SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Walker Lockett made his Major League debut tonight**, becoming the seventh Padres pitcher to make their MLB debut and the third to do so as a starting pitcher.
- **Hunter Renfro** has hit safely in each of his last four games, batting .500 (6-for-12) with two doubles.
- **Freddy Galvis** has seven extra-base hits in his last nine games (five doubles, one triple and one homer) with a .581 slugging percentage...has reached base via hit or walk in eight of his last nine games, posting a .343 OBP in that time.
- **Travis Jankowski** has eight of the Padres' 10 leadoff hits to start a game...is hitting .310 (27-for-87) this season when batting leadoff.
- **Manuel Margot** has hit safely in six of his last eight games (.304, 7-for-23).

CINCINNATI NOTES

- **Tyler Mahle** earned his fourth winning decision of the season tonight and his first since May 10 at LAD...has worked 5.0 innings-or-more in 10 of his 12 starts this season, posting a combined 4-4 record with a 3.56 ERA (22 ER, 55.2 IP) in those outings.
 - Recorded his first career double and extra-base hit in the sixth inning.
- **José Peraza** has recorded multiple hits in each of his last four games and has hit safely in each of his last five, batting .476 (10-for-21) with a double and four RBI...tallied a season-high three RBI tonight, his first such game since August 17 of last season at CHC.
- **Scouter Gennett** belted his 11th homer of the season and is now hitting .425 (37-for-87) over his last 22 games since May 7 with five doubles, nine home runs, 25 RBI and 18 runs scored.
- **Michael Lorenzen** earned his first save of the season and became the first Red to work 4.0 innings-or-more and gave a save since Elmer Dessens did so on June 24, 2000 vs. San Diego at Cinergy Field in Cincinnati.
