THE TWINS: The Twins completed their six-game homestand with a record of 4-2, going 1-2 vs. Cleveland and 3-0 vs. Kansas City...tonight they will begin a seven-game roadtrip with four at the Indians through Thursday and three at the Tigers over the weekend...the Twins are 17-10 in 27 games since July 5.

TWINS COMPLETE SWEEP OF ROYALS: The Twins beat the Royals yesterday afternoon by a score of 6-4, completing their fourth sweep of the season...Ervin Santana was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched...the Twins used five different relievers, as Gabriel Moya earned his second win in as many days and Fernando Rodney earned his 24th save...the offense recorded 11 hits, including a Jake Cave grand slam in the second inning, the first of his career and fifth for a Twin this season.

TAKE THE FIELD: The Twins have placed outfielder Robbie Grossman on the 10-day disabled list with a right hamstring strain he suffered during Sunday afternoon's game vs. Kansas City...to replace Grossman on the 25-man roster, the Twins have recalled outfielder Johnny Field from Triple-A Rochester...Field, who was claimed by the Twins off waivers from Cleveland on Friday, played 63 games this season with Tampa Bay, hitting .213 (36-for-169), with nine doubles, six home runs and 14 RBI.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 13th of 19 scheduled meetings this season and for the fourth time of 10 scheduled games at Progressive Field...they have gone 13-8 vs. the Tribe, 4-3 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 2-1 at Cleveland...seven wins are tied with Chicago-AL for most vs. any opponent this season...they have won six of their last nine over the Indians.

☞ The final seven meetings between these two teams will be at Progressive Field...the Twins are 13-8 in their last 21 in this park and 8-4 in their last 12.

☞ Jorge Polanco's first career HR was in Cleveland May 15, 2016, a solo shot off Trevor Bauer.

INDIVIDUALS VS. INDIANS:

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .320 (116-for-363) with 34 doubles, 48 walks and a .398 on-base percentage in 93 career games at Progressive...he's hitting .387 (29-for-75) in his last 18 here...Mauer is hitting .320 (232-for-724) with 51 doubles, 14 home runs, 78 RBI, 101 walks, 110 runs scored and .403 on-base percentage in 190 career games vs. the Indians...232 hits are his second most vs. any opponent (247 vs. KC)...among actives vs. Cleveland, he ranks first in doubles and walks and second in hits.

☞ Mauer is hitting .302 (13-for-33) with seven doubles lifetime vs. Trevor Bauer...13 hits and seven doubles are the most for any opponent in Bauer's career.

☞ Eddie Rosario is hitting .335 (76-for-227) with 10 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 60 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...his 76 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball...in 29 career games at Progressive Field, he is hitting .373 (41-for-110); in his last six games here, he has four hits twice and three hits once (14-for-26 in that span - .538 avg).

☞ Miguel Sanó has reached safely in each of his last 10 vs. the Indians.

THE ARCHER: Fernando Rodney recorded his 24th save yesterday afternoon and is on pace to save 35 games this season, which would mark the sixth time in his career saving 35-plus games.

TYPICAL MAUER: Joe Mauer is hitting .305 (39-for-128) with eight doubles, one triple, two home runs, 21 RBI, nine walks and 14 runs scored in his last 31 games.

HOME SICK: The Twins have gone 19-34 on the road this season...only Detroit (18-38) and Baltimore (14-43) have less road wins in baseball this season...they are 5-10-2 in series play away from Minnesota...through games of August 5 last season, they were 28-23 on the road...

☞ Jorge Polanco is hitting .302 (13-for-43) with four walks and a .375 on-base percentage in 12 road games...he has hit safely in 10 straight road starts.

☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .313 (21-for-67) in his last 16 road games.

RBI WORLD SERIES: 24 baseball and softball teams, including baseball squads from Uganda and Curaçao, have advanced to the 26th edition of the Reviving Baseball in Inner Cities (RBI) World Series, which will once again be hosted by the Twins in Minneapolis & St. Paul...the Twins hosted the RBI World Series from 2011-2013...the tournament begins today and runs through Thursday, August 16.

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Miguel Sanó is hitting .400 (8-for-20) with three doubles, three RBI, three walks, five runs scored and a .478 OBP in his last six games.

☞ Since July 1, Jake Cave is hitting .305 (25-for-82) with seven doubles, two triples, two home runs, 15 RBI and 16 runs scored...since that date, he leads all current Twins in RBI and tied with Robbie Grossman for first in doubles.

☞ Since July 1, Max Kepler has reached safely 47 times, tied for 10th most in the AL.

☞ Former Twins closer Ron Davis is celebrating his 63rd birthday today...Davis played for the Twins from 1982-86 and saved 108 games for Minnesota, which ranks fifth on the Twins all-time list, trailing Joe Nathan (260), Rick Aguilera (254), Glen Perkins (120) and Eddie Guardado (116).

LAST START: Gibson suffered his eighth loss of the year after allowing three runs on five hits and three walks with six strikeouts against Cleveland on July 31...suffered his first loss to the Tribe since August 17, 2017 when he allowed three runs on seven hits and one walk over 4.0 innings...

AGAINST THE INDIANS: Gibson is making his 17th career start and fourth of the year against Cleveland, is 3-7, 5.16 ERA (83.2 IP, 48 ER) with 37 walks and 57 strikeouts in his career and 1-1, 2.89 ERA (18.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks and 16 strikeouts this year...

GIBBY ON TARGET: After winning his start at home on July 7, Gibson now has 22 wins at Target Field, which is now the most all-time...he passed Brian Duensing for most in Target Field history:

PICKING UP WHERE HE LEFT OFF: After a rough first half of 2017, Gibson finished the second half of the season 7-3, 3.76 ERA (76.2 IP, 32 ER) with 22 walks and 70 strikeouts...since July 16, 2017, Gibson is 12-11, 3.57 ERA (211.2 IP, 84 ER) with 75 walks and 202 strikeouts...

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 132 strikeouts through 22 starts and owns a strikeout rate of 23.6 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 27.7 percent, 10th best in the AL...

KEEP THE K'S COMING: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...through 22 starts in 2018, Gibson is striking out 8.80 batters-per-9.0 innings, 18th in the AL.

LIMITING THE DAMAGE: Gibson has only allowed 36 XBH this season, second fewest allowed in the AL among starters with at least 22 starts... opponents are slugging .353 against Gibson, seventh lowest in the AL...

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GIDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who threw more than 150 innings in 2017...

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .181 average (19-for-105) with runners in scoring position, fifth best in the AL and eighth best in baseball...of those 19 hits, only four have gone for extra bases...

Mejia will be making his fourth start and fifth appearance for the Twins tomorrow...has started four times prior against Cleveland going 1-2 with a 1.96 ERA (18.1 IP, 4 ER)...his last start came on August 1, shut out Cleveland through 5.0 innings on one hit and three walks with two strikeouts...Mejia previously made two starts for the Twins this season, June 30 at Chicago-NL and July 23 at Toronto, then was moved to the bullpen where he had one appearance on July 29 at Boston, 3.0 innings and allowed just one hit and no runs.

- Twins 'pen has posted a 2.73 ERA (26.1 IP, 8 ER) with 6 walks and 29 strikeouts in their last seven games...has held opponents scoreless in three of those.
- Twins 'pen has 21 blown saves this season, tied-second with Colorado, trailing just San Francisco (23)...29th in baseball in save percentage (53.3%).
- **'Pen has 9.49 K-per-9.0 IP ratio, the 6th best in the AL and 9th best in baseball...the mark is also the highest in club history, next is 7.43 in 2016.**
