RED HOT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 30-16 post All-Star Break and 31-16 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in MLB since the All-Star Break (30), while St. Louis .652 winning percentage ranks 3rd in MLB over that period. St. Louis has won 20-of-its-last-27 games overall, including a season-best eight-game winning streak (August 7-15). Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the 3rd-most wins (78) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are at 16 games over .500 entering play tonight and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.0 games out of first place, and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 0.5 games. The Cardinals currently carry the 3rd-best record in the NL and have 6 games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

ROAD WARRIORS: The Cardinals' NL-leading 41 road wins are T3rd-most in the Majors and are the club's most since 48 road victories in 2016 (29 in 2017).

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: St. Louis is 180-172 all-time in Interleague play, with a .511 win percentage that leads all NL clubs (Mets, .507)...this season, St. Louis is 10-7 (5-2 on the road) need St. Louis one more win for winning Interleague record for first time since 2015 (11-9) and the 13th time in 22 seasons (since 1997)...St. Louis is 88-88 all-time in American League ballparks.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Cardinals designated hitters are the all-time leaders amongst National League teams in batting (.305, 209-686), on-base percentage (.381) & slugging percentage (.516). Tonight's designated hitter, **José Martínez**, ranks 10th in the Majors with a .350 (21-60) batting average in Interleague play.

HE MAKES IT A LITTLE BADER: Outfielder **Harrison Bader** leads Major League outfielders in 5-star catches (7) and Outs Above Average (20) (Statcast), and co-leads the Majors with Detroit outfielder **JaCoby Jones** with 21 defensive runs saved (Fangraphs). His 8 outfield assists rank T6th in the National League and co-lead NL rookies with Miami's **Brian Anderson**.

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER: **Matt Carpenter** enters tonight's Interleague matchup leading all active players with a career .618 slugging pct. and OPS (1.032) in those contests while ranking 5th in batting (.327) and 2nd in on-base pct. (.414).

CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL: St. Louis have homered in 101 of 140 games this season, going 70-31 (.693 win pct.) in those games (8-31 when not homering)...their 70 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 77)...among MLB clubs going yard, only the Red Sox (76-18, .809) and Astros (74-29, .719) have better winning percentages...St. Louis' 184 home runs are T2nd-most in the NL (Brewers) and trail the Dodgers (196)...275 of the Cardinals 649 runs scored (42.4%) this season have come via the long ball. **ROAD BOMBS:** St. Louis is an NL-best 39-17 (.696) while homering on the road, and trails only Oakland (117) in road homers (112).

POSTCARDS: Two Cardinals minor league affiliates are currently competing in the postseason. The defending PCL Champion **Memphis Redbirds** (AAA) are currently tied 1-1 with the Oklahoma City Dodgers in the best-of-five PCL Semifinals. Pitchers **Michael Wacha** (left oblique strain) and **Mike Mayers** (right shoulder inflammation) are scheduled to pitch in rehab tonight for the Redbirds. The **Peoria Chiefs** (A) swept the Quad City River Bandits (Astros) in the best-of-three Midwest League Quarterfinals. The Chiefs begin the Semifinals on Saturday (TBD opponent). The Cardinals minor league organization finished 492-402 overall and .550 winning pct. that ranked 3rd behind Tampa Bay (.604) and Houston (.562).

DANCING IN SEPTEMBER: Since the turn of the decade in 2010, the Cardinals have posted a stretch of winning Septembers going 137-99 (.581) in the month, trailing only Cleveland (140-99, .586).

BIG MAC FLASHBACK (Sept. 7, 1998) Home Run #61: In town for just the second (and final) time that season, **Sammy Sosa** and the Chicago Cubs were on hand to witness **Mark McGwire** tie **Roger Maris'** record after hitting starter **Mike Morgan's** 1-1 pitch off the Stadium Club in the first inning. The moment was extra special for Big Mac, who hit the historic home run on his father's 61st birthday.

The 2018 season marks the 20th anniversary of the 1998 Home Run Race that ultimately concluded with Mark McGwire belting 70 homers while establishing a new MLB single-season home run record. Cardinals.com/McGwire

DETROIT CONNECTIONS

1934 World Series: The "Gas House Gang" won the NL pennant on the final day of the season, then defeated Detroit in the Series, four games to three, for their third championship in eight years. **Dizzy** and **Paul Dean**, each won two games over the Tigers. The final game of the Series, won by the Cardinals, 11-0, was marked by **Commissioner Kenesaw Landis'** order to eject **Ducky Medwick** from the game. Medwick slid hard into Tigers third baseman **Marv Owen** in the sixth inn., so infuriating Detroit fans that they bombarded Medwick with empty bottles, fruit, vegetables and debris when he took his position in left field in the bottom of the inning. Landis removed Medwick to halt the disturbance...1934 was the last World Series in which both teams were led by player-managers.

Cardinals Director of Communications **Brian Bartow** is a native of Battle Creek Mich...graduated from Ferris State College in Big Rapids, Mich.

1968 World Series: 50 years ago, the Tigers overcame a 3-1 deficit and defeated the defending World Series champion Cardinals, four games to three, for their first championship since 1945... Left-hander **Mickey Lolich** hurled three complete-game victories (1.67 ERA) to earn MVP... Gibson won two games and set Series records by striking out 17 batters in Game One and 35 in the Series. **Lou Brock** batted .464 and stole seven bases. Current Cardinals Hall of Fame broadcasters **Tim McCarver** and **Mike Shannon**, each homered and played all seven games.

Hall of Famer and former Cardinals Manager **Whitey Herzog** played in 52 games for Detroit during the 1963 season...became a Tiger via trade with Baltimore, packaged with catcher **Gus Triandos** in exchange for catcher the **Dick Brown** (November 26, 1962).

2006 World Series: The Cardinals secured a play-off berth on the final day of the regular season by winning the NL Central Division and went on to capture the 10th World Championship in franchise history, topping the Tigers in five games... the Cardinals won the Fall Classic with the fewest regular-season wins during a full season in major league history (83)...St. Louis pitchers limited the Tigers to 32 hits in 44 IP with a 2.05 ERA. **David Eckstein** batted .364 (8-22) with three doubles and four RBI to be named MVP...**Tony La Russa** joined **Sparky Anderson** (Reds & Tigers) as only the second manager to win the World Series with teams in both leagues...notable Cardinals to appear include **Yadier Molina** and **Adam Wainwright**.

Tigers Special Assistant to the GM **Jim Leyland** spent six seasons (2000-05) as a scout for the Cardinals, scouting NL clubs from Pittsburgh and AL clubs from Cleveland.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his eight career Major League start and 25th appearance tonight.
- Ranks T3rd in the National League with five wins post All-Star Break; one of three MLB pitchers with at least five wins without a loss in that period (J.A. Happ & Blake Snell).
- This is his second career Interleague start and fourth appearance.
- He's one of 11 different pitchers (lone lefty) to make a start for St. Louis this season.
- Is the first Cardinals left-hander to begin his career 6-0 since Allen Watson started 6-0 in his rookie season of 1993.
- Is 3-0, 2.13 ERA in 14 games (25.1 IP) at Busch Stadium, limiting opp. to .237 BA.
- Owns a 4-0 mark with 2.52 ERA in his seven starts (39.1 IP).

LAST TIME OUT

- Became the first Cardinals rookie LHP to win five games in August, tossing a career-high 7.0 innings allowing a career-high 10 hits, but surrendering only two runs in a 12-5 Cardinals win vs. CIN. Led all Major League Baseball pitchers with five wins in August.
- The Cardinals were 7-0 in games he appeared in during the month of August.

- Led all of Major League Baseball with five wins in August.
- Improved to 4-0 with a 12-3 win at Coors Field vs. COL (8/26). He became the Cardinals first LH starter to win a game at Coors Field since Kent Mercker in 1999.
- Blanked the Dodgers over his first 4.0 innings on 8/20, improving his scoreless inning streak to 15.0, but took ND in the Cardinals 5-3 win that featured 9th inning HR's from Gyorko & Carpenter.
- Stretched his win streak to three with 6.0 shutout innings in 4-2 win over WSH on 8/15, matching his career-high with 6 strikeouts.
- Gained his first win as a starter, combining with Shreve and Poncedeleon on a 7-0 shutout of the KC Royals at Kauffman Stadium on 8/10.
- Recalled on July 24 from Memphis (AAA) and made his first career Major League start at CIN that night, began that start with 6.1 no-hit innings before Joey Votto singled in the 7th inning. He and Daniel Poncedeleon (7/23 at CIN) became the first pair of rookie teammates to carry consecutive no-hitters into the 7th inning since 1964.
