Nelson Cruz is 2 RBI shy of 1,000 for his career...with 2 more RBI, Cruz will become the 5th active player with at least 350 home runs and 1,000 RBI: Albert Pujols, Adrián Beltré, Miguel Cabrera and Edwin Encarnación.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their penultimate homestand of the season - a 10-day, 8-game, 3-team set - with the second (1-0) of 3 games vs. the Baltimore Orioles...will also face the New York Yankees (Fri-Sun) and the San Diego Padres (Tue-Wed) during this homestand...went 4-5 on a recently-concluded 10-day, 9-game, 3-city road trip to Arizona (2-1), San Diego (0-2) and Oakland (2-2)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have won 12 of their last 23 and 14 of their last 27 games...are 22-30 (7/4-current) since winning a season-high 8 straight games (6/25-7/3)...the Mariners have won 37 of their last 74 games, 44 of their last 83, 48 of their last 89 and 55 of their last 99...Seattle is 63-50 in its last 113 games, 68-53 over its last 121 games...Seattle is 23-24 during the day and 54-37 at night...Seattle is 39-28 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 50-22 (.694) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 34-18 (.654) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-4 (.800) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 55-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 22-43 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (66-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (68-0).
- **Milestones** - **Kyle Seager** (534) trails Raúl Ibañez (540) by 6 for 8th-most runs scored in club history...**Nelson Cruz** (295) is 5 doubles away from 300 in his career...Cruz (998) is also 2 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...he will become the 12th active Major League player with at least 1,000 RBI.
- **Heating Up** - Dating back to Aug. 11, **Ryon Healy** is batting .377 (23x61) with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 12 RBI and 3 walks in 17 games...during this stretch his .377 average ranks 5th in the Majors (min. 50 AB)...teammate **Jean Segura** is 2nd in the Majors during this span with a .400 (26x65) average.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK...for the 3rd month in a row - and the 4th time overall this season - **Edwin Díaz** has been named the Hartford Presents American League Reliever of the Month for August...he is the first player to win 4 monthly awards in a single season since Mike Trout (AL Rookie of the Month) in 2012 and the first non-rookie since Pedro Martínez (AL Pitcher of the Month) in 1999...Díaz now has 5 career AL Reliever of the Month honors, joining Edgar Martínez (5x AL Player of the Month) and Ichiro Suzuki (4x AL Rookie of the Month and 1x AL Player of the Month) as the only Mariners to win 5 career monthly awards of any kind...in 11 relief appearances in the month of August, Díaz converted 10-of-11 save opportunities while posting a 1.64 ERA (2 ER, 11.0 IP)...he struck out 21 and did not walk a batter while limiting opposing batters to a .195 (8x41) average against and recording a 0.73 WHIP (0 BB, 8 H, 11.0 IP)...his 10 saves in the month of August led the Major Leagues.

LEFTY LEADERS...**Wade LeBlanc's** 8 wins are tied for 3rd-most on the club this season (also: **Félix Hernández** and **Mike Leake** while trailing **Marco Gonzales** (12) and **James Paxton** (11)...with LeBlanc's next win, the Mariners will have a trio of left-handers with at least 9 wins apiece for just the 3rd time in club history...Randy Johnson, Jamie Moyer and Jeff Fassero accomplished this feat in back-to-back seasons in 1997 and 1998.

BIRD HUNTING...**Nelson Cruz** has reached base safely in 57 of 61 career games (w/AB) vs. the Orioles, including 54 games with at least 1 hit...overall he is batting .349 (81x232) with 45 runs scored, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 12 home runs, 51 RBI, 3 HBP, 26 walks and 4 stolen bases...among all active players, Cruz's .349 average vs. Baltimore is the 3rd-highest, while teammate **Robinson Canó's** .326 (232x711) average ranks 11th (min. 150 PA)...Cruz also ranks 5th in on-base percentage (.418), 5th in OPS (1.009), 7th in slugging percentage (.591), while Canó ranks 1st in hits (232), runs scored (126), doubles (50) and RBI (111), 4th in home runs (29) and 8th in walks (51).

HAMMERIN' HANIGER...**Mitch Haniger** has hit safely in 15 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the Majors and the longest streak of his career (previous: 13, 4/6-19/17)...during the streak (8/18-c), he is batting .317 (20x63) with 12 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 4 home runs, 6 RBI, 2 HBP and 8 walks...Haniger's streak is the longest by a Mariners player this season...he becomes the 24th player in club history (done 50x) to record a hitting streak of at least 15 games...dating back to July 31, Haniger has hit safely in 28 of his last 32 games, including 12 multi-hit contests; he is batting .336 (45x134) with 21 runs scored, 14 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs, 16 RBI, 2 HBP and 11 walks over that span.

JEAN. JEAN. THE HITTING MACHINE...dating back to Aug. 5, **Jean Segura** has hit safely in 15 of his last 20 games, including 11 multi-hit contests, batting .368 (32x87) with 10 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI, 2 HBP, 4 walks and 5 stolen bases...during this span, his .368 average is 4th-best in the Major Leagues, trailing only Justin Turner-LAD (.408/40x98), J.D. Martinez-BOS (.380/38x100) and Paul Goldschmidt-ARI (.370/37x100).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 66 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 52-for-56 (92.9%) in save opportunities with a 1.90 ERA (14 ER, 66.1 IP) with 115 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .157 (36x230) average against with a 0.78 WHIP (16 BB, 36 H, 66.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 52 saves...Wade Davis-COL is 2nd with 38.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd among Major League relievers with 115 strikeouts...Josh Hader-MIL is 1st with 116.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 26 one-run saves...Blake Treinen-OAK is 2nd with 17.
- Has struck out 46.0% (115 K, 250 BF) of batters faced this season, the 4th-best single-season strike-out rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- His .157 opponents average against is the lowest in American League history among pitchers with at least 45 save opportunities (93 such seasons in AL history).
- His 0.78 WHIP is 3rd-lowest in American League history among pitchers with at least 45 save opportunities...only Dennis Eckersley-OAK (0.61, 1990) and Fernando Rodney-TB (0.78, 2012) posted a lower WHIP in a season with at least 45 save opportunities (93 such seasons in AL history).
- Has struck out his 1st batter faced 31 times this season, most in the Majors (Adam Ottavino-COL, 30).

AS YOU KNOW...**Mitch Haniger** is the 24th player in club history (done 50x) to record a hitting streak of at least 15 games...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that Haniger is only the 5th player in club history with a hitting streak of at least 15 games while batting leadoff in each game?...he joins **Ichiro Suzuki** (16x), **Joey Cora** (2x), **Jean Segura** and **Harold Reynolds** as the only Mariners to accomplish this feat.

ABOUT LEBLANC...

- 34-year-old left-hander is making his 28th appearance and 23rd start of the season, his 204th career appearance, 102nd career start and 4th career start (6th appearance) vs. Baltimore tonight.
- Signed with Seattle on March 25, 2018 after being released by New York-AL at his request.
- Previously played with Seattle in 2016...acquired on June 22, 2016 from Toronto in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...was traded to Pittsburgh on Sept. 13, 2016 in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations.
- Selected by San Diego in the 2nd round of the 2006 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Native of Lake Charles, LA...attended Alfred M. Barbe High School.
- Made his Major League debut with the Padres on Sept. 3, 2008 at Los Angeles-NL (L,4.0,8,5,3,1,HR-2).
- Pitched for the University of Alabama, 2004-06...was 24-9 with a 2.81 ERA (100 ER, 320.1 IP) and 334 strikeouts in 46 career G/45 GS...holds Alabama's all-time record for strikeouts with 334...National Freshman of the Year (*Baseball America*) and SEC Freshman of the Year in 2004 after going 8-4 with a 2.08 ERA (26 ER, 112.2 IP) with 98 strikeouts in 16 G/15 GS while posting 8 complete games, including 2 shutouts.
- Went 2-5 with a 4.23 ERA (21 ER, 44.2 IP) in 8 starts with the Seibu Lions in the Japan Pacific League in 2015.
- Is 9-7-1 with a 3.87 ERA (59 ER, 137.1 IP) in 41 career games (19 starts) in September.

LAST OUTING...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings and earned W#8 in his last start, a 7-1 Mariners win at OAK on 8/30...allowed just 3 hits and 3 walks while striking out 4 batters...marked his 4th scoreless start of the season and his 3rd start of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings pitched (also: 5/14 at MIN & 6/16 vs. BOS).

FOR STARTERS...since moving into the Mariners rotation on May 3, is 8-3 with a 3.61 ERA (49 ER, 122.0 IP) with 96 strikeouts and 29 walks in 22 starts...the Mariners are 15-7 in those starts...among American League leaders during that span, ranks 6th in WHIP (1.12/29 BB, 108 H, 122.0 IP), 10th in BB/9.0 IP (2.14/29 BB, 122.0 IP), 10th in ERA and 14th in K/BB (3.31/96 K, 29 BB).

START IT UP...in 30 career starts with the Mariners, is 11-3 with a 3.83 ERA (71 ER, 166.2 IP) with 130 strikeouts and 38 walks...**the Mariners are 22-8 in his 30 starts with the club...**made 8 starts with Seattle in 2016, going 3-0 with a 4.43 ERA (22 ER, 44.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 9 walks.

HE'S A WINNER...made 21 career starts with the Mariners before suffering a loss (6/24/16-7/8/18)...only 1 American League pitcher in the live-ball era had a longer such streak to begin a tenure with a single club (Whitey Ford-NYY, 22, 7/6/50-6/12/53)...among all pitchers in the live-ball era, LeBlanc's streak trailed only Ford and Kirk Rueter-MON (22, 7/7/93-6/15/94)(STATS).

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME...signed to a contract extension through the 2019 season with annual club options through 2022 on July 3.

THAT'S NEAT!...turned in one of the best starts of his career June 16 vs. Boston, allowing 2 hits and striking out 9 across 7.2 scoreless innings...faced just 1 over the minimum, thanks to a 1st-inning double play...retired 22 straight batters after allowing a leadoff single in the 1st inning, ending with a 2-out single in the 8th...his 7.2 innings and 9 strikeouts were both his most since 2011 with San Diego.

A MAY TO REMEMBER...in 6 starts in the month of May, went 1-0 with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER, 31.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and 6 walks...among American League leaders for the month of May, ranked 4th in ERA and 9th in WHIP (0.99/6 BB, 25 H, 31.1 IP)...the Mariners went 5-1 in those 6 starts.

WELCOME (BACK) TO SEATTLE...signed with Seattle on March 25 after being released by New York-AL at his request...became the 43rd player in club history to have spent at least two different stints with the Mariners...Mike Blowers (1992-95, 1997, 1999), Raúl Ibañez (1996-2000, 2004-2008, 2013), Norm Charlton (1993, 1995-97, 2001) and Jeff Nelson (1992-95, 2001-03, 2005) are the only players who spent three separate stints with the Mariners.

2017 SEASON...went 5-2 with 1 save and 4 holds in 50 relief appearances with a 4.50 ERA (34 ER, 68.0 IP), 54 strikeouts and 17 walks with Pittsburgh...held right-handed batters to a .217 (38x175) batting average against with a .270 OBP and a .389 slugging percentage (.658 OPS against).

CAREER...10-year MLB veteran with 7 clubs (San Diego, Miami, Houston, Los Angeles-AL, New York-AL, Pittsburgh & Seattle)...overall, is 33-38-3 with a 4.27 ERA (338 ER, 712.1 IP) in 203 career appearances/101 starts...in 101 career starts, is 30-34 with a 4.34 ERA (266 ER, 551.0 IP) with 390 strikeouts and 176 walks...in 102 career relief appearances, is 8-4-3 with a 4.02 ERA (72 ER, 161.1 IP) with 125 strikeouts and 43 walks...appeared in 11 games (8 starts) with the Mariners in 2016, going 3-0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (25 ER, 50.0 IP).
