### FISH BITES

Miami continues its final homestand of the season with game two of four against the Cincinnati Reds tonight at 7:10 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, who is making his 25th start of the season, is facing Cincinnati for just the second time in his career; he took a 4-1 loss to the Reds on May 4, 2018 at Great American Ball Park, allowing four runs on five hits and four walks, while recording two strikeouts, over 4.0 innings. The Reds are starting RHP Luis Castillo, who earned the win in his only prior start against Miami; he limited the Marlins to one run on three hits and a walk over 8.0 innings on July 30, 2017 at Marlins Park. Miami opened the homestand with a two-game split against the Washington Nationals, after returning from a wet and wild 2-7 road trip that saw three postponements due to weather. Miami will close out its 2018 season slate next week, traveling to Washington for a three-game series Monday-Wednesday, followed by a three-game set at Citi Field against the Mets, Friday-Sunday.

### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The Marlins dropped its second-straight 4-2 decision, this time to the Cincinnati Reds in game one of this four-game series. Miami was held scoreless over the first seven frames, until an RBI double by **J.T. Realmuto** and RBI single by **Peter O'Brien** cut the deficit to two. **Starlin Castro**, **Realmuto**, and **O'Brien** recorded two hits each, combining for six of the Marlins seven hits. **Jeff Brigham** was saddled with the loss, surrendering two runs on three hits and four walks, while striking out six, over a career-high 5.0 innings.

### VS. THE REDS

The 2018 season series between the Marlins and Reds is currently tied at 2-2; Miami took two of three from Cincinnati at Great American Ball Park, May 4-6. Miami is looking to extend its season-series win streak against Cincinnati to four, dating back to 2015. Prior to 2015, the Marlins hadn't won a season series since going 4-2 in 2005. In the nine seasons between season-series wins, Miami went 0-6-3. The Marlins the all-time series in South Florida (47-49; 12-10 at Marlins Park), and trail the overall series, 88-111.

### WINDING DOWN AT HOME

Despite a 35-43 record at Marlins Park this season, the Marlins pitching staff has put together one of the finer seasons in recent memory at home. The staff will have accumulated the most innings pitched, finishing with a minimum 768.0, ahead of a 2007 staff that tossed 757.0. Marlins pitchers have allowed just 647 hits to date, which ranks as the fifth-fewest in franchise history. Their 7.86 hits allowed per 9.0 ranks as the second-lowest, behind a mark of 7.54 in 1996. The staff's .237 average against would go down as the second-lowest (.230 in '96), while their 3.68 ERA would end as the seventh-best.

### TALE OF TWO CITIES

**Wei-Yin Chen** has pitched to a 1.77 ERA (71.0/14) in 12 home starts, compared to 9.29 (51.1/53) in 12 road starts. According to *Stats LLC*, the 7.52 difference in home/road ERA is the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors since Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 difference (11.10 on road/2.95 at home) in 2012 (min. 15 GS at home and on road). His 9.29 ERA is the highest of any Major League pitcher this season (min. 10 GS), while his home ERA of 1.77 ranks as the fifth-lowest of any MLB pitcher (min. 10 GS). Among Marlins starters, his road ERA would rank as the highest single-season ERA in Club history, while his home ERA is currently the sixth-lowest in a single-season in Club history.

### AWARDS SEASON

Yesterday, the South Florida Chapter of the BBWAA announced its 2018 Marlins award recipients. **Lewis Brinson** was honored with the Charlie Hough Good Guy Award; **Miguel Rojas** was named winner of the Jeff Conine Mr. Marlin Award; **Brian Anderson** took home the José Fernández Rookie of the Year Award; and **J.T. Realmuto** was named MVP. Tonight, the Marlins are honoring their 2018 Minor League award winners in a pregame ceremony; Player of the Year **Austin Dean**, Pitcher of the Year **Nick Neidert**, Student of the Year **Walner Espinal**, and Staff Member of the Year **Bruce Walton**. In addition, the Marlins named Team MVPs for each of their affiliates: New Orleans - RHP **Jeff Brigham**; Jacksonville - INF **Isan Diaz**; Jupiter - RHP **Parker Bugg**; Greensboro - INF **Jose Devers**; Batavia - LHP **Manuel Rodriguez**; GCL - OF **Davis Bradshaw**; and DSL - LHP **Luis Palacios**.

### PUTTING IT TOGETHER

Over their last 23 home games since July 28, the Marlins have posted a 3.13 ERA (213.0 ip/74 er) to mark the fourth-lowest ERA among National League staffs (seventh in MLB) at home in that span. They have limited opponents to a .217 average against, second in the NL and fifth in the Majors behind Oakland (.208), Tampa (.215), Boston (.215), and the Mets (.216). Starters have allowed three-or-fewer runs 19 times, including 14 starts of two-or-less runs allowed, and posted a 2.98 ERA (126.2/42), while the bullpen has allowed 32 earned runs over 86.1 innings pitched for a 3.34 ERA.

### HOME IMPROVEMENTS

Since June 8, Miami has gone 25-25 over its last 50 games at Marlins Park. That is a drastic improvement over a 10-18 record over the first 28 games at home. The Marlins have posted a 3.51 ERA (475.0 ip/185 er) over the stretch, which is the fifth-best among National League teams behind the Dodgers (3.05), Giants (3.18), Pirates (3.27), and Brewers (3.36).

### CATCH & HIT

**J.T. Realmuto** hit his 21st home run of the year last Friday night, extending his single-season career high. His 18 home runs as a catcher rank as the second-most by a Marlins backstop in Club history, one behind Charles Johnson's 19 in 1997. His 62 RBI when behind the plate are the fourth-most in a single season in Marlins history, behind Ivan Rodriguez (82 in 2003) and Johnson (69 in 2001 and 63 in 1997).

### SEEING THE FOREST THROUGH THE TREES

This morning, Marlins' players **Jarlin García**, **Pablo López**, and **José Ureña**, along with Marlins' alumnus Alex González, Billy The Marlin, and Marlins Mermaids, in conjunction with 2018 Marlins Charity Partner The Education Fund, assisted students with a food forest harvest and distribution of fresh produce at Twin Lakes Elementary School. The school grows fresh herbs and produce on site that is used in the school cafeteria for daily lunch preparation, and is periodically distributed to students to take home.

### ALL AROUND ANDY

**Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in games (148), at-bats (560), runs (81), and average with RISP (.357); ranks second in hits (150), doubles (31), walks (59), multi-hit games (43), and on-base percentage (.352); ranks third in average (.268) and slugging (.391); ranks tied for fourth in triples (4); and ranks fifth in RBI (59). On the defensive side, he leads NL rookie outfielders (min. 50 GS) with a .994 fielding percentage, committing just one error in 176 total chances. He also owns eight outfield assists, tied with Harrison Bader for most among all ML rookie outfielders and just four off the Major League lead held by Billy Hamilton and Mitch Haniger. His eight total errors this season are third-fewest by a NL rookie (min. 90 GS), and he is the only rookie on that list to spend significant time at two different positions (56 GS at 3B; 89 GS in RF).

Wei-Yin Chen is making his 25th start of the season, his final home start of the season, in game two of this four-game set against Cincinnati. Has won four of his last nine starts after taking four losses in previous five starts.

Has allowed a total of 46 hits over 56.1 innings since July 8, the seventh-fewest (min. 45.0 ip) among Major League starters, behind Blake Snell (31), Tyler Glasnow (34), Dereck Rodriguez (40), Mike Minor (44), Julio Teheran (45), and Vince Velasquez (45).

Has 1.77 ERA (71.0/14) in 12 home starts, compared to 9.29 (51.1/53) in 12 road starts. According to *Stats LLC*, the 7.52 difference in home/road ERA is the largest gap for any pitcher in the Majors since Dallas Keuchel had an 8.15 difference (11.10 on road/2.95 at home) in 2012 (min. 15 GS at home and on road).

His 9.29 ERA on the road is the highest of any Major League pitcher this season (min. 10 GS), while his home ERA of 1.77 ranks as the fifth-lowest of any MLB pitcher (min. 10 GS). Among Marlins starters, his road ERA would rank as the highest single-season ERA in Club history, while his home ERA is currently the sixth-lowest in a single-season in Club history.

Pitched to a 1.54 ERA in four August starts, the lowest monthly ERA (min. 4 GS) of his career. His previous low was a 2.05 ERA in five starts in September 2014. His August ERA ranked 10th among Major League starters (min. 4 GS), behind leader Cole Hamels (0.69).

Tied a career high with 8.0 innings pitched on September 1 vs. Toronto. Marked longest start since going 8.0 innings on July 12, 2015 vs. Washington. Limited Blue Jays to just three hits and one run while walking none and striking out seven.

On August 25 vs. Atlanta, limited Braves to six hits, while walking two and striking out a season-high 10, over 6.0 shutout innings. Tossed season-high 109 pitches and has reached 100-pitch mark in three of his last five starts. His pitch total in the game was the most since throwing 111 on September 26, 2015 at Boston. Has broken 100-pitch plateau nine times dating back to the start of 2016 (50 starts). Over his first four Major League campaigns, eclipsed 100-pitch mark 54 times in 117 starts.

Opponents are batting .223 (43x193) first time through lineup, .265 (49x185) second time through, and .322 (29x90) third time through.

Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.

Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.

José Ureña will make his 30th start of the season, extending a career-high, in game three of this four-game set against the Cincinnati Reds. Tomorrow night will mark his 17th start of the season at Marlins Park, where has gone 2-9 with a 4.20 ERA (90.0 ip/42 er). The 17 starts at home will be tied with 12 others for the eighth-most home starts in a single season in Club history; Jack Armstrong (1993), Kevin Brown (1996), and Scott Olsen (2007) share the top spot with 19 home starts.

Over his last five starts, has allowed a total of eight runs spanning 33.1 innings pitched for a 2.16 ERA. In three previous starts, which included a one-pitch outing against Atlanta on August 15, allowed 10 runs in 10.1 innings.

Has allowed just three runs over his last three starts, equaling the best three-start stretch of his career in terms of runs allowed. From June 13-23, 2017, allowed three total runs to Oakland (1), Atlanta (2), and the Cubs (0).
