN: RHP Julio Teheran is 1-0 with a 2.48 ERA (9 ER/32.2 IP) over his last five starts, and has allowed just 17 hits for a .159 opponents' average against...Teheran took a no-decision in his last start on September 2 vs. Pittsburgh despite allowing just one run over 7.0 innings.

A Teheran ranks seventh in the major leagues this season with a .201 batting average against.

A For his career, he is 10-9 with a 3.29 ERA (61 ER/166.2 IP) in 28 games, 26 starts, during September...His ERA is a personal best for any calendar month.

REHABILITATION: RHP Arodys Vizcaíno and RHP José Ramírez made major league rehabilitation appearances with Single-A Rome last night during the club's playoff series with Lexington...Ramírez allowed four hits and four runs, earned, while getting one out, while Vizcaíno tossed a scoreless ninth inning in the 6-0 loss that eliminated Rome.

CAMARGO: 3B Johan Camargo finished 3-for-5 with two doubles and a home run, and has now homered in consecutive games for the third time in his career.

A Since becoming the starting third baseman on May 20, Camargo has 15 home runs...That is second most on the team to OF Ronald Acuña Jr., who has 20.

A Camargo became the first Braves third baseman with three extra-base hits in a game since 2012, when Martín Prado had two doubles and a triple on May 25 vs. Washington.

A Prior to Camargo, the last Braves third baseman to have a three extra-base hit game that included a home run was Chipper Jones on June 7, 2009 vs. Milwaukee...Jones went 4-for-4 with a triple and two home runs.

A Camargo has 14 doubles since the All-Star break, tied for the most in the National League...He is hitting .322 (56-for-174) with a .540 slugging percentage since the break.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves are 40-30 (.571) away from SunTrust Park this season, which is the second-best road record in the National League...Only Los Angeles is better (38-28, .576).

A With one more win away from SunTrust Park, the Braves will ensure they finish with a winning road record for the first time since going 46-35 in 2012.

A The Braves have 11 more road games left this season.

A From 2013-2017, the Braves went 174-230 (.431) on the road...That was the seventh-worst record in all of baseball.

A Over that stretch, the Braves were 29-64 (.312) on the road against the N.L. West...They are 5-6 so far this season.

HOME RUNS: With another home run this season, OF Ronald Acuña Jr. will tie Eddie Mathews and Orlando Cepeda (25 homers) for the fifth most home runs in a single season prior to turning 21...Al Kaline sits in fourth place with 27 in 1955, while Conigliaro had 32 in 1965...Frank Robinson hit 34 in 1956, while Mel Ott holds the record with 42 in 1929.

MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis collected two more hits last night, and over his previous five games, the outfielder is hitting .526 (10-for-19) with three walks, four RBI and a .591 on-base percentage.

A Prior to this stretch, Markakis hit .162 (11-for-68) with a .237 on-base percentage over 18 games.

A Markakis is tied for the major league lead with 171 hits...Boston's J.D. Martinez also has 171 hits.

A Markakis is on pace for 196 hits...His career-high total is 191 in 2007.

Tonight's Game

- Set to make his 28th start of the season and the 190th (193rd appearance) of his career.
- Needs one strikeout tonight to log 1,000 for his career, and is looking to become the ninth pitcher in franchise history to fan 1,000 in a Braves uniform.
 - Of the eight with at least 1,000 strikeouts, only five did so in baseball's modern era: John Smoltz (3,011), Phil Niekro (2,912), Warren Spahn (2,493), Tom Glavine (2,091) and Greg Maddux (1,828)... All five are in the Hall of Fame.
- Makes his ninth career appearance against Arizona, and is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (14 ER/46.1 IP) over his first eight games... Has allowed two or fewer runs in seven of his eight turns.
 - Faced them once this season, 7/15 at SunTrust Park, in Atlanta's final game before the All-Star break... Earned the win after tossing 6.1 scoreless innings with four hits and three walks... Fanned six.
 - Has won each of his last four decisions against the Diamondbacks... Has not lost to Arizona since May of 2013.
 - Last pitched at Chase Field on 8/24/16, and allowed 11 hits and six runs over 6.0 innings... Outside of that start, has a 1.79 ERA (8 ER/40.1 IP) in his career versus Arizona.
- Makes his second start in September and allowed just four hits and one run over 7.0 innings in his first, 9/2 vs. PIT.
 - For his career, is 10-9 with a 3.29 ERA (61 ER/166.2 IP) in 28 games in September, including 26 starts... It's his lowest ERA in any calendar month (min. 20.0 IP).
 - Allowed three or fewer earned runs in five of his last six September starts.

2018 Recap

- Allowed six hits and four runs over 5.2 innings, 8/28 vs. TB... Has made seven starts against the American League this season, and is 1-3 with a 5.29 ERA (20 ER/34.0 IP)... He is not slated to face another A.L. opponent in the remainder of the regular season.
- Earned the win, 8/22 at PIT, after allowing two hits and one run over 7.0 innings.
 - Walked just one, snapping a streak of 16 straight games with at least two walks... The streak was the longest of its kind in the majors at the time.
- Allowed two hits and one run over 6.0 innings, 8/11 vs. MIL.
 - Teheran allowed his only run in the first inning, and has a 7.33 ERA (22 ER/27.0 IP) in the first frame this season.
- Slugged the first home run of his career, 8/5 at NYM... Took Corey Oswalt out to left in the fifth inning, a solo shot.
 - Became the first Braves pitcher to homer since Jaime García hit a grand slam on 7/21/17 at LAD.
- Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.2 innings, 8/5 at NYM... Atlanta won 5-4 in 10 innings.
 - Snapped a streak of 13 consecutive starts against the Mets completing at least 6.0 innings, which dated to 6/21/15... Went 5-3 with a 1.63 ERA vs. NYM in that span.
 - Teheran's 2.42 ERA (40 ER/148.2 IP) against the Mets is the lowest among all active pitchers in the majors.
- Held Arizona to four hits and three walks over 6.1 scoreless innings 7/15... Fanned six.
 - The start was his sixth scoreless effort of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four hits on the season, the most such starts in the majors.
- Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17... Was the first hitless start of his career.
 - Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.
 - Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing... Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).
- Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16... Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.
- Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion... Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.
 - Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5... The D.L. stint was the second of his career and his first since 2016.
- Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM.
 - Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning.

Career Recap

- Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Has a 2.51 ERA in 51 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the fourth lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lowest.
- Allowed three hits and two runs, 9/6 at ARI, to blow his third save and snap a nine-game streak without allowing an earned run...Earned his fifth win after Atlanta won in 10 innings, most among Atlanta relievers.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his five wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 8-for-42 (.190) with runners in scoring position, including 3-for-19 (.158) with two outs.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arodys Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson, Jonny Venters and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Saves/Opp: 12/16 **Holds:** 10 **1st Batter/Retired:** 61/42 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/4

- Has allowed just one earned run in 19 appearances (16.2 IP) since the Braves acquired him on 7/29...Earned his first save with Atlanta, 9/6 at ARI, and has seven holds since being acquired.
- Took his second loss with Atlanta, 8/31 vs. PIT after allowing one unearned run in 0.2 innings...Both of his losses with the Braves, and his two blown saves, have come in games in which he did not allow an earned run.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .241 (32-for-133) average, while lefties are hitting .330/.420/.423 in 113 plate appearances.
- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
