WHEN IN THE COURSE OF HUMAN EVENTS...: On Independence Day, the Padres fell 4-2 to the Athletics at the Oakland Coliseum, getting swept by the A's in the brief two-get set for their second-straight series opposite their Interleague foe...the four-game losing stretch vs. OAK is the Padres longest against them since they lost five-straight from June 5, 2000-June 13, 2001...the Padres are now 6-3 on July 4th since 2010.

- **Luis Perdomo** made his first start since April 18 vs. LAD, working a season-high 5.2 innings and allowing two runs (earned) on four hits.
- **Christian Villanueva** homered for his club-leading 17th time, **Freddy Galvis** went 2-for-4 for his 20th multi-hit game and **Wil Myers** collected his first multi-walk game of the season.

A TALE OF TWO ERICS: Prior to the month of June, starter **Eric Lauer** had a 7.67 ERA, and after June 1, he's owned a 2.76 ERA...the -.491 ERA difference is the largest of any pitcher this season pre-June and in June (minimum 25 IP in both splits).

ALL HAIL ERIC, PRINCE OF PICKOFFS: **Eric Lauer** leads the majors with seven pickoffs (SEA's Marco Gonzales has second-most with six)...he's the first rookie to have seven-or-more pickoffs since Julio Teheran's eight in 2013...the Friars combined 13 pickoffs headline the majors (with NYM on their heels with 12).

CHASE-ING HITS: The Padres pitching staff has held D-Back bats to a .191 average (17-for-89) in three games this season (April 20-22 at Chase Field)...the Padres offense, however, has amassed just a .175 clip vs. D-Back arms in that time (17-for-97) and just a .208 OBP.

RISPECT THE SITUATION: The Padres' batting average with RISP/2 out is .269, leading the NL and trailing only OAK (.272) for the highest in baseball...the Friars' .794 OPS with RISP/2 out is the second-highest in the NL (behind ATL's .828) and ranks fifth-highest in the majors.

'TIS TIME TO TURN THE TABLES: After being swept in Oakland, the Padres have dropped six-straight series since June 14 (4-14)...the losing stretch commenced after the club won five-straight series from May 28-June 13 (11-5)...SD has won just one of their last six games and two of their last 10.

SPLIT IT UP: This season, **Jose Pirela** has hit .246 with no runners on base...with runners on, he's hit .283, with RISP, he's hit .299 and with RISP/2 outs, he's hit .357...the Padres have followed this pattern, having hit .223 with nobody on, .251 with runners on, .258 with RISP and .269 with RISP/2 out.

ON THE ROAD...AGAIN...: The Padres are on the road once again, having played 17 of their 27 June games on the road...by the end of the current trip (@ OAK and @ ARI), the Friars will have played 23 of their last 28 games since June 8 away from Petco Park.

OH, HAPPY DAY!: Join the Padres in wishing bullpen coach, **Doug Bochtler**, a wonderful birthday!

PADRES ON DECK: On Wednesday night, LHP **MacKenzie Gore**, 19, allowed four hits and two walks with six strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings for Fort Wayne (A), picking up his first win of the season...for El Paso (AAA), **Luis Urias** went 4-for-5 with a triple, a walk, two RBI and three runs scored...he hit an RBI triple and scored a run in the Chihuahuas' game-winning, two-run rally in the top of the 11th.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#46 LHP ERIC LAUER (3-5, 5.08)

LAUER HOUR: 23-year-old **Eric Lauer** (who celebrated his birthday on June 3) is set to make his 14th career start and first against the Arizona Diamondbacks, the last of the National League West foes to face-off against.

- His first three career starts came at COL, at SF and vs. LAD...he faced SF for a second time on 6/24 at AT&T Park...in his four career starts against the NL West, he has gone 1-1 with a 4.50 ERA (10 ER, 20.0 IP) with 19 SO against eight walks.

LAST TIME OUT: Tagged with the loss in the Padres' 6-3 defeat on 6/20 vs. PIT, allowing a career-high nine hits and six runs (three earned) across 5.0 IP.

JUNE BLOOM: After posting a 7.67 ERA from April-May (his first seven starts), he tallied a 2.76 mark in June (his past six outings) for a -4.91 ERA differential.

- His -4.91 ERA differential ranked first among all ML pitchers that tossed at least 25.0 IP from March-May and also at least 25.0 IP in June.
- His ERA improved -1.23 points better than the next closest pitcher (TEX's **Mike Minor**, -3.68), followed by TOR's **Marco Estrada** (-3.33), PIT's **Ivan Nova** (-3.21) and MIN's **Lance Lynn** (-3.11).

ONE TEAM, ONE DREAM: The Padres are now 3-10 when Lauer toes the rubber, having lost each of his last three outings...his 3.63 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) is the fifth-lowest among all NL starters (min. 13 games started).

- When the southpaw rookie gets two-or-more runs of support from the Padres offense (happened in six of his 13 starts), he is 3-0 with a 2.78 ERA (10 ER, 32.1 IP) and a 1.42 WHIP with just two home runs allowed... when he gets one run or less of support (happened in seven of his 13 starts), he's 0-4 with a 7.58 ERA (25 ER, 29.2 IP) with a .362 opponent average and a 2.12 WHIP with eight home runs allowed.

GET TO 5.0: Lauer has works 5.0-or-more innings in six consecutive starts...when throwing at least 5.0 IP, he owns a 3-2 record, a 2.54 ERA (14 ER, 49.2 IP), .281 opponent average and 1.47 WHIP...when he tosses less than 5.0 innings, he has a 0-3 record, 15.32 ERA (21 ER, 12.1 IP) with a .456 opponent average and a 2.92 WHIP.

ERIC'S ARSENAL: Lauer has relied on four pitches this season: four seamer (59.8%), cutter (25.6%), curve (10.9%), and changeup (3.7%)

PICKOFF ARTISTS: Lauer's seven pickoffs lead the majors, one ahead of SEA **Marco Gonzales'** six.

- Recorded pickoffs in five straight starts from 5/22-6/13, the longest pickoff streak in SD history and tied for the second-longest in ML history with four others...Andy Pettitte had the longest streak (eight straight in 1997).
- **Lauer** (seven) and fellow rookie lefty **Joey Lucchesi** (three) have combined for 10 pickoffs this season...it's the most pickoffs by a Padre rookie duo in franchise history.
- The Padres 13 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of the NYM's 12.

LEARNING LESSON: Became the first Padres starting pitcher since Ben Howard on Sept. 14, 2003 at LAD to allow three home runs in an inning on 5/11 vs. STL., which occurred in the top of the third...allowed a career-high seven runs (six earned) on seven hits and a walk in SD' 9-5 loss...earned his third career win the next time he faced the Cardinals lineup on 6/13, tossing 5.2 IP of two-run ball in SD's 4-2 victory.

CHECK THE SPLITS: Lauer has walked five left-handed batters this season and yielded 22 free passes to right-handed hitters...lefties have also accrued just four RBI off the southpaw, while righties have combined for 33 RBI.

HISTORIA: Earned his first career win on 5/6 vs. LAD in Monterrey, Mexico, tossing 6.0-shutout innings behind a career-high 102 pitches and five strikeouts against one walk in the Padres' 3-0 victory.

- Became the first and only SD pitcher to get his first career ML win in a game played outside the US and Canada...also just the second starter to get such a win and the fifth pitcher (starter or reliever) to do so.
- At 22 years and 337 days old on 5/6, he was the fifth-youngest pitcher in the NL to record a win this season.

TOMORROW'S STARTER

JOEY'S BACK: LHP **Joey Lucchesi** is set to make his fourth start since returning from the disabled list on 6/20 with a right hip strain that forced him to miss 32 team games.

- In his first start back on 6/20 vs. OAK, lasted a career-low 1.2 IP on three hits and four runs.
- In his ensuing two starts on 6/25 at TEX and 6/30 vs. PIT, he has gone 1-0 in a combined 9.0-shutout IP, allowing just two total hits.

- Owns a 3.63 ERA in 17 games on the road and a 2.37 ERA in 17 games at Petco Park.
- Posted a streak of 29 consecutive appearances (37.0 IP) without allowing a home run to begin his ML career (3/29-6/17)...no other reliever has thrown more than 35.0 innings without giving up a home run this season.
- Throws a first-pitch strike 66.3 percent of the time, leading the Padres bullpen.
- His 42.2 IP leads in the SD bullpen (among relievers yet to make a start).

- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 41 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (49).
- 51.6 percent of his pitches this season have been sliders...228 of his sliders have been thrown for strikes, the highest total among major league relievers this season.
