• **3B Matt Duffy** (1x4, HR, RBI) provided the lone run for the Grizzlies with a solo homer, his 1st of the season...has hit safely in a club-high 9 consecutive games (.343, 12x35), and 11 of his last 12 games.

• **1B Jon Singleton** went 1x3 with a walk...has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games.

• **RHP Mike Hauschild** (0ER/5.1IP) allowed 3 runs, but they were all unearned...struck out 6, walked 3 and allowed 4 hits in the outing.

• **RHP Josh Fields** (0ER/0.2IP) had a scoreless appearance in his 2nd outing since getting optioned to Triple A.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Corpus Christi Hooks at San Antonio, 7:05 p.m. CT | **PROBABLE STARTERS:** RHP Francis Martes (2-2, 7.06 ERA)

• The Hooks rode a 3x4 night from **3B-SS Alex Bregman** while the pitching staff allowed just 5 hits in an 8-0 shutout victory over the Missions in San Antonio...the Hooks have won 12 of their last 15 games and a season-high 7 in a row.

• **Bregman** drove in 4, knocked 2 doubles, walked, scored 3 total runs and belted his 8th homer of the season...is tied for the club lead (also T-3rd in the Texas League) in HR with **Derek Fisher** and **Chase McDonald**...was his 2nd start of the season at 3rd base...leads the Texas League in OPS (1.131) and OBP (.438), and ranks 2nd in SLG (.693) and 4th in batting average (.330).

• **CF Derek Fisher** went 2x5 with a double, triple, RBI and a run scored...is tied for the Texas League-lead in walks (21) and ranks 8th in OPS (.878, .355 OBP/.523 SLG)...is batting .304 (17x56) with 5 HR, 14 RBI and a 1.026 OPS in May.

• **LHP Brian Holmes** (0ER/5IP), **LHP Michael Freeman** (0ER/2IP) and **LHP Chris Cotton** (0ER/2IP) completed the Hooks league-best 6th shutout of the year.

• **DH J.D. Davis** (1x5, RBI) and **LHP Evan Grills** were named the Texas League Player and Pitcher of the Week prior to the game.

• **IF Bobby Wernes**, the Astros 30th round pick in the 2015 draft out of Arkansas, won the New York-Penn League batting title with a .346 (65x188) batting average...Wernes also posted a league-leading .434 on-base percentage...led all 3rd basemen in fielding percentage (.976).

• **OF Dexture McCall** was a New York-Penn League Midseason All-Star, batting .295 (59x200) with 9 doubles, 4 HR, 37 RBI and a .376 on-base percentage in 59 games...was named the **MVP of the All-Star Game** after hitting a 2-run double.

• The Greeneville Astros captured their 2nd Appalachian League Championship title in the history of the franchise in 2015...it marked their first title since their inaugural season in 2004...the club finished in 2nd place in the regular season before tearing through the playoffs and defeating Princeton, 2-1, in the championship.

• **OF Kyle Tucker**, the 5th overall selection in the 2015 draft, played a key role in Greeneville's postseason run...batted .375 (9x24) with 3 home runs, driving in 6 total runs in the postseason...hit a crucial, 3-run homer in the final game of the Appalachian League Championship Series.

• In 30 games in the GCL, **OF Daz Cameron** hit .272 (28x103) with 2 doubles, 3 triples, 11 steals and a .372 on-base percentage.
