FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a quick four-game road swing to the Nation's capital to take on the Washington Nationals in game three tonight at 7:15 p.m. LHP **Wei-Yin Chen**, who is making his 14th start of the season, has gone 1-5 with a 4.15 ERA (47.2 ip/22 er) in nine career appearances, eight starts, against the Nationals. Washington is countering with RHP Max Scherzer, who in 15 career starts against the Marlins has gone 8-3 with one complete game and a 3.39 ERA (95.2/36). Miami recently completed a 10-game homestand against Arizona (1-3), the Mets (2-1) and Tampa Bay (2-1). Upon conclusion of this series, Miami will return home to finish out the pre-break schedule with a six-game homestand against Milwaukee and Philadelphia.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami dropped the fifth consecutive game in the series this season, the 13th in a row to the Nationals, in a 3-2 loss here at Nationals Park. Miami got out to an early lead after **Starlin Castro** doubled home **Cameron Maybin** with one out in the third. The Nationals answered with two runs in the fourth before the Marlins tied the game in the fifth on a bases-loaded walk drawn by **Martin Prado**. The Nationals ended up walking off on a pinch-hit home run by Mark Reynolds in the ninth. Castro, **Garrett Cooper**, and **Miguel Rojas** each had two hits, while **J.T. Realmuto** had his 12-game hitting streak snapped. **Dan Straily** went 6.0 innings, allowing five hits and two runs with three walks and one strikeout, and **Kyle Barraclough** took his third loss of the season.

VS. THE NATIONALS

This is just the second meeting of the season between the two rivals, and the first at Nationals Park. The Marlins dropped the 2017 series against the Nationals, 6-13, which included an eight-game losing streak to conclude the series. Miami was swept in the first series of the season, a three-game set at Marlins Park from May 25-27, and have dropped 13 straight to the Nationals. The 13-game slide is the longest against the Nationals in Club history, and is longest to any opponent in Club history. The last team to drop 13 consecutive games to a single opponent was the Cincinnati Reds to the St. Louis Cardinals from September 14, 2017 to June 9, 2018. The last team with a losing streak of 14 games to an opponent was the Reds again, this time to the New York Mets from Sept. 7, 2014 to Sept. 7, 2016. Miami is 54-67 against the Nationals in DC, and 122-121 overall, since 2005.

KID CLUTCH

Brian Anderson has seven hits in his last 12 at-bats with runners in scoring position (.583), going 1x2 in such situations last night. On the season, the rookie right fielder has posted the second-best average with runners in scoring position in the Majors at .427 (35x82), trailing only the Dodgers' Matt Kemp (.438; 28x64). Anderson leads MLB in hits with RISP (35), ahead of Yuli Gurriel (30).

UMM...WHAT'S IT CALLED AGAIN?

Miami got off to a slow start this season, going 5-17 over their first 22 games. However, they have improved dramatically over their last 68, posting a 31-37 record, including a 16-18 mark since June 1. All of this while playing the sixth toughest schedule in the Majors to date, second toughest among National League teams, with their opponents combining on a .511 winning percentage. The remainder of the schedule will see Miami play the seventh-hardest schedule in the Majors, third most difficult in the NL (.520).

HEATING UP WITH SUMMER

Since June 28, Miami's offense has hit at a .270 clip (157x582) with 76 runs scored, and their 157 hits rank second among National League clubs behind Chicago (159). The Marlins average in that time ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Cubs (.307), Reds (.276), and Colorado (.270). Miami's run total is tied for fourth with Atlanta and Colorado, trailing the Reds (100), Cubs (90), and Dodgers (80).

CASTRO-LLING

With two hits last night, **Starlin Castro** marked his 29th multi-hit game of the season, and fifth straight game with two-or-more hits. His 29 multi-hit games are tied for fifth among National League hitters with Asdrúbal Cabrera. He has hit safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .489 (23x47) over that span to lead the Majors. In that time he has raised his average from .267 to a current .297. He is one of just five National League players with 100+ hits this season (104), joining Nick Markakis (111), Ozzie Albies (105), Scooter Gennett (105), and Freddie Freeman (102).

GETTIN' MIGGY WITH IT

Miguel Rojas recorded his third multi-hit effort in his last five games last night, going 2x4. Since June 23, Rojas ranks second in the Majors in average (min. 61 PA), posting a .379 average (22x58). He trails only Javier Baez (.394; 26x66) in that span. Albert Almora Jr. ranks third at .371, followed by Josh Reddick (.367), and Ozzie Albies (.366).

BOOK IT

J.T. Realmuto hit his 11th home run of the season Monday night; Miami is 9-0 when he homers (two multi-homer games) this year. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is tied for the longest winning streak to open a season when an individual homers in Club history. The Marlins also won the first nine games when Josh Willingham homered in 2007, and when Mike Lowell went deep in 2004.

HE'S DOING ONE STECK OF A JOB

Drew Steckenrider entered last night's game and provided a scoreless seventh inning, getting out of a bases-loaded jam after walking two and allowing a hit. He is on a career-best 18.2 inning scoreless streak over his last 21 appearances, a run that has seen him become the first pitcher in Club history to make 14-or-more appearances in a calendar month (June) without allowing a run; he last allowed a run (2) on May 20 at Atlanta. His scoreless streak is now the longest active streak in the Majors, and is the second-longest by a Marlins reliever this season (Barraclough 20.2).

WHAT A RELIEF

Since May 28, Miami's bullpen has limited opponents to the second-best average against among National League bullpens with a .221 average, behind only the Nationals (.215). The 'pen leads the NL in innings pitched (156.2) and ranks fifth in ERA at 3.62 (156.2 ip/63 er), behind Arizona (2.45), the Giants (3.07), the Nationals (3.24), and the Dodgers (3.49).

THIRD TIME IS HAS BEEN A CHARM

Over the last 14 days, Marlins starting pitchers have actually been tougher on opposing lineups when facing the third time through the order. Miami starters lead the Majors in OPS (.370) and slugging percentage (.214) when going through the lineup the third time in a game in that span. The league average for OPS is .784, while the average in slugging percentage is .456.

PUSHING THE LIMITS

The Marlins are 15 games into a stretch of 20 consecutive games between off-days. During the stretch, Miami will have faced off against two first-place teams (Arizona and Milwaukee), and will play five of six series against teams with .500-or-better records. Prior to their last homestand, Miami finished a run that saw them play 25 of 35 games on the road. On June 25 they started a stretch were 15 of 22 games would be at home.

- Wei-Yin Chen tonight will make his 14th start of the season as the Marlins face the Nats in game three of this brief four-game road trip for Miami.
- He is 1-5, 4.15 (47.2 ip/22 er) in nine career appearances (eight starts) against Washington. He is 1-5, 4.24 (46.2/22) in the starts; relief appearance was on Sept. 4, 2017 (1.0 ip).
- Has one start against Nats this year. Did not factor in the decision, a 4-1 loss, on May 26 despite tossing 7.1 innings and allowing just one run on three hits and two walks (one IBB), with six strikeouts. Marked his second-longest career start vs. Washington (8.0 on 7/12/15).
- Allowed six earned runs and took the loss in his first career start vs. Nats (May 20, 2012); since then, has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his seven starts against them, posting a 3.40 ERA (42.1/16), but is just 1-4, receiving 2.13 runs of support per 9.0.
- Began season on DL (left elbow strain). Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk.
- Made season debut on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts.
- Has 1.89 ERA (33.1 ip/7 er) in six home starts, compared to 9.85 (28.1/31) in seven road starts.
- His start on May 26 vs. Washington marked 150th of career. Among pitchers born in Taiwan, Chen leads all in innings pitched (924.2), starts (157) and strikeouts (718). He ranks second in career wins with 55, behind Chien-Ming Wang (68). Wang ranks second in innings pitched (845.2), starts (126), and strikeouts (394).
- Opened 2017 on 25-man roster, but made just five starts before beginning DL stint on May 5. Reinstated on September 4, after which he made just four relief appearances before being shut down with left elbow discomfort following outing on Sept. 22. Finished with 2-1 record and 3.82 ERA (33.0/14).
- Best start of the year came on April 18 at Seattle, holding Mariners hitless over 7.0 innings while striking out two and issuing just two walks. Marked first start of career holding an opponent hitless. Previous low-hit start was one, done on June 2, 2016 vs. Pittsburgh (6.0 ip).

- Allowed season-high tying seven hits, with four runs and two walks, along with three strikeouts, over 5.0 innings on April 26 at Philadelphia. Loss marked first and only defeat of season.
- Recorded season-high seven strikeouts in final start, on May 1 vs. Tampa Bay. Did not receive a decision despite allowing just two runs and two hits over 6.0. Also walked a season-high four.
- Upon reinstatement from DL, made first career relief appearance on September 4 vs. Washington, tossing 1.0 perfect inning. Allowed one run on two hits over 6.0 innings (1.50 ERA) in four relief outings to close out season.
- Picked up first career hit, an infield single, off of Zack Wheeler on April 7 at the Mets.

- Trevor Richards will make his 12th start of the season for Miami tomorrow - the first of his career against Washington - as the clubs wrap up this four-game series in DC.
- Went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er) in four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami. He contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston.
- He went 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2/13) across five starts in his first stint with the Marlins. Tossed 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits allowed on April 14 vs. Pittsburgh, and tossed 4.2 shutout innings, with a career-high 10 strikeouts, on April 25 at the Dodgers, his final start before being optioned back to NOLA.
- In the Pittsburgh start, became the first Marlins rookie starter to work at least 7.0 innings and allow two or fewer hits since Justin Nicolino on September 26, 2015 vs. Atlanta (7.0 ip, 2 h). He became just the 15th pitcher in Club history to do so (22nd time).
- Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his six starts after returning to New Orleans. Tossed a career-high 7.1 innings against Round Rock in his first game back, on May 1. Struck out nine batters in that game, a Minor League season-high that he tied on May 26 at Iowa. Posted 37 strikeouts against just four walks with the Baby Cakes.
- Recalled from New Orleans prior to his start on June 7 at St. Louis. Is 2-3, 5.18 (24.1/14) in six starts since his return, with 24 strikeouts to eight walks. Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in four of those outings.
