FISH BITES

The Marlins open 25th Anniversary Weekend with the first of three games tonight against the San Diego Padres at 7:10 p.m. Miami is starting LHP **Caleb Smith**, who is making his 13th start of the season and second against San Diego. In his only career appearance against the Padres, May 28 at Petco Park, he earned his fourth win of the season after allowing just one run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over a career high-tying 7.0 innings. The Padres are countering with LHP Eric Lauer, who took the loss in his matchup against Smith on May 28, allowing five runs on seven hits over 2.1 innings. Miami returns home after going 3-7 on an 10-game road trip to San Diego (1-3), Arizona (0-3) and St. Louis (2-1). The current homestand will continue with a four-game series against another NL West entry, the San Francisco Giants, Monday-Thursday. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami was unable to come away with a sweep, falling to the St. Louis Cardinals, 4-1, at Busch Stadium. The Cardinals scored twice in the first, before Miami scored its only run on a RBI-double by **Justin Bour** in the sixth. Bour was the star on offense, finishing with three of the Marlins four hits. **Brian Anderson** accounted for the other Miami hit, which extended his hitting streak to five games. **Trevor Richards** was recalled earlier in the day to make the start and took the loss, allowing three runs on seven hits with four strikeouts and no walks over 5.0 innings.

A SWING AND A MISS

Caleb Smith leads all National League rookies in strikeouts with 74, ahead of Cincinnati's Tyler Mahle (67), and ranks 12th in the NL overall. He ranks fifth in the National League and 12th in the Majors (min. 10 GS) with a strikeout rate of 29.6% (74/250). He trails Max Scherzer (39.3), Jacob deGrom (33.9), Patrick Corbin (32.7), and Kenda Maeda (30.3) in the NL. He owns a swing/miss percentage of 21.9% on pitches in the strike zone, fifth-best in the NL (eighth in MLB), behind Scherzer (26.5), deGrom (25.8), Luis Castillo (23.0), and Vince Velasquez (22.8) in the NL.

YOUTH ON DISPLAY

The Marlins and Padres have combined for 432 games played by rookies this season. Miami has 220 games played by rookies to lead the Majors, while San Diego ranks second with 212. Philadelphia ranks third at 196, followed by Cincinnati (173). - *Stats LLC*

SPRINT FOR FIRST

Since the start of 2016, the Marlins have scored first in 56.6% of their home games (107/189), marking the third-highest percentage in the Majors in that span. Cleveland has scored first in 57.1%, while San Francisco ranks second at 56.7.

ANTI-THEFT DEVICE

On April 5 at Philadelphia, the Phillies successfully stole three bases against **Bryan Holaday** before he caught César Hernández trying to steal third. Since then, Holaday has thrown out eight consecutive attempted base stealers, including one yesterday, marking the longest catcher caught stealing streak in Club history and is tied for the longest streak in the Majors this season (Salvador Perez). The previous record had been held by Benito Santiago, who caught seven straight in 1994. The last Major League player to record a streak as long or longer than Holaday's was Arizona's Miguel Montero, who cut down nine straight in August 2011. - *Stats LLC*

LOCKED DOWN

Marlins catchers have combined to throw out 17 runners this season, tied with Oakland for the most in the Majors. The Marlins 52.5 caught stealing percentage leads MLB, ahead of Washington (46.8) and Kansas City (38.2). Since 2016, Miami owns the fourth-best caught stealing percentage (35.5) in the Majors, behind Cleveland (36.9), Boston (35.6), and the Angels (35.6).

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 62 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (232), runs (32), hits (69), and on-base percentage (.373); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (20); ranks second in average (.297), walks (23), doubles (15), RBI (30), and slugging percentage (.418); and is tied for third in triples (2).

- Ranks second among National League players 25-younger in hits, behind Ozzie Albies (70).
- Is on pace to record 109 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie and would tie Rocco Baldelli for the third-most by any Major League rookie since 2000 (Ichiro-133 in 2001; Hideki Matsui-114 in 2003). Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 47 first-half RBI, which would tie Bruce Aven (1999) and Mike Jacobs (2006) for the second-most by a Marlins rookie, behind Dan Uggla's 51 in 2006.

MARLINS' GOOD STUDENT PROGRAM

The Miami Marlins today announced further details regarding its Good Student Program, a new community ticket program and core pillar of the organization's Baseball For Kids partnership with J.P. Morgan. The Good Student Program's inaugural edition in 2018 recognizes K-12 students in the public school systems of Miami-Dade County and Broward County who achieved perfect attendance and/or straight A grades during the 2017/2018 academic year. Eligible students - determined by each school system and estimated at more than 30,000 - will receive an invitation for two complimentary tickets to a Marlins home game of their choice between June 11 and August 12.

YEAR OF THE FAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Marlins, in partnership with AutoNation, America's largest automotive retailer, will be awarding a prize of a 24-month car lease to a select fan tonight, the eighth of 25 dates this season where a fan will drive off with a new car. The "Marlins Year of the Fan Sweepstakes, Driven by AutoNation" is open to any eligible fan in attendance at each select home date. Fans will be eligible for that date's drawing by scanning their valid, digital game ticket, stored on a mobile device, upon entry to Marlins Park prior to the end of the third inning. ➤ Caleb Smith is making his 13th start of the season tonight when the Marlins open their 25th Anniversary Weekend with the first of three games against San Diego at Marlins Park.

➤ Made first career Opening Day roster after going 0-2 with 5.21 ERA (19.0 ip/11 er) in six Spring outings (two starts). Acquired by Miami this offseason, along with INF Garrett Cooper on November 20, from Yankees.

➤ Tonight will mark his second career start against San Diego. The other was on May 28 of this season at Petco Park (W, 7.0 ip, 4 h, r, er, bb, 4 so, hr).

➤ This is his first start at home since May 17, after a string of three straight road starts. Has 1-2 record and 3.51 ERA (25.2/10) in five home starts, and is 3-4, 4.41 (34.2/17) in seven starts on the road.

➤ Leads all MLB rookies in strikeouts (74), ahead of Shohei Ohtani and Tyler Mahle (61 each).

➤ His 74 strikeouts are tied with Josh Johnson for fourth-most before the All-Star break by a rookie in Club history (third-most by a left-hander). Only José Fernández (103 in 2013), Scott Olsen (LH, 79 in 2006), and Dontrelle Willis (LH, 79 in 2003) had more.

➤ Among pitchers with at least 12 starts, ranks fourth in National League (11th in MLB) with a strikeout rate of 29.6% (74/250). He trails only Max Scherzer (39.3), Jacob deGrom (33.9), and Patrick Corbin (32.7) in the NL.

➤ Also among pitchers with at least 12 starts, ranks sixth in the NL (12th in MLB) in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (6.56). Trails only Scherzer (5.54), Corbin (6.06), Aaron Nola (6.30), Sean Newcomb (6.42), and Michael Wacha (6.46) in NL. Only José Fernández (5.79) had a better mark for a rookie in Club history (min. 1.0 IP per team game).

➤ Allowed five runs in his last start (June 2 at Arizona). In previous seven starts, had allowed more than two runs just once (four on May 17 vs. Dodgers). Over last eight starts, he is 4-4 with a 3.02 ERA (44.2/15) and a .181 average against (28x155).

➤ Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in nine of his 12 starts this season, and two-or-fewer in six of his last eight, including two games with zero runs allowed (over 7.0 ip on April 29 vs. COL, and over 5.2 ip on May 5 at CIN).

➤ Has five starts with one-or-zero runs allowed, tied for 8th in NL, behind leaders Mike Foltynewicz and Jacob deGrom (8 each).

➤ Is receiving just 2.98 runs of support during his outings, second-lowest mark among National League starters (min. 11 GS). Only Junjo Guerra (2.24) is receiving less run support.

➤ Earned first Major League win on April 29 vs. Colorado. Held Rox scoreless on two hits and a walk, while striking out nine, over a career-best 7.0 innings.

➤ Had a solid outing on April 22 at Milwaukee, despite taking a loss. Limited Brewers to two hits and two runs over 6.0 innings (a career high until his next start), with no walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts. Became 10th Marlins pitcher (17th time) to record as many as 10 strikeouts in a game without issuing a walk, following Dan Straily a year to the day on April 22 at San Diego (14 SO). April 22 was also witness to another such occurrence; José Fernández struck out 14 Braves at Turner Field in 2014.

➤ In first start of season, March 30 vs. Cubs, allowed just one run and four hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over 5.1 innings. Established single-game career highs in innings and strikeouts. Contest went 17 innings, tied for third-longest game by inning in Marlins history.

➤ Dan Straily is slated to start Game 2 of this three-game 25th Anniversary Weekend series against the Padres. It will mark his fourth career start against the Friars, his second this season following a 9-5 loss at Petco Park on May 29 (L, 5.2 ip, 7 h, 5 r, 4 er, 4 so, hr).

➤ In his two prior starts against San Diego, both for Miami in 2017, had not factored in a decision, despite allowing just two runs in each outing: over 7.0 innings on April 22 at Petco, and over 6.0 innings on August 27 at Marlins Park.

➤ In the April 22 start last season, he struck out 14 and did not walk a batter. Became 11th pitcher (16th time) in Club history to strike out 10-plus batters without issuing a walk, a feat that was matched exactly one year later in Milwaukee by tonight's starter, Caleb Smith.

➤ Miami had won his first five starts of the season before he suffered his loss to the Padres on May 29, and followed it with a loss in his last start, on June 3 at Arizona (4.1 ip, 2 h, r, er, 5 bb, 4 so).

➤ Did not walk a batter in the loss at San Diego, snapping a career-long streak of seven consecutive starts (since September 18, 2017) in which he issued three-or-more free passes.

➤ Allowed four earned runs in his season debut on April 30, but has allowed two-or-fewer in five of his six starts since, posting a 2.81 ERA (32.0 ip/10 er) over that span.
