LAST SEASON:

2017 SEASON: Went 1-1 with one save, a 4.81 ERA (39.1ip/21er) and 43 strikeouts in 46 total appearances between St. Louis and Philadelphia...Began season with St. Louis and tossed a scoreless frame in his debut on 4/4 before allowing a combined five runs in his next two outings (1.1ip)...Recorded his only save of the season (10th career) on 5/7 at Atlanta...Was scored upon once (13.1ip/2er) over 15 appearances from 4/14 to 5/19...Allowed three runs on five hits in 1.1 innings while being charged with his only loss on 5/20 vs. San Francisco...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning and picked up his only win on 6/20 at Philadelphia...Was placed on

the 10-day disabled list on 6/25 with a cervical spine sprain... Began a rehab assignment with Double-A Springfield on 7/7... Was recalled from rehab and reinstated from the disabled list on 7/13...Made six straight scoreless appearances before allowing four runs in 0.1ip on 7/29 vs. Arizona...Was placed on the disabled list on 8/6 with left forearm tendinitis...Began a rehab assignment with Palm Beach on 8/24...Was recalled from rehab assignment, reinstated from the disabled list and designated for assignment on 8/31...Was claimed off waivers by Philadelphia on 9/2...Was scored upon twice in his seven outings (5.0ip) with the Phillies.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS:

2016: Led all qualifying National League left-handed relievers in ERA while making the second-most appearances in his career... Did not allow a run in 51 of his 67 appearances...Finished tied for fourth among National League relievers in wins...Ranked third among National League left-handed relievers in batting average against (.193)...Limited right-handed hitters to a .180 average, which ranked second among National League relievers behind Ryan Buchter (.168)...Did not allow a run thru his first eight appearances (7.2ip) from 4/5-24...Began the season with a 4-0 record before suffering his first loss on 6/7 at Cincinnati; his four wins in the team's first 28 games as a reliever were the most since Bruce Sutter (1983) and Larry Jackson (1957)...Earned his first save on 5/12 at Los Angeles (AL) after stranding the bases loaded with one out in the ninth (marked the 10th time in Cardinals history that a reliever came in with the bases loaded in the ninth inning and picked up the save)...Was on the disabled list from 6/30 to 7/14 with mononucleosis...Posted a 1.50 ERA over 12 appearances in September/October.

2015: Led all Major League pitchers in appearances; the third-most for a Cardinals left-handed reliever in a single season behind Steve Kline (89 in 2001) and Ray King (86 in 2004)... Became the first Cardinals pitcher since Steve Kline in 2001 to lead MLB in appearances...Set the Cardinals record for strikeouts by a left-handed relief pitcher with 90, surpassing Al Hrabosky's 82 in both 1974 and 1975...Finished third among National League relievers in strikeouts behind Aroldis Chapman (116) and Will Smith (91)...Finished tied for sixth among National League relievers in innings pitched and 10th in ERA...Finished tied for fourth among National League relievers in wins...Earned wins in each of his first five decisions before suffering his only loss on 8/28 at San Francisco...Posted 13 straight scoreless appearances (13.0ip) from 4/27 to 5/24.

2015 POSTSEASON: Appeared in three of the four Division Series games vs. Chicago...Retired each of the two batters he faced in Game One...Allowed a solo homer in 0.2ip in Game Three...Pitched 1.2 innings in Game Four and allowed two home runs while suffering the loss; had all three of his homers come off left-handed batters after allowing three homers to lefthanders in his MLB career to that point.

2014: Was a member of St. Louis' Opening Day roster for the first time in his career...Was placed on the 15-day disabled list with a left forearm strain on 5/24 and was reinstated on 7/23 after missing 53 games...Averaged 10.98 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched...Stranded 11 of 13 inherited runners...Tied his career high with 2.0 innings of work on 4/29 vs. Milwaukee.

PERSONAL:

PERSONAL: Kevin Ryan Siegrist...Is a 2007 graduate of Wellington (FL) High School...Played college baseball at Palm

2013: Pitched exclusively in relief for the first time in his career... Began season with Triple-A Memphis before recalled by St. Louis on 6/6...Finished season with a 25.0-inning scoreless streak, beginning on 8/2; the longest active streak in MLB to end the year and the fifth-longest in the National League for the season... Struck out a season-high four batters over 1.2 innings in his Major League debut on 6/6 vs. Arizona...Did not allow a run in 43 of his 45 appearances...Was unscored upon in a Cardinals' rookie-record 12 consecutive games to begin his career, which was snapped by Starlin Castro's solo home run on 7/12 at Chicago; his only homer allowed during the regular season...His 0.45 ERA in 39.2 innings was the lowest in MLB since 1911 (Buck O'Brien with Boston), by any pitcher with at least 35 innings pitched, and the lowest by any relief pitcher in MLB history (minimum 35 innings)...His 0.88 WHIP ranked ninth among MLB pitchers with at least 35 innings pitched...Did not allow a run in 24 appearances (20.2ip) at Busch Stadium...Earned first career win on 8/15 vs. Pittsburgh as the Cardinals won 6-5 in walkoff fashion in 12 innings...Suffered his only loss on 7/30 in game one of a doubleheader at Pittsburgh after allowing a game-ending single to Alex Presley in the 11th inning.

2013 POSTSEASON: Appeared in nine games during the postseason...Allowed three runs (2er) after allowing two over 39.2 innings during the regular season...Did not allow a run over his final three World Series appearances...Was the only Cardinals pitcher to strike out David Ortiz in the World Series with a swinging strikeout in Game Six, which snapped Ortiz' 30 at bat postseason strikeout-less streak.

2012: Began season on Palm Beach's disabled list...Was promoted to Springfield on 7/6, where he stayed for the remainder of the season and helped the Cardinals to the Texas League championship...Went 2-1 with a 2.37 ERA in six appearances (five starts) for Surprise during the Arizona Fall League.

2011: Split season between Quad Cities and Palm Beach, where he had a combined record of 8-4 with a 2.26 ERA (107.1ip/27er) in 20 games (19 starts).

2010: Split season between Batavia and Johnson City...Went 4-4 with a 4.02 ERA (53.2ip/24er) in 14 games (nine starts).

2009: Spent entire season with Batavia...Recorded first professional win on 7/6 at Auburn.

2008: Began professional career with the GCL Cardinals after being selected by St. Louis in the 41st round of the draft earlier in the summer.
