WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost three straight games as they continue a season-long, 10-game trip this afternoon with the finale in Texas.
- RHP Reynaldo López is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who are a season-high tying 26 games under .500 (third time).
- The Sox have lost the first two games of this series by a combined 24-7 margin, allowing seven home runs.
- Following today's game, the White Sox continue the trip with three games in Cincinnati (7/2-4) and four in Houston (7/5-8) before ending the first half with a five-game, six-day homestand vs. St. Louis (7/10-11) and Kansas City (7/13-15).
- The Sox went 4-3 on their last homestand vs. Oakland (2-2) and Minnesota (2-1) from 6/22-28 and 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland from 6/18-20.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are looking to avoid their first three-game sweep in Texas since 8/28-30/07.
- The Sox have allowed five runs in their three wins vs. the Rangers this season and 36 in the three losses.
- Chicago has lost five straight road games by a combined 48-12 margin, allowing 36 runs in the last three.
- Sox pitchers have posted a 7.26 ERA (104 ER/129.0 IP) in their last 15 games vs. Texas, allowing 10-plus runs six times.
- The Sox are 3-28 (.107) with RISP over the last two games.
- Avisail García has homered three times in his last five games (once in first 22).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Texas scored seven runs in the eighth inning to break open a 6-4 game and went on to post a 13-4 victory over the White Sox.
- Carlos Rodón suffered the loss, allowing five runs on six hits over 5.1 IP ... Luis Avilán (2 ER/0.1 IP) and Bruce Rondón (5 ER/0.1 IP) combined to allow all the runs in the eighth.
- Matt Davidson matched his career high with three hits (seventh time), going 3-4 with a double, home run (No. 14) and two runs scored ... Davidson became the first Sox position player since at least 1913 to pitch in a game and subsequently homered in the next game (STATS).
- Avisail García hit his fourth home run, and Yolmer Sánchez was 2-4 with a double and RBI after missing Friday's game with a left quad contusion.

LAST NIGHT ON THE FARM

- Class AAA Charlotte RHP Michael Kopech, the No. 11 prospect in baseball per MLB Pipeline, allowed one earned run on three hits with eight strikeouts over 6.0 IP in a loss vs. Gwinnett ... Kopech owns a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP) with 17 strikeouts over his last two starts.
- Class AA Birmingham LHP Bernardo Flores threw 7.0 scoreless IP vs. Jacksonville to lower his ERA to 1.29 (2 ER/14.0 IP) over two starts with the Barons.
- DH Micker Adolfo, the No. 10 prospect in the Sox system, hit a two-run homer in the 10th inning to lift Class A Winston-Salem to a 6-3 win at Wilmington ... CF Luis González went 4-5 to raise his average to .421 (16-38) in eight games with the Dash, and 1B Gavin Sheets was 3-5 with a double and RBI to extend his hitting streak to 13 games, the longest active in the Carolina League.
- Winston-Salem, the CL first-half Southern Division champion, leads the league in slugging percentage (.422), runs scored (405) and doubles (159) and ranks second in OPS (.767), average (.271) and home runs (66).

POWERFUL PROSPECT PIPELINE

- The White Sox farm system features eight of the Top 100 prospects in baseball according to MLB Pipeline's latest rankings, tied with Atlanta for the most in the major leagues.
- OF Eloy Jimenez (No. 3) is the highest rated Sox prospect, followed by RHP Michael Kopech (11), OF Luis Robert (25), RHPs Dylan Cease (42), Alec Hansen (48) and Dane Dunning (55), OF Blake Rutherford (83) and C Zack Collins (96).

PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game ... as of 6/26, Abreu has received 1,032,748 votes to widen his lead over Houston's Yuli Gurriel (714,361) and Boston's Mitch Moreland (644,728).
- Abreu is the first White Sox player to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at first base in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter to the All-Star Team, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).

WHITE SOX VS. TEXAS RANGERS

- The season series is tied, 3-3.
- The Sox are hitting .250/.304/.390 (50-200) with a 6.23 ERA (36 ER/52.0) this season but have been outscored, 41-24.
- The Sox have gone 4-1-1 in the last six season series.
- The White Sox lead the all-time series, 268-247, going 154-99 at home (73-47 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 114-148 on the road (46-62 at Globe Life Park).

WINDY CITY AND LONE STAR CONNECTIONS

- White Sox RHP Joakim Soria (2013-14), INF Leury García (2013) and third-base coach Nick Capra (1982-83, '85, '91) all played for the Rangers.
- Rangers RHP Bartolo Colón (2003, '09) and bench coach Don Wakamatsu (1991) played for the Sox ... first-base coach Steve Buechele originally was selected by the White Sox with the ninth overall pick in the 1979 draft out of Servite (Calif.) High School but did not sign.

WILD WILD WEST

- The White Sox are 6-13 vs. the American League West in 2018, going 5-8 at home and 0-5 on the road ... they have won five of their last 12 games after losing their first six.
- The Sox are 184-167 vs. the AL West since 2008, including a 107-71 record at home.

SIGN HERE, PLEASE

- The White Sox have agreed to terms with OF Steele Walker from the University of Oklahoma and LHP Konnor Pilkington from Mississippi State University, their second and third-round picks from the First-Year Player Draft.
- INF Nick Madrigal, the Sox first-round pick (No. 4 overall) from NCAA champion Oregon State, is the only Sox Top 10 selection who remains unsigned ... Madrigal and the Beavers completed their season on Thursday with a 5-0 victory over Arkansas.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY

- The White Sox have made a major-league leading 1,348 quality starts since the start of the 2003 season, one more than the second-place New York Mets (1,347) and 41 more than Oakland (1,306), the next-closest American League team.

BULLPEN RELIEF

- Despite allowing seven earned runs in 2.2 IP last night, the White Sox bullpen owns a 3.14 ERA (52 ER/149.0 IP) in 46 games since 5/13.
- Joakim Soria has made 13 straight scoreless appearances (12.2 IP), converting all seven save chances with five hits allowed, two walks and 13 strikeouts.
- Jace Fry owns a 1.82 ERA (5 ER/24.2 IP) with 32 strikeouts and a .138 (12-87) opponents average in 25 games this season.
- Xavier Cedeño has made 11 straight scoreless appearances (9.1 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

30/30 THREAT

- SS Tim Anderson (13 HR/17 SB) is one of nine players in the major leagues this season with at least 10 home runs and 10 stolen bases and one of three shortstops, along with Cleveland's Francisco Lindor and Colorado's Trevor Story.
- Anderson is on pace to record career highs with 26 homers and 34 stolen bases ... the 26 home runs would be the third-highest total in Sox history by a shortstop behind José Valentín (30 in 2004 and 28 in 2003), and the 34 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).

STOP! THIEF!

- The White Sox are tied for the major-league lead with 64 stolen bases ... the Sox are on pace to steal 126, which would be their most since 2010 (160) ... they have not led the majors in steals since 1966 (153).

TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox are tied for second in the major leagues this season with 23 triples ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez is tied for the major-league lead with eight triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

ON DECK: CINCINNATI REDS

- The White Sox continue the trip tomorrow with an interleague matchup at Cincinnati ... RHP James Shields (3-9, 4.29) is scheduled to start the opener of the three-game series.
- The Sox lead the all-time interleague series, 16-4, going 6-2 at home and 10-2 in Cincinnati ... they won two of three games in the last matchup in 2015 in Chicago and two of three in the last series at Great American Ballpark in 2009.

1990: New York's Andy Hawkins throws a no-hitter but the Yankees suffer a 4-0 loss to the White Sox in the final season at old Comiskey Park ... three Yankees errors in the eighth inning lead to four unearned runs off Hawkins, who is not credited with an official no-hitter since the Sox did not bat in the bottom of the ninth.

LÓPEZ AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 17th start of the season, 10th on the road and second against Texas.
- Has allowed a home run in each of his last three starts, going 1-1 with a 5.94 ERA (11 ER/16.2 IP).
- Is 1-4 with a 4.72 ERA (25 ER/ 47.2 IP) in nine road starts.
- Went 3-0 with a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) over his final four starts of 2017 ... made his White Sox debut on 8/11/17 vs. Kansas City, receiving a no decision after allowing two runs with six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.
- Was named the White Sox Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July 2017 after posting a 2.10 ERA (7 ER/30.0 IP) with 38 strikeouts and a .183 (20-109) opponents average over five starts.
- Was acquired from Washington with RHPs Dane Dunning and Lucas Giolito in exchange for OF Adam Eaton on 12/7/16 ... originally was signed by the Nationals as a non-drafted free agent on 6/21/12.

LAST START

- Earned his third win of the season on 6/26 vs. Minnesota ... allowed four runs on six hits over 6.1 IP.
- Allowed a solo home run to Brian Dozier in the second inning and Ehire Adrianza in the third.
- Departed with the White Sox trailing, 3-2, after tossing 98 pitches (64 strikes) ... the Sox went on to win, 8-4, after we the Sox took the lead in the sixth inning.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

- Is making his 19th career start on the road ... has gone 5-7 with a 5.10 ERA (51 ER/90.0 IP), 76 strikeouts and a .272 (95-349) opponents average in his career.
- Owns a 1-4 record with a 4.72 ERA (25 ER/47.2 IP) in nine road starts this season, compared to 2-1 with a 2.72 ERA (14 ER/46.1 IP), 28 strikeouts and a .194 (32-165) opp. average in seven starts at home.
- Suffered the loss in his last road start on 6/20 at Cleveland ... allowed five runs (four earned) on six hits over 4.1 IP.

HELP WANTED

- Owns a 3.45 run support average (36 RS/94.0 IP) in 2018, the ninth-lowest in the American League and 13th-lowest in the majors.
- Has received three runs or less of support in 11 of his 16 starts, including zero runs five times.
- Received a 7.55 RSA (40 RS/47.2 IP) in eight starts last season.

MAKING HISTORY

- Is the first White Sox pitcher with 6.0-plus IP, two-or-fewer hits allowed, and one-or-fewer runs allowed in each of his first two starts of the season (source: Elias).
- Became the first White Sox starting pitcher since at least 1908 to lose a game in which he thre 7.0-plus IP while allowing two or less hits and one run which was unearned (source: Baseball Reference and STATS LLC) ... the last five pitchers to accomplish this feat:

2017 REVIEW

- Made eight starts with the White Sox in his first season with the organization ... went 1-2 with a 3.56 ERA (12 ER/3.0 IP) in five starts at home and 2-1 with a 6.75 mark (13 ER/17.1 IP) over three road starts.
- Five of his seven starts were quality ... went 2-2 with a 3.15 ERA (11 ER/30.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts in those outings.
- Worked a career-high tying 7.0 IP (four runs) in a win on 9/16 at Detroit ... allowed three runs in the second inning before limiting the Tigers to one run on five hits over his final 5.0 IP.
- Suffered his first loss with the White Sox on 8/17 at Texas, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP before exiting game with soreness on his right side.
- Was placed on the disabled list on 8/19 (retro to 8/18) with a back strain ... reinstated on 9/1, made the start that night vs. Tampa Bay (L; 3 ER/6.0 IP).
- Made 22 starts with Class AAA Charlotte, going 6-7 with a 3.79 ERA (51 ER/121.0 IP) and 131 strikeouts ... allowed two earned runs or less in seven of his final eight starts from 6/29-8/6 before being promoted.
- Entered the season ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 Prospect in the White Sox organization and No. 31 in baseball ... was rated by MLB.com as the No. 4 Prospect in the Sox system, No. 38 in baseball and the No. 9 right-handed pitching prospect.

PERSONAL NOTES

- His grandfather sold two cows in the Dominican Republic to buy him a used glove, a pair of cleats and an aluminum bat when he started playing baseball.

VS. AMERICAN LEAGUE WEST

- Is making his sixth career start against the American League West.
- Has gone 1-2 with a 3.99 ERA (13 ER/29.1 IP), 33 strikeouts and .189 (20-106) opponents average in five starts against the division lifetime.
- Received the win in his last start on 5/29 vs. Texas, tossing 8.0 scoreless IP while allowing just two hits with eight strikeouts.

VS. TEXAS RANGERS

- Is scheduled to make his third career start vs. the Texas Rangers ... is 1-1 with a 4.38 ERA (6 ER/12.1 IP), 14 strikeouts and a .159 (7-44) opponents average.
- Received the win in his last start on 5/20 at Guaranteed Rate Field, tossing 8.0 scoreless IP while allowing just two hits with eight strikeouts ... suffered the loss in his last start at Globe Life Park on 8/17/17, allowing six runs on five hits over 4.1 IP including, a two-run home run to Brett Nicholas in the third inning.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- RHP James Shields (3-9, 4.29) is scheduled to make his 18th start of the season, sixth on the road and first against the Cincinnati Reds.
- Is 1-4 with a 5.97 ERA (21 ER/31.2 IP) and .238 (29-122) opponents average over six games (five starts) on the road this season.
- Earned his third win of the season on 6/27 vs. Minnesota, tossing 7.0 scoreless IP while allowing just four hits ... it was his 10th quality start of the season (seven total QS in 2017).
- Is 18-18 with a 4.57 ERA (156 ER/307.0 IP), 274 strikeouts and a .266 (319-1199) opponents average in 50 career games (49 starts) in interleague play ... has gone 23-140 (.167) with three doubles, six RBI and 15 runs scored as a hitter lifetime.
- Is 0-2 with a 6.08 ERA (9 ER/13.1 IP), 17 strikeouts and a .255 (13-51) opponents average in two career starts against Cincinnati.
