### BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Drop to 9-6 in extra-inning games (6-5 at home)...Fall to 3-11 vs. BOS this season and are now 17-26 in divisional games...Lost for the 6<sup>th</sup> time this year when out-hitting an opponent...Had the roof open/close during a game at Rogers Centre for the 1<sup>st</sup> time this year (went 0-7 in such games in 2017).
- MARCUS STROMAN** threw a two-hitter over 7.0 innings...Retired 20 outs on ground balls (16) and strikeouts (4)...Allowed 1 unearned run, for his longest ER-free start since 8/11/17 vs. PIT (8.0 IP)...Was his 3<sup>rd</sup> career game of 7+ IP and 2-or-less hits (2<sup>nd</sup> vs. BOS, also 7/24/14), last doing on 9/24/16 vs. NYY (7.0 IP, 1H)...Now has a 3.48 ERA (21 ER/54.1 IP) in 9 starts since his DL stint (7.71 ERA in 7 starts prior)...Exited the game prior to the 8<sup>th</sup> with a right middle-finger blister.
- DEVON TRAVIS** opened the scoring with a two-run blast to the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck in left-field in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning...Was his 4<sup>th</sup> HR this year to open the scoring and his 5<sup>th</sup> to plate Toronto's first run(s) of a game...Has hit each of his last 6 HR with runners on base...Now has 32 HR as a Toronto 2<sup>nd</sup> baseman, tying him with Damaso Garcia for 4<sup>th</sup> all-time (Hill-90, Alomar-54, Hudson-34)...Has 9 RBI in his last 5 games...Added a single in the 7<sup>th</sup> for his 14<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game, 3 of which have come during his current 5G hitting streak...Has gone 24-for-76 (.316) with 2-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR and 17-RBI in his last 24 games.
- JUSTIN SMOAK** hit his team-leading 18<sup>th</sup> home run to tie the game, 5-5, in the 9<sup>th</sup> inning...Has recorded 14 HR in the 9<sup>th</sup> inning or later over the last 2 seasons, the most in the Majors...Has hit 6 HR vs. BOS this season...His 17 career HR vs. BOS are his most vs. any opponent (16 vs. LAA)...Extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a 1<sup>st</sup>-inning single, tying the 2<sup>nd</sup> longest streak of his career (4/11-4/29/11)...Has gone 15-for-47 (.319) with 3-2B, 2-HR, 4-RBI over that stretch...Tied Lourdes Gurriel Jr. for the longest streak by a Blue Jay this season...Also walked as part of a 2-for-4 night...His 62-BB are 6<sup>th</sup> most in the AL.
- KEVIN PILLAR** hit his 9<sup>th</sup> home run, a two-run homer in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning...All of his HR this season have been at home and 7 have been against AL East opponents...Was his 1<sup>st</sup> career extra-inning home run.
- LUKE MAILE** doubled in the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 8<sup>th</sup> and picked up an RBI to extend his career highs in hits (40), RBI (26) and 2B (10)...Was his 4<sup>th</sup> multi-XBH game this season (last: 6/2 at DET).
- TEOSCAR HERNANDEZ** walked, singled and drove in a run with a sac fly in the 7<sup>th</sup>...Has gone 8-for-28 (.286) with 3-2B, 1-3B, 1-HR and 2-RBI over his last 7 starts.
- YANGERVIS SOLARTE** singled twice and drew a pair of walks...Reached base 4 times in a game for the 4<sup>th</sup> time this year (last: 7/6 vs. NYY).

### RED SOX NOTES:

- Became the 1<sup>st</sup> team this season to earn their 80<sup>th</sup> win...The last time they did so was in 2009 (80-51)...Are now 8-3 in extra-inning affairs...Had their 14<sup>th</sup> game with 10+ runs this season, tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> most in the Majors...Move to 11-3 against the Jays this season and 38-14 in AL East matchups...Have won 5 straight contests and 9 of their last 10.
- DREW POMERANZ** allowed a pair of runs on 4 hits over 4.2 innings...Struck out a season-low 1 batter while matching a season high with 5 walks (also 5/13 at TOR)...Now has 28 walks in 38.0 career IP vs. TOR - his most vs. any opponent...Is now 2-0 with a 3.92 ERA (9 ER/20.2 IP) in 4 starts at Rogers Centre as a member of the Red Sox.
- J.D. MARTINEZ** got the Red Sox on the board with an RBI single in the 4<sup>th</sup> inning...Hit a three-run homer in the 8<sup>th</sup> inning to give the Red Sox a 5-3...Was his MLB-leading 34<sup>th</sup> HR (J. Ramirez-33 entering tonight)...Also doubled as part of a 3-for-5 evening...Was his 44<sup>th</sup> multi-hit effort (MLB leader coming into tonight was Francisco Lindor at 44) and his 13<sup>th</sup> 3+ hit game...Marked his 4<sup>th</sup> 4+RBI game (last: 7/3 at WAS)...Leads the Majors in RBI (97) and multi-RBI games (29).
- MITCH MORELAND** had the go-ahead blast in the 10<sup>th</sup> inning, a three-run shot...Was his 4<sup>th</sup> career extra-inning HR (last: 8/4/17 vs. CWS)...6 of his 14 homers this season have given the Red Sox the lead...Is 2<sup>nd</sup> on the team with 11 game-winning RBI.
