The Mariners have not committed an error in 15 consecutive games (5/23-c)...during this span, the Mariners have successfully converted 585 total chances (420 putouts, 165 assists)...the 15 consecutive games (previous: 12, 7/3-21/12) without an error and 585 total chances (previous: 518, 7/3-21/12) without an error are both club records.

### VS. TAMPA BAY

The Mariners and Rays meet for the 5th (4-0) of 7 games this season...Seattle swept a 3-game series vs. the Rays at Safeco Field, June 1-3...the Mariners are 13-3 in their last 16 games vs. the Rays, dating back to the start of the 2016 season:

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue a 6-day, 6-game road trip covering over 5,600 miles with the second game of a 4-game series with Tampa Bay (1-0)...opened the road trip splitting a 2-game set with Houston (1-1)...the Mariners will return home to Seattle on June 11 to begin a 7-day, 7-game homestand that features 3 games vs. the Angels and 4 games vs. the Red Sox...tonight's game will be televised on ROOT SPORTS NW and broadcast live on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners have won 6 of their last 7 games, 10 of their last 13, 15 of their last 19 and 17 of their last 23...Seattle is 25-12 in its last 37 games, 30-15 over its last 45 games and 35-19 in its last 54 games...Seattle is 12-10 during the day and 28-12 at night...Seattle is 20-12 at Safeco Field, 19-11 on the road.

- Extra, Extra!** - the Mariners are 6-0 in extra-inning games this season...tied with Texas (6-1) and Toronto (6-1) for the ML-lead in extra-inning wins.
- Walk it Off** - the Mariners (5) are tied with the Yankees for 3rd-most walk-off wins in the ML, trailing only the Cardinals (7) and Braves (6)...each of the Mariners 5 walk-off wins has come during extra-innings.
- Multi-Hit Madness** - Jean Segura leads the Major Leagues with 28 multi-hit games, ranking ahead of Nicholas Castellanos-DET (26) and Nick Markakis-ATL (26)...Segura leads the Majors with 12 games of 3+ hits, ahead of Nicholas Castellanos-DET (11).
- Four Score** - Seattle is 27-8 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but 12-15 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- That was Close** - the Mariners are 19-9 (.679) in one-run games this season, the most one-run wins and one-run decisions in the Majors...the Mariners are also 25-11 in games decided by 2-or-fewer runs.
- Scoreless** - RH Chasen Bradford has an active 8.2 scoreless innings streak over his last 8 games (5/17-c)...his scoreless streak is currently the T11th-longest active streak in the American League.
- Series Stuff** - the Mariners have won or tied 16 of their first 19 series, posting a series record of 11-3-5.

**MARCO...POLO**...in each his last 4 starts (5/17-current), Marco Gonzales has tossed at least 5.0 innings while allowing 1-run-or-fewer runs, going 3-0 with a 0.35 ERA (1 ER, 26.0 IP) over that span...during this stretch he has limited opponents to a .180 opponent batting average (16x89) while walking 9 and striking out 18...his 0.35 ERA is the lowest in the Majors dating back to May 17, ranking ahead of Ross Stripling-LAD (0.73 ERA) and Blake Snell-TB (0.74 ERA)...Gonzales' streak of 4 consecutive starts tossing at least 5.0 innings and allowing 1-run-or-fewer runs is currently tied for the 4th-longest in club history (15x, last: Hisashi Iwakuma, 8/3-19/14) and trailing only Jamie Moyer (6, 8/18-9/19/01), Jarrod Washburn (5, 7/6-28/09), Randy Johnson (5-2x, 5/28-6/19/97 & 8/11/94-5/12/95) and Scott Bankhead (5, 6/18-7/9/89).

**HITS IN 60**...Jean Segura has recorded 85 hits in his first 59 games this season...his 85 hits are currently the 2nd-most in his career through his first 60 games of a season, trailing only his 89 hits in 60 games in 2017 and ranking ahead of his 82 hits in 60 games in 2013 with Milwaukee...his 85 hits this season are already T8th-most in club history through first 60 games (see full chart in sidebar).

**HOT START**...Seattle is 39-23 (.629) through its first 62 games of the season, its 3rd-best record in club history, trailing only 2001 (49-13/.790) and 2003 (42-20/.677)...the Mariners currently have a +1.0 lead over the Astros in the American League West...prior to this season, the last time the Mariners led the AL West outright after May was at the end of play on Aug. 24, 2003.

**AS THE STARTING PITCHING GOES**...since May 16, the Mariners starters are 10-1 (team is 15-6 overall) with a 2.24 ERA (34 ER, 136.2 IP) with 102 strikeouts and 31 walks in 21 games...Seattle starters lead the Major Leagues in ERA during that span, ranking ahead of St. Louis (2.53/35 ER, 124.1 IP) and Washington (2.81/35 ER, 112.0 IP)...the 136.2 innings pitched by Mariners starters are the most in the Majors since May 16...during this same stretch, Mariners relievers are 5-5 with 8 saves and a 2.69 ERA (18 ER, 60.1 IP).

**NO FREE PASSES**...James Pazos has not issued a walk since his first appearance of the season on April 4, a span of 23 appearances without a walk...Pazos' streak of 23 consecutive games without issuing a walk is the 2nd-longest streak of games without a walk among Major League relievers this season...Kansas City's Kelvin Herrera has an active streak of 25 straight games without issuing a walk, dating back to the beginning of the season...Pazos' streak is the 2nd-longest by a reliever in club history, trailing only Charlie Furbush, who did not walk a batter in 26 straight outings, May 20 - July 29, 2014.

**ROLLING IN ST. PETE**...the Mariners have won 10 of the last 13 games and 13 of the last 19 games in St. Petersburg (since July 21, 2012)...the 19-game stretch followed an 8-game losing streak at Tropicana Field (8/19/11-7/20/12)...the Mariners swept a 3-game set in Seattle earlier this season (June 1-3) and overall are 20-6 in the last 26 games against the Rays (since June 7, 2014).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN**...Jean Segura is batting .370 (47x127) with 25 runs scored, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 20 RBI, 5 walks and 8 stolen bases in 29 games on the road this season, including batting .449 (22x49) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 1 home run, 5 RBI and 3 stolen bases in his last 11 road games (5/9-c)...among all American League players, his .370 road average is the T2nd-highest this season (also: Andrelton Simmons-LAA, .370/40x108) and trailing only Jose Altuve-HOU (.412/54x131)...he also ranks 2nd in hits, 4th in runs, 9th in on-base percentage (.391), T11th doubles and T12th in RBI.

**RIBBIES**...Seattle boasts 2 of the top-3 players in the American League in RBI on the road this season...Kyle Seager ranks 2nd in the American League with 26 road RBI, while Mitch Haniger ranks T3rd with 24 RBI...Jean Segura ranks T12th with 20 road RBI.

**A RAY OF SUNSHINE**...Ben Gamel has reached base safely in all 7 games he has appeared in vs. the Rays, including at least 1 hit in 6 games...overall is batting .423 (11x26) with 3 runs scored, 1 double, 1 triple, 1 RBI, 1 HBP and 4 walks.

**AS YOU KNOW**...dating back to May 23, the Mariners have not committed an error over the last 15 consecutive games (585 TC, 165 A), setting club records for most consecutive games and total chances without an error...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...since 1920 (live-ball era) the Mariners 15-game errorless streak is longest since the Boston Red Sox had an 18-game errorless streak in 2016 (9/13-10/1/16) and currently tied for the 6th-longest in the Major Leagues (also: Cincinnati 6/15-30/75, St. Louis 5/24-6/9/91, Texas 8/4-19/96, Toronto 8/19-9/4/08, Miami 9/19/14-4/11/15 & Oakland 6/25-7/9/16)?...the longest errorless game streak by a team is 18, accomplished by the 2009 Yankees (5/14-6/1/09) and the 2016 Red Sox (9/13-10/1/16).

**ABOUT GONZALES...**

- 26-year-old left-hander is making his 13th start of season, 34th career appearance (26th start) and 2nd career start vs. Tampa Bay.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 seasons (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002).

**LAST OUTING...**allowed 1 earned run on 5 hits and 2 walks while striking out 6 across 6.2 innings pitched...held the Rays scoreless for first 5 innings before allowing an RBI double to Wilson Ramos with two outs in the 6th inning...snapped streak of 24.1 innings pitched without allowing an earned run (5/17-6/2).

**GAS IN THE TANK...**has pitched 6.0-or-more innings in 7 of his last 8 starts and 8 of his 12 starts overall this season...is 5-1 with a 1.98 ERA (11 ER, 50.0 IP) with 14 walks and 40 strikeouts in his last 8 outings...prior to 2018, Gonzales had only reached the 6.0 inning mark in 1 start, on Aug. 30, 2014 vs. Chicago-NL with St. Louis (6.0,3,1,1,2,5).

**SETTLING IN...**in 6 starts since May 1, Gonzales has posted a 2.13 ERA (9 ER, 38.0 IP), the 6th best mark in the American League (12th overall)...his 0.35 ERA (1 ER, 26.0 IP) since May 15 leads ML starters...posted a 5.02 ERA (16 ER, 28.2 IP) in 6 starts in April.

**UNDER PRESSURE...**is 3-2 with a 2.58 ERA (11 ER, 38.1 IP) in 7 starts this season in which he has received 2 or fewer runs of support, holding opponents to a .260 average (38x146) and allowing 1 home run in those 7 outings...in 5 starts when receiving 3 or more runs of support, Gonzales is 3-1 with a 4.45 ERA (14 ER, 28.1 IP), with opponents batting .294 (32x109) with 4 home runs...Gonzales has started in 9 games decided by 2 or fewer runs this season, collecting a 5-1 record in those starts (team is 7-2 in those 9 games).

**2017 SEASON RECAP...**went 1-1 with a 6.08 ERA (27 ER, 40.0 IP) with 32 strikeouts and 11 walks in 11 games (8 starts)...was acquired from STL on 7/21/17 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill...posted a 5.40 ERA (22 ER, 36.2 IP) with 30 strikeouts and 11 walks in 10 games (7 starts) with Seattle.

**AAA RECAP...**combined for 13 AAA starts last season, 11 with AAA Memphis in the Cardinals organization and 2 with AAA Tacoma after being acquired by the Mariners...was 8-4 with a 3.14 ERA (28 ER, 80.1 IP) with 66 strikeouts and 22 walks in 13 combined starts...went 6-4 with a 2.90 ERA (22 ER, 68.1 IP) with 57 strikeouts and 17 walks in 11 starts with Memphis...was 2-0 with a 4.50 ERA (6 ER, 12.0 IP) with 9 strikeouts and 5 walks in 2 starts with Tacoma.

**BULLDOG ROOTS...**played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.

**POSTSEASON GLORY...**added to the Cardinals roster for the 2014 National League Division Series vs. Los Angeles-NL...made 3 appearances in the NLDS, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk...picked up the wins in Game 1 and Game 4 vs. the Dodgers...became the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodriguez-LAA, 2002)...in the 2014 NLCS vs. San Francisco, went 0-1 with a 9.00 ERA (3 ER, 3.0 IP) with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk in 3 appearances.

**ML CAREER...**in parts of 4 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is 11-6 with a 4.50 ERA (72 ER, 144.0 IP) with 123 strikeouts and 50 walks in 34 games (26 starts)...originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University.

**TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP FÉLIX HERNÁNDEZ (6-4, 5.33 ERA)**

32-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 389th Major League start tomorrow at Tampa Bay...W#6 in his last start, a quality start in the Mariners 4-3 win on 6/1 vs. TB (8.0,5,1,1,1,7)...has tossed 5.0+ innings and allowed 3 or fewer earned runs in 8 of his 13 starts this season...W#1 on Opening Day, a 2-1 Mariners win, on March 29 vs. CLE (5.1,2,0,0,2,4); was 11th Opening Day start, building on Mariners record...**SPRING TRAINING:** in 2 Cactus League starts, compiled a record of 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (2 ER, 5.0 IP) with 5 strikeouts and 1 walk...Félix exited his first spring start after 1.1 inning on 2/26 at CHC after being hit by a line drive on right forearm (1.1,1,1,1,0,2)...allowed 1 R over 3.0 innings in MiL game on 3/19 at SD-AAA (3.0,3,1,1,0,5)...threw 3.2 innings on 3/24 vs. CHC, allowing a leadoff home run before retiring 10 of the last 14 batters he faced (3.2,4,1,1,1,3)...**2017:** Went 6-5 with a 4.36 ERA (42 ER, 86.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 26 walks in 16 starts...placed on the 10-day DL on April 26 with right shoulder inflammation...activated on June 23 after making three rehab starts (6/6, 6/11, 6/17 w/AAA Tacoma)...spent a second stint on the 10-day DL on Aug. 5 (retro to Aug. 2) with right shoulder bursitis...activated on Sept. 14...**CAREER:** Signed as a non-drafted free agent July 4, 2002...has played his entire 14-year career with Seattle, going 166-118 with a 3.26 ERA (934 ER, 2576.2 IP)...is Seattle's all-time leader in wins (166), innings (2576.2), strikeouts (2,404) and starts (388)...6-time All-Star (2009, 2011-15), 2-time AL ERA champ (2010-2.27, 2014-2.14)...**vs. TB:** Will be making his 18th career start against the Rays...is 9-2 with a 1.89 ERA (27 ER, 128.2 IP) in 17 career starts vs. the Rays...won his last start vs. the Rays on June 3 (8.0,5,1,1,1,7)...threw the first perfect game in Mariners history on Aug. 15, 2012 vs. Tampa Bay (9.0,0,0,0,0,12).
