NATIONALS NEWS

#SCHERZDAY

The Washington Nationals open a three-game series against the St. Louis Cardinals on Monday afternoon... **Max Scherzer**, a native of Chesterfield, Missouri, enters this start with 249 strikeouts this season and is approaching his fifth straight 250+ strikeout season...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, his current four-season streak is tied for the second-longest streak in MLB history:

DOING JUAN SOTO THINGS

Juan Soto has hit safely in eight of his last nine games and has produced multi-hit efforts in four straight contests...The four-game multi-hit streak is the longest by a Nationals player this season...During his nine-game stretch, Soto is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with two doubles, one homer, eight RBI, four walks and five runs scored.

- Soto leads all MLB rookies (min. 385 PA) in on-base percentage (.417) and OPS (.937).
- He leads all National League rookies (min. 385 PA) in slugging percentage (.520) and batting average (.303).
- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies in walks (1st, 63), runs (2nd, 63), RBI (2nd, 53), home runs (3rd, 16), doubles (T3rd, 20) and hits (T3rd, 98).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in walks (4th, 63), OBP (4th, .417), runs (T4th, 63) and OPS (6th, .937).
- Among all NL hitters (min. 385 PA), he ranks in OBP (2nd, .417), OPS (5th, .937) and SLG (11th, .520).

STATUS CHECK

Since the All-Star break, Washington's offense ranks in the National League in on-base percentage (1st, .340), slugging percentage (2nd, .444), runs (2nd, 214), batting average (2nd, .269), stolen bases (3rd, 28), doubles (3rd, 77) and walks (3rd, 138).

- Nationals hitters have struck out 313 times since the All-Star break, the second-fewest in the National League behind the Atlanta Braves (313).

SAVING GRACE

In 23 outings dating to July 4, **Matt Grace** has pitched to a 1.78 ERA (5 ER/25.1 IP) while striking out 23 batters and issuing just six walks...He has surrendered just five extra-base hits during this stretch (4 2B, HR).

- Among National League left-handed relievers, Grace ranks in walks per 9.0 IP (4th, 1.94), strikeout-to-walk ratio (8th, 4.00), opp. OBP (8th, .286) and WHIP (10th, 1.14).

TURNING THE HITS

Trea Turner has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games dating to Aug. 21...During this stretch, he is 16-for-50 (.320) with two doubles, one homer, four RBI, four walks, three stolen bases and seven runs scored...Turner has not been held hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5.

- Turner leads the nationals with 39 multi-hit games this season and his career-high 151 hits rank eighth in the National League.

ADAM'S EATIN

Adam Eaton has hit safely in seven of his last eight games, producing multi-hit efforts in four of the eight... He has scored one run in four straight games...He is 13-for-35 (.371) with three doubles, a triple, a homer, three RBI, two walks and six runs scored during this stretch.

ZIM'S WORLD

Since Aug. 7, **Ryan Zimmerman** is hitting .325 with nine doubles, six homers, 17 RBI, 11 walks, one stolen base and 10 runs scored...He has reached base safely in 20 of the 24 games, posting a .402 on-base percentage and a .663 slugging percentage.

- Since July 23, his first start back after the All-Star Break, he ranks among National League hitters in doubles (T1st, 12), SLG (5th, .623) and OPS (5th, 1.016).

NATIONALS HISTORY

September 3 (9-3 on this date)

2014 — **Adam LaRoche** hit a game-tying, two-run pinch-hit homer in the ninth inning off Kenley Jansen and then, in the 14th, with his aching body at near revolt, legged out an RBI fielder's choice as the Nationals bested the Dodgers, 8-5, at Dodger Stadium. The five hour, 34-minute getaway day game was — at that point — the longest in the 10-year history of the Nationals.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with Detroit (2010-14) and Arizona (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times...Enters this start ranked 46th on MLB's all-time strikeout list and sixth among active players.

AGAINST THE CARDINALS: Is 2-4 with a 2.70 ERA in eight career starts against his hometown club...Allowed one earned run in 13.0 IP (0.69 ERA) in two starts against them in 2017...Struck out 22 batters against just four walks.

LAST START: Turned in his shortest start since April 4 at Atlanta, tossing 5.0 innings in Washington's 5-4 win at Philadelphia on Aug. 28...Allowed three earned runs on four hits with five strikeouts.

2018 NOTES

- Leads National League pitchers in strikeouts (249), strikeouts per 9.0 IP (12.01), hits per 9.0 IP (5.79), WHIP (0.88), strikeout-to-walk ratio (5.53), opp. AVG (.179), opp. OBP (.241) and wins (16)...He ranks in the NL in ERA (2nd, 2.22), opp. OPS (3rd, .567) and opp. SLG (4th, .326).
- Is 4-1 with a 1.73 ERA (10 ER/52.0 IP) over his last eight starts...Has struck out 67 batters while walking 11.
- Tossed 20.0 consecutive scoreless innings from Aug. 7 to Aug. 23...It is the longest streak by a Nationals pitcher in 2018.
- Had a six-game winning streak in eight from July 7- Aug. 17...Posted a 2.00 ERA (13 ER/54.0 IP) and 60 SO.
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 15 starts, the third-most in MLB and second-most in the National League.
- Recorded his 200th strikeout of the season on July 27 at MIA (Bour)...Per *Elías*, his streak of seven 200+ strikeout seasons is tied for second in MLB history behind **Tom Seaver** (NYM, 9, 1968-1976), and with **Roger Clemens** (BOS, 7, 1986-1992) and **Walter Johnson** (WSH, 7, 1910-1916).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout w/WSH on July 2 vs. BOS, becoming the 11th pitcher in MLB history to collect at least 1,000 strikeouts with two different clubs...The list, according to *Elías*: **Jim Bunning** (DET/PHI), **Roger Clemens** (BOS/NYY), **Randy Johnson** (ARI/SEA), **Mark Langston** (ANA/SEA), **Greg Maddux** (CHI/ATL), **Mike Mussina** (BAL/NYY), **Nolan Ryan** (CAL/HOU), **CC Sabathia** (CLE/NYY), **Luis Tiant** (BOS/CLE) and **Cy Young** (BOS/CLE).
- Recorded a nine-game winning streak from (4/9-6/5) which tied the second-longest streak of his career (13 G; 4/6-7/3/13 and 9 G; 8/20/16-4/7/17)...It is the longest winning streak in Major League Baseball in 2018.
- Did not earn the win, but struck out a season-high 15 batters on May 6 vs. PHI...It was his fifth career 15+ strikeout game...He became the first pitcher in Major League history (since 1913) to strike out at least 15 batters in no more than 6.1 IP according to Baseball-Reference.com.
- Was named National League Pitcher of the Month for April (5-0, 1.62 ERA, 57 SO, 9 BB, .165 opp. AVG) and May (4-0, 2.21 ERA, 63 SO, 10 BB).
- Was named National League Player of the Week for the week of April 9 through 15 (2-0, 1.13 ERA, 21 SO, BB, 3 H).

CAREER NOTES

- His 78 games of 10+ strikeouts are rank eighth-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Steve Carlton** (H.O.F., 1994) is next on the list with 84 10+ strikeout games.
- His 41 games of 10+ strikeouts and one earned run or fewer are seventh-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Curt Schilling** is sixth 47 such games.
- His 22 games of 10+ strikeouts and zero earned runs allowed are seventh-most in MLB history (since 1913) and second-most among active pitchers (**Clayton Kershaw** - 23).
- Scherzer's five career games with 15 or more strikeouts are the most among active players and tied for seventh-most all-time.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.36 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.61).
- His career .197 opp. AVG vs. right-handed batters is fourth-best all-time and second among starting pitchers (**J.R. Richard** - .186).
