### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** take game three of four over the White Sox...Twins improve to 77-84 on the season and to 11-7 against Chicago-AL this year, 5-4 at Target Field...are now 41-34 against the AL Central this year...improve to 48-32 at Target Field this year...with this win the Twins solidify their 20<sup>th</sup> series win and will go for their 7<sup>th</sup> series sweep tomorrow...will finish the season with a series record of 20-23-7...ties our season longest win streak (5).
- **KYLE GIBSON** earned his 10<sup>th</sup> win of the season after 6.0 innings and just one run on three hits...tonight' start marks his 18<sup>th</sup> quality start of the season...he will finish the year 10-13 with 196.2 innings pitched, a career high...this season also set a new career high in strikeouts (177) and was marks the fewest earned runs allowed in any full season of his career (79).
- **JAKE CAVE** (1-for-3) extended his hit-streak to six games, hitting .429 (9-for-21) during the streak with a two RBI double in the first inning to score the first runs for the Twins...this was his 17<sup>th</sup> double of the season.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (3-for-5) recorded three singles in the game, marking his 23<sup>rd</sup> multi-hit game and fourth three-hit game...this homestand he has recorded a hit in five of the six games, and of those five games four were multi-hit games...hitting .407 (11-for-27) in this homestand.
- **JOE MAUER** (2-for-4) extended his hit-streak to eight games is hitting .417 (15-for-36) with five multi-hit games during the streak...this marked his 42nd multi-hit game of the season...was his 574<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of his career, which ranks third most on the Twins all-time list...reached base safely in each of his last 15 starts and is hitting .371 (23-for-62) with eight RBI and 13 runs scored over that span...has scored a run in seven straight games.
- **JOHNNY FIELD** (2-for-4) recorded his third multi-hit game of the season with the Twins and his 12<sup>th</sup> overall with a double and single both in the second inning...this marks the 13<sup>th</sup> double of the season for Field...this marked the second time this season that a player has recorded two hits in one inning, other was Brian Dozier on July 8 vs. Baltimore in the sixth inning.
- **WILLIAMS ASTUDILLO** (2-for-5) recorded his fourth double of the season in the second inning...has recorded a hit in seven of his last eight, hitting .452 (14-for-31) during that span...recorded a single in the eighth to mark his 10<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.

## **WHITE SOX NOTES:**

- **THE WHITE SOX** fall to the Twins for the third time in two days...are now 8-14 in the last 22 games at Target Field...have now lost 10 of their last 12 games and 17 of their last 23 overall...Chicago is now 30-45 against American League Central and have lost 11 of their last 14 against divisional foes.
- **CARLOS RODON** made his 20<sup>th</sup> and final start of the season (11<sup>th</sup> on the road) second against the Twins, did not factor in the decision...allowed eight runs on six hits, four walks and two strikeouts over 1.0 inning (shortest outing of the season)...finished the year 6-7 with a 4.18 ERA (120.2 IP, 56 ER) with 55 walks and 90 strikeouts...five straight road starts with two earned runs or more.
- **JEANMAR GOMEZ** pitched 3.0 scoreless innings...17 of his 26 appearances this season have been scoreless...has tossed at least 1.0 inning in five of his last seven appearances...has allowed earned runs in just one of the outings.
- **YOAN MONCADA** (2-for-5) doubled in the third inning and the ninth, marking his 31<sup>st</sup> multi-hit game of the season...reached base safely now in 30 of his last 34 games and is now hitting .292 (38-for-130)...became the fifth player in White Sox history, age 23 or younger, to record 30-plus doubles, 15-plus home runs and 60-plus RBI in a single season.
- **OMAR NARVAEZ** made his 72<sup>nd</sup> start at catcher this season...singled and RBI in the first inning...he is now hitting .319 (61-191) since 6/7 ranks fourth in the American League among players with at least 200 plate appearances...he left tonight's game with lower back stiffness.
