Top of the Lineup

Since moving OF Ender Inciarte and 2B Ozzie Albies back to the top two spots in the lineup 11 games ago on June 22, the Braves have scored 64 total runs (5.8 per game).

The pair has combined to compile a .391 on-base percentage over this stretch, while scoring 24 runs.

With the duo hitting first and second in the starting lineup this season, the Braves are 26-17 (.605).

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Yankees finish a three-game set today, the teams' first series since 2015... These three games will be the clubs' only matchup this season.

A With a win today, the Braves will have taken both of their series at new Yankee Stadium, which opened in 2009...The Braves won two-of-three in their only other trip here, June 18-20.

A RHP Julio Teheran is set to face the Yankees for the second time in his career...He allowed eight runs, earned, and nine hits over 4.1 innings in his first start against New York, a 20-6 loss on August 30, 2015 at Turner Field.

A LHP CC Sabathia is scheduled for his fifth career start against Atlanta and his first since 2012...The lefty tossed a complete game in his last start against the Braves, striking out 10 in a 6-2 win here on June 18, 2012.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled LHP Luiz Gohara from Triple-A Gwinnett and optioned RHP Evan Phillips to the Stripers.

A Gohara, 21, returns to Atlanta for his second stint with the club this season...He was with the team from May 8-June 16 during his first recall, while also spending time on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List and the Restricted List, May 25-June 3.

A The lefty went 1-4 with a 5.74 ERA (17 ER/26.2 IP) in seven games, all starts, at Triple-A Gwinnett... He pitched last on June 30 at Charlotte.

A Phillips, 23, made his major league debut last night and allowed two runs, earned, over 2.1 innings of relief.

MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis finished 2-for-4 last night, collecting his major league-best 36th multi-hit game...He also drove a full-count, 7th-inning pitch from Adam Warren out to right field for his 10th home run of the season.

A Markakis reached double-digit home runs prior to the All-Star break for just the second time in his career...He had 14 in 2008...In his first three seasons with Atlanta, the outfielder hit a combined nine first-half home runs (zero in 2015, five in 2016, four in 2017).

A Markakis and 2B Ozzie Albies are two shy of the franchise record for most doubles prior to the All-Star break...Marcus Giles set the mark with 29 in 2003.

RUBBER GAME: The Braves and Yankees split the first two games of this series, setting up Atlanta's 12th rubber game of the season...The club has lost four straight rubber matches, after starting the season 7-0 in these games...Three of the four losses have come away from SunTrust Park.

HITS: 2B Ozzie Albies finished 2-for-5 yesterday, and now has 99 hits this season...His hit total ranks fourth in the National League, and he trails OF Nick Markakis (108), 2B Scooter Gennett (104) and 1B Freddie Freeman (101).

A Markakis and Freeman are the only pair of teammates in the majors to each have triple-digit hits...The duo is also the first pair of Braves to each reach 100 hits prior to the All-Star break since 2012, when Martin Prado and Michael Bourn accomplished the feat.

A No trio of Braves teammates have ever reached 100 hits prior to the All-Star game.

A The Braves have 773 hits this season, four behind Chicago (NL) for the N.L. lead.

DAY GAME: The Braves are a N.L.-best 19-9 (.679) in day games this season, trailing only Boston (.800), the Yankees (.720) and Houston (.704) for the best mark in the majors.

A The Braves per game averages of 5.61 runs and 1.50 home runs in day games both lead the National League.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .336 (41-for-122) with 10 home runs and a .672 slugging percentage in daylight this season.

VS. LEFTIES: The Braves are set to face their 27th left-handed starter of the season today, and the club is 14-12 in such games so far...They are hitting a major-league best .275 (229-for-832) against lefties this season, while their .466 slugging percentage trails only the Yankees' mark of .488.

A Braves left-handed hitters have 102 of those hits against lefties, and their .295 (102-346) average is the best in baseball.

A 1B Freddie Freeman is hitting .360 (40-for-111) against lefties this season, the second-best mark by a left-handed hitter and the seventh-highest average overall...He also has eight home runs, the most by a lefty, and the sixth most overall.

A In 2015, Freeman hit .219 (25-for-114) with one home run and a .316 slugging percentage against lefties...Since that season, the first baseman has hit .309 (133-for-430) with 23 home runs and a .549 slugging percentage against left-handed pitching.

FIRST PLACE: The Braves are in first place on Independence Day for the first time since 2014, when they finished the day 1.5 games up on Washington.

MINTER: A.J. Minter has converted all four of his save chances this season, and is the first Braves left-hander with multiple saves in a season since Jonny Venters had five in 2011.

A The last rookie lefty with more than four saves in a season was Chris Sale, who had eight in 2011.

Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 17th start of the season and the 179th (182nd appearance) of his career.
- A* Held St. Louis to just two hits over 6.0 scoreless innings in his last start, 6/29...Was his fifth scoreless start of the season of at least 6.0 innings and four or fewer hits, tied with teammate Sean Newcomb for the most such starts in the majors.
- A* In 16 turns this season, has six starts allowing one earned run or fewer and six starts allowing four or more runs...Has two of each such starts over his last four turns.
- A* Has walked three or more batters in 11 of his 16 starts on the season, second most in the majors...CHI's Tyler Chatwood has 12 such starts...Teheran has issued at least three base on balls in seven of his last eight starts.
- A* Teheran's rate of 4.21 walks per 9.0 innings is seventh highest in the majors.
- A* Faces New York-AL for the second time in his career, and makes his first career start at Yankee Stadium...Allowed nine hits and eight earned runs over 4.1 innings, 8/30/15 at Turner Field.
- A* Makes his 22nd career start in Interleague Play...Is 6-11 with a 5.37 ERA (73 ER/122.1 IP) in his career against the American League, including 1-2 with a 5.40 ERA (10 ER/16.2 IP) in three starts this season.

2018 Recap

- A* Allowed a season-most seven runs, 6/23 vs. BAL...Surrendered a first-inning grand slam to Mark Trumbo, the fifth grand slam allowed by Teheran in his career...Five grand slams are third most among active pitchers since his debut in 2011.
- A* Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17...Was the first hitless start of his career.
- A* Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.
- A* Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing...Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).
- A* Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16...Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.
- A* Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion...Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.
- A* Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5...The D.L. stint was the second of his career and his first since 2016.
- A* Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM...Has gone 7.0 innings three times this season, and all three have come against the Mets.
- A* Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning...His streak was the longest in the majors against the Mets since Teheran also had a 29.0-inning run from 6/21/15 to 9/9/16.
- A* Turned in a "quality" start, 5/25 at BOS, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings of work...Threw a season-most 109 pitches.
- A* Took the loss after Atlanta fell 6-2...The loss snapped a career high-tying four-game winning streak that dated to 4/16 vs. PHI...Went 4-0 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER/35.0 IP) over the run, which spanned six total starts.
- A* Allowed a then season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/20 vs. MIA...Left the game trailing 6-0 before Atlanta rallied for a 10-9 win...The Braves are 10-6 in his 16 starts this season.
- A* All six runs scored in the fourth inning, the third time in his career he's allowed six or more runs in one inning...Also did so on 7/28/17 at PHI (5th) and 5/26/15 at LAD (4th).
- A* Won his third consecutive start, 5/14 at CHI, after holding the Cubs to four hits and four runs over 6.0 innings...All four runs scored on a pair of two-run homers.
- A* Allowed two runs in the bottom of the second to snap a 16.0-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest such stretch of his career...Tossed a career-most 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings in 2016.
- A* Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/9 at TB...Allowed four hits and fanned seven...Logged consecutive scoreless starts for the fifth time in his career.
- A* The outing vs. TB snapped a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East, dating to 9/6/17.
- A* Held the Mets to two hits and two walks over 7.0 scoreless innings, 5/3...Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning before Asdrúbal Cabrera doubled with two outs.
- A* Earned his first win of the season, 4/16 vs. PHI...Tossed 6.0 innings and allowed just five hits and one run, striking out a season-best nine.
- A* Snapped a six-start winless stretch with the victory, which dated to 9/17/17.
- A* Made his fifth consecutive Opening Day start, which set the Atlanta era (since 1966) record for a pitcher.

Career Recap

- A* Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 26/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/3

- Over his last 16 appearances, has a 2.33 ERA (5 ER/19.1 IP) with a .156 (10-for-64) opponents' average.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... In four extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings with four hits and 14 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last five outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just eight hits in 71 at-bats (.113) against him...Lefties are hitting .359/.457/.667 with 14 hits, six walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 35/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one.
- Is one of seven relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- Allowed five runs over his last two appearances (3.1 IP)...Allowed multiple runs in consecutive appearances for the first time in his career.
- Holding batters to a .182 (14-for-77) average with men on base and has allowed just six hits (6-for-44, .136) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .280 (23-for-82) with no one on base.
- Has a 6.35 ERA (12 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.
- Earned three of his four wins at SunTrust Park this season...Is 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) at home.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 41/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with an 7.31 ERA (13 ER/16.0 IP) in his last 17 appearances...Surrendered 15 hits and eight walks during the spell, including a pair of home runs, and has allowed at least one run in eight of those outings.
- Had a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Fanned a career high-tying four batters in 2.1 innings, 6/19 at TOR, to earn his second win
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 9-for-48 (.188) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 6/4 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/1

- Recalled today from Triple-A Gwinnett for his second stint on the active roster...Also up from 5/8-6/16... Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- In three starts with the Stripers since being optioned, is 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP)...Fanned 13... Earned his first win of the season in his last appearance, 6/30 at Charlotte (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP, 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 10/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 5/1

- Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed one run and struck out five.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.38 ERA (5 ER/13.1 IP) in 10 relief appearances with Atlanta this season...Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Has fanned 18 batters in his 13.1 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 52 batters in 34.2 combined innings (13.5 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
