TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants look to get back in the win column following back-to-back losses to the Phillies as they face RHP Nick Pivetta in game three of this four-game set...San Francisco is 3-2 over the first five games of their current 10-game road trip to Atlanta (3-0), Philadelphia (0-2) and Pittsburgh.

AGAINST THE PHILLIES: Dating back to last season, the Giants have dropped six of their last eight games to Philadelphia and have been outscored 52-38 over that eight game span...SF has also lost seven of their last nine contests at Citizens Bank Park, including each of their last four.

TOO MANY LONG BALLS: SF pitchers have surrendered 12 home runs in their last seven games, including seven homers in their past two contests...Giants' pitchers allowed just 20 homers over their first 29 contests this season.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Chris Stratton has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.49 ERA (7er, 25.1ip) in four road starts this season...opponents are batting just .135 (5-for-37) off him with two outs...he'll oppose Phillies' right-hander Nick Pivetta, who struggled in his last start in Washington, allowing six earned runs in 1.0 inning of work.

BUSTER VS. THE PHILLIES: C Buster Posey is batting .388 (62-for-160) with 23 runs and 19 RBI in 41 career games against the Phillies, which is the second-highest average of any player against Philadelphia since 1913 (min. 150 PA)...Posey had his 23-game hitting streak against the Phillies snapped last night as he went 0-for-4.

JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco is 17-3 this season when scoring at least four runs in a game, compared to a 2-14 record when scoring fewer than four.

A COUPLE OF STREAKS: IF Brandon Belt has reached base safely in 20-straight games, batting .324 (23-for-71) with nine extra-base hits 13 RBI and 15 walks...**OF Andrew McCutchen** has reached base safely in each of his last 19 games (18 hits, 17 walks).

TOO MANY MISCUES: The Giants have committed at least one error in each of their last six games (12 total errors)...San Francisco's 29 errors overall this season rank as the second most in the Majors behind the Texas Rangers (33).

MLB FACEBOOK WATCH GAME: Tomorrow, Thursday, May 10 the Giants at Phillies game can be seen exclusively on Facebook Watch starting at 10:00 a.m. PT...the game will be called on Facebook Watch by Javier Lopez (analyst), Scott Braun (play-by-play), Ben Davis (analyst) and Alexa Datt (in-game reporter)...this will be the sixth broadcast in the package of weekday afternoon games produced by MLB Network and its Emmy Award-winning production team...it will feature a social-first presentation and interactivity for Giants fans.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants are hitless in their last nine at-bats with runners in scoring position after hitting .417 (15-for-36) with RISP over their three game set in Atlanta...SF's .236 average with RISP overall ranks as the fifth-lowest in the NL.

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants have turned 12 double plays over their past seven games...their 42 double plays this season are the most in the Majors.

The Giants and Braves split a doubleheader, with the Giants winning the opener, 5-2, and the Braves taking the nightcap, 6-5 in 11 innings...Orlando Cepeda hit a grand slam and solo HR for Atlanta, while **Willie McCovey** hit a three-run HR for SF.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#34 RHP Chris Stratton
6-2, 211, 27 years old (August 22, 1990)
3-2 Record, 3.99 ERA

- The 27-year-old right-hander is making his eighth start of the season...the Giants are 5-2 in his starts this year, winning five of his last six trips to the hill.
- Last started Friday at Atlanta and earned the win despite allowing two home runs for the first time in his career...allowed three runs on six hits while walking two and striking out six in SF's 9-4 win.
- Has limited the opposition to three runs or fewer in six of his seven outings...had the worst start of his career April 28 vs. Los Angeles, allowing a career-high six runs in just 1.1 innings, the second-shortest start of his big league career.
- Was reinstated from the Paternity List April 28...was placed on that list April 25 and flew home to Mississippi where he was able to meet his wife, Martha Kate, and make the birth of their second child, Mary Bennett Stratton, born April 25 at 11:53 p.m.
- Has a 6.43 ERA (5er, 7.0ip) in the first inning and a 3.45 ERA (12er, 31.1ip) in all other innings combined.
- Has never faced the Phillies...is a perfect 3-0 with a 2.11 ERA (5er, 21.1ip) in five games (three starts) against the NL East in his career.
- Is 2-1 with a 2.49 ERA (7er, 25.1ip) and a .189 opponents average against in four starts on the road this season...has allowed three runs or fewer in each of his last eight road starts dating back to last season.
- According to FanGraphs, opponents are hitting .173 (14-for-81) off Stratton this year against his four-seam fastball, .238 (5-for-21) off his curveball, .412 (7-for-17) off his slider, .200 (2-for-20) off his changeup and .375 (3-for-8) off his sinker.
- Threw his curveball 193 times last season and the pitch averaged 3,105 revolutions per minute, according to Statcast - the highest spin rate among all Major League pitchers who threw the curveball at least 50 times.
- Opponents have a .145 career batting average against Stratton's curveball.
