## NATIONALS NEWS

### MOVING ON...

Following Thursday's home opener against the New York Mets, the Washington Nationals enjoyed a day off on Friday before resuming the series against New York on Saturday afternoon.

- The opening homestand will feature visits from the Mets (2 G), Atlanta Braves (3 G) and Colorado Rockies (4 G).

### ROSTER MOVES

Prior to today's game, the Nationals recalled infielder/outfielder **Matt Reynolds** and selected the contract of catcher **Jhonatan Solano** from Triple-A Syracuse...They placed catcher **Miguel Montero** on the paternity list and designated for assignment left-handed pitcher **Enny Romero**.

### IT STARTS AT THE TOP

Through the first six games, **Adam Eaton** is 10-for-22 (.455) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, three walks and 10 runs scored...He has reached base safely in each of his first six games...Eaton leads the National League in batting average (.455), slugging percentage (.864) and is tied for first with 10 runs scored... He also ranks among National League hitters in on-base percentage (2nd, .618) and hits (T2nd, 10).

- Although he has only played in 29 games for Washington since the start of the 2017 season, Eaton has scored 34 runs in those 29 games...All told, he is hitting .327 with 10 doubles, one triple, four homers, 18 RBI, 17 walks and 34 runs scored in 29 games as a National.

### TONY! TONY! TONY!

**Anthony Rendon** went 3-for-3 with two doubles, one RBI and one walk on Thursday and has now hit safely in seven straight games to start the season...His seven-game hitting streak to start the season is the second-longest to start a season in his career...He started the 2014 season on a nine-game hitting streak.

### BRYCE BEING BRYCE

**Bryce Harper** ranks among National League hitters in home runs (T1st, 4), slugging percentage (2nd, .857), walks (2nd, 10), RBI (T3rd, 9), and on-base percentage (6th, .485).

- With 430 RBI for his career, Harper is just two RBI shy of tying **Ian Desmond** (432) for second-most in Nationals history behind **Ryan Zimmerman** (938).

### HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

**Howie Kendrick** has reached base safely in each of his first six games of the season...He has hit safely in five of the games and he was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded three multi-hit efforts and four of his eight hits have been doubles...His four doubles are tied for second in the National League.

### RIZZO EXTENSION

On Thursday morning, the Washington Nationals announced a two-year contract extension for President of Baseball Operations and General Manager **Mike Rizzo**, keeping him with the club through the 2020 season.

- "Mike's commitment to our shared goal of bringing a World Championship to Washington, D.C. makes this an exciting day for our family and the Washington Nationals," said **Theodore N. Lerner**, Managing Principal Owner of the Washington Nationals. "Mike and his staff have built quite a team—one that brings excitement to our ballpark every night and gives our city something to be proud of."
- "I'm proud of the progress we've made in Washington, DC, building the Nationals from nearly expansion status into one of the winningest clubs in Major League Baseball," **Rizzo** said. "I appreciate the Lerner family for giving me the continued opportunity to see what we can accomplish in the future."

### OFFENSIVE RANKS

Washington leads the National League with 39 walks...The Nationals are tied for the National League lead in home runs (12) while ranking tied for third in runs scored (39), third in slugging percentage (.440) and fourth in on-base percentage (.358)...Nationals hitters have struck out just 58 times this season, sixth-fewest in the National League.

### NO INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have inherited nine runners so far this season, with only one coming around to score (11.1%)...They are one of nine teams in Major League Baseball (one of five in the NL) to allow no more than one inherited runner to come around to score in 2018.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### April 7 (4-7 on this date)

2005 - For the fourth time in his career, **Jose Vidro** hit a game-winning extra-inning homer, a solo shot in the 10th inning off Real Cormier, and the Nationals edged the Phillies, 5-4. With the rubber-game win, the Nationals win their first road series.

The group enjoys a behind-the-scenes look at team operations, a private meet and greet with Rendon as well as special batting practice viewing and tickets complete with NatsBucks.

Nationals second baseman **Daniel Murphy** spent seven seasons (2008-15) with the New York Mets...Washington's hitting coach **Kevin Long** served as New York's hitting coach from 2015-17 and bench coach **Chip Hale** served as their third base coach from 2010-11.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #47 - GIO GONZALEZ - LHP

Electric left-hander enters seventh NL season with the Nationals...In six years with the Nationals, is 79-54 with a 3.49 ERA in 186 starts...Ranks second on Washington's all-time (2005-pres.) wins list with 79...Is Washington's most prolific left-handed pitcher, leading Nationals southpaws in nearly every pitching category...Leads Nationals (2005-pres.) lefties in wins (80), innings pitched (1,113.2), and strikeouts (1,096), among other categories...Has made 30-or-more starts seven of the last eight seasons.

**AGAINST THE METS:** Has been strong against the New York Mets in his career...Is 14-5 with a 2.93 ERA in 23 career starts against them...Faced them three times in 2017, going 3-0 with 2.25 ERA (5 ER/20.0 IP)...Since Sept. 25, 2014, has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 10 of 11 starts against New York, including three scoreless outings...Is 8-1 with a 2.39 ERA (18 ER/67.2 IP) during this stretch.

**LAST START:** Opened the season with 6.0 strong innings as Washington completed the sweep of the Cincinnati Reds, 6-5...Allowed one earned run on five hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

### 2017 NOTES

- Put together a season that garnered National League Cy Young Award attention (finished sixth) and worthy of All-Star status (was inexplicably left off the NL squad).
- Gonzalez (5th, 2.96), coupled with **Max Scherzer** (2nd, 2.51) and **Stephen Strasburg** (3rd, 2.52), helped the Nationals become the first team with three starting pitchers ranking in the top five in the National League in ERA in 21 years (since the 1996 Atlanta Braves), according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*... Washington was the first team in MLB to do this since the 2002 Boston Red Sox.
- Gonzalez' 15 wins, 1.18 WHIP, 2.96 ERA, .216 opp. AVG, and 22 quality starts were his best marks since his first season in Washington.
- In addition to ERA, he also ranked in the NL in opp. SLG (3rd, .345), opp. AVG (5th, .216) and opp. OBP (9th, .298).
- Against left-handed batters, ranked among MLB starting pitchers in opp. SLG (1st, .256), opp. AVG (3rd, .183), and opp. OBP (4th, .251).
- Was stingy with runners in scoring position, ranking first in NL (second in MLB) with a .175 opp AVG w/RISP.
- Posted a then team-best 17.0 scoreless innings streak from July 26 to Aug. 9.
- Went 5-0 with a 0.79 ERA (3 ER/34.1 IP), 25 strikeouts, one home run and a .175 opponent AVG during a five-game winning streak, July 31 to Aug. 26...That five-game winning streak matched the longest of his career (May 5-27, 2012)...Posted a 0.79 ERA (3 ER/34.1 IP) with a .175 opp. AVG during the streak.
- Flirted with a no-hitter on July 31 at MIA (8.0 IP, 3 BB, 5 SO) in Washington's 1-0 win...Surrendered a ninth-inning single to **Dee Gordon**, breaking up the bid.
- Tossed a season-high 8.1 innings on July 14 at CIN (8.1 IP, 4 H, 2 BB, 6 SO).

### CAREER NOTES

- His 80 wins are sixth among MLB left-handed pitchers the last six seasons...Ranks fourth among big league southpaws in that span with a .235 batting average against.
- Since 2012, is 70-5 with a 2.91 ERA in 93 starts when receiving more than two runs of offensive support...Is 83-1 with a 2.83 ERA in 105 starts when getting four or more runs of offensive support in his career.
