MARINERS NOTES:

- The Mariners are 5-0 against the Orioles this season.
 - Earned another 1-run win, improving to 34-18 (.654) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB).
 - Improve to 39-28 at Safeco Field this year.
 - Move to 22-42 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- Mitch Haniger** (1x3, 3B, BB) extended his career-best hitting streak to 15 games, the longest active streak in the Majors... during that span, he is batting .317 (20x63) with 12 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 6 RBI, 1 hit by pitch and 8 walks.
 - Hit his third triple of the season (last: 5/15 vs. Texas), the sixth of his career.
 - Has hit safely in 28 of his last 32 games, batting .336 (45x134) with 21 runs scored, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 16 RBI, 2 HBP and 11 walks.
- Erasmo Ramírez** threw for 5.1 innings, giving up just 1 run on 2 hits while tossing 5 strikeouts... he lowered his ERA to 5.56.
 - Improved his ERA at Safeco Field to 1.78 (2 ER, 10.1 IP).
 - His third game this season without issuing a walk.
- Edwin Díaz** recorded his Major League-leading 52nd save of the season...his 52 saves are tied with Eric Gagne-LAD (2002) for 8th-most in single-season Major League history.
 - Improves to 26-for-29 (89.6%) in one-run save opportunities this season.
 - The Mariners are now 61-0 when Díaz enters with a lead this season, including 29-0 when he enters with a one-run lead.
- Cameron Maybin** (2x3, 3B, R) had his second multi-hit game with the Mariners tonight, first since 8/07 @ Texas... it was his 15th multi-hit game of the year (13 with Miami).
 - Notched his first triple with Seattle.
 - Has hits in 13 of 19 games with at bats with the Mariners, hitting .214 (15x70) with 9 runs, 1 triple, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 4 walks.
- Ryon Healy** (1x3, RBI, BB) tied the game up at 1-1 with a single in the 4th inning... is batting .377 (23x61) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 3 home runs and 12 RBI since 8/11 (16 games).
 - Extended his hitting streak to 5 games (since 8/29 @ San Diego)... is batting .391 (9x23) with 3 runs, 1 home run, 6 RBI and 2 walks during that span.
- Nelson Cruz** (1x3, BB) has reached base safely in 57 of 61 career games (w/AB) against the Orioles, including 54 games with at least 1 hit... overall he is batting .350 (63x180) with 45 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 12 home runs, 51 RBI, 3 HBP, 26 walks and 4 stolen bases.

ORIOLES NOTES:

- The Orioles are now 0-4 on their current road trip.
 - Are 1-7 at Safeco Field over the last three seasons.
- Jonathan Villar** (1x4, HR, RBI, R) hit his 6th home run of the year in the 4th inning, scoring the first run of the game.
- Tim Beckham** (1x3) stayed hot in the two games he has played in September, batting .714 (5x7) with 1 double, 1 home run and 2 RBI in those games.
- Josh Rogers** made his second Major League start and appearance... threw 5.1 innings and giving up 2 runs on 4 hits, both career-lows.
 - Threw a career-high 4 strikeouts.
- Joey Rickard** (1x3) extended his hitting streak to 4 games (since 8/19), batting .455 (5x11) during that span.
