### Vs. LHP

The Braves are set to face LHP Robbie Ray today, and are scheduled to see LHP Andrew Suarez and LHP Derek Holland in their next series against San Francisco.

The Braves are 18-23 against left-handed starters this season, but are hitting .274 against all lefties, the best average in the National League. Their .456 slugging percentage against lefties is second best in the league (Colorado, .466).

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Diamondbacks finish a four-game set tonight with the seventh and final meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves are 3-3 against the Diamondbacks this season, and the teams have each scored 21 runs in the six games.

- A* The Braves have taken two of the first three games in this series, and each team has scored 15 runs.
- A* The Diamondbacks won two-of-three games at SunTrust Park earlier this season, winning a 2-1 and 3-0 game to open the series, before the Braves took a 5-1 decision in the final game before the All-Star break...Again, each team scored six runs in that series.
- A* The Braves have not won a series in Arizona since taking three-of-four in 2012...They are 6-10 overall since 2013 here, including 0-4-1 in series play.
- A* RHP Julio Teheran beat Arizona earlier this season, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings in a 5-1 win on July 15...The righty is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA (14 ER/46.1 IP) in eight career appearances, all starts, against Arizona.
- A* RHP Clay Buchholz is set to face the Braves for the fourth time in his career and for the first time since April 28, 2016 at Turner Field while with Boston...The righty is 1-1 with a 6.06 ERA (11 ER/16.1 IP) against the Braves...Buchholz is unbeaten in his last four starts, going 2-0 with a 0.64 ERA (2 ER/28.0 IP).

**NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT:** The Braves hung on for a 5-4, 10-inning win last night, their 18th last at-bat win this season...Each of the Braves' last five wins have come in their last at-bat...It's the team's longest such streak since a six-game run from July 20-July 28, 1995 and the longest such stretch by a National League team this season...Research courtesy of the Elias Sports Bureau and STATS, LLC.

- A* Their 18 such wins are tied for the second most in the National League and one behind the San Francisco Giants' total for the league lead.
- A* Since Brian Snitker was named interim manager on May 17, 2016, the Braves have 55 last at-bat wins, the most in the National League.
- A* The Braves led the N.L. in last at-bat victories the last two seasons...They had 20 in 2017 and 19 in 2016.
- A* The Braves have scored 232 times in the seventh inning or later this season, tied for the second-most such runs in the National League this season...Only Chicago has more at 256.
- A* Last night's win coupled with Philadelphia's loss at New York dropped Atlanta's magic number to clinch the National League East to 18.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Braves are 41-30 (.577) away from SunTrust Park this season, which is the best road record in the National League and the fifth best in baseball.

- A* Last night's win ensured the Braves will finish with winning road record this season for the first time since going 46-35 in 2012.
- A* The Braves have 10 more road games left this season.
- A* From 2013-2017, the Braves went 174-230 (.431) on the road...That was the seventh-worst record in all of baseball.
- A* Over that stretch, the Braves were 29-64 (.312) on the road against the N.L. West...They are 6-6 so far this season.

**ACUÑA JR.:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. finished 2-for-3 with two intentional walks last night and the 20-year-old rookie is now hitting .328 (61-for-186) with a .411 on-base percentage and 40 runs scored since moving to the leadoff spot for the first game out of the All-Star break on July 20.

- A* Washington's Juan Soto, who is 19, was also intentionally walked twice in a game this season, July 26 at Miami...Prior to this season, the last time a player was intentionally walked multiple times in the same game prior to his 21st birthday was 1999, when Adrian Beltre drew two such walks on April 20 vs. Atlanta.
- A* Last night marked the first time over the last 110 seasons a Braves player drew two intentional walks prior to his 21st birthday...Prior to Acuña Jr., the previous youngest Braves player to be walked intentionally multiple times in a game over that span was Elbie Fletcher, who was 21 year, 64 days old on May 21, 1937 when Pittsburgh walked him twice.

**1,000 STRIKEOUTS:** RHP Julio Teheran collected the 1,000th strikeout of his career when he fanned Eduardo Escobar in the first inning last night...He became the ninth pitcher in franchise history to fan 1,000 in a Braves uniform.

- A* Of the previous eight with at least 1,000 strikeouts, only five did so in baseball's modern era: John Smoltz (3,011), Phil Niekro (2,912), Warren Spahn (2,493), Tom Glavine (2,091) and Greg Maddux (1,828)...All five are in the Hall of Fame.

- A* Teheran allowed two runs, one earned, last night, and over his last six starts, he owns a 2.33 ERA (10 ER/38.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts and 19 hits against.

**HOME RUNS:** With another home run this season, OF Ronald Acuña Jr. will tie Eddie Mathews and Orlando Cepeda (25 homers) for the fifth most home runs in a single season prior to turning 21...Al Kaline sits in fourth place with 27 in 1955, while Conigliaro had 32 in 1965...Frank Robinson hit 34 in 1956, while Mel Ott holds the record with 42 in 1929.

#### Today's Game

- A Atlanta recalled him from Triple-A Gwinnett, 9/1, and he is set to make his third major league start.
- A Makes his first career appearance against Arizona...The Diamondbacks drafted Toussaint with the 16th overall selection in the 2014 First-Year Player Draft before trading him to Atlanta on his 19th birthday, 6/20/15.
  - A Atlanta acquired Toussaint and RHP Bronson Arroyo in exchange for INF Phil Gosselin.
  - A Gosselin batted .283 (81-for-286) over 146 games for Arizona, while Arroyo never pitched for Atlanta.
- A Last started against the Boston Red Sox, 9/3, and took the first loss of his major league career...Allowed four hits and three runs over 4.2 innings, fanning six.
  - A Held Boston hitless for 4.1 innings to open the game, before Eduardo Núñez doubled.
- A Has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his last 15 starts, regardless of level, dating to 6/4 while with Double-A Mississippi...Is 8-2 with a 1.57 ERA (16 ER/91.2 IP) and a .187 opponents' batting average in that span.
  - A His team has gone 11-4.
- A Starts today at 22 years, 81 days old...Is the eighth-youngest pitcher to start a game this season.
  - A Of the eight youngest pitchers to start a game, five have done so for Atlanta... RHP Mike Soroka made five starts for Atlanta, while LHP Kolby Allard, LHP Luiz Gohara and RHP Bryse Wilson have each started once for Atlanta.
- A Made 24 starts at the minor league level, splitting his season between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett...Combined to go 9-6 with a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP) and 163 strikeouts.
  - A Opened the season in Mississippi and made 16 starts with the M-Braves (4-6, 2.93)...Transferred to Gwinnett on 7/4 and went 5-0 with a 1.43 ERA in eight starts for the Stripers.
  - A At the time of his recall, his 163 strikeouts were most among Atlanta farmhands and tied for eighth most in the minor leagues...His 10.8 SO/9.0 IP is the highest rate of his career.
- A Entered the 2018 season tabbed by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 11 prospect and as the Braves No. 14 farmhand by Baseball America.
- A Name is pronounced TWO-key TWO-sahnt...His complete bio is available on page 320 of the 2018 Atlanta Braves media guide.

#### 2018 Recap

- A Atlanta selected his contract from Triple-A Gwinnett, optioned him to the Stripers and then appointed him as the 26th man for the doubleheader, 8/13...Made his major league debut that afternoon.
  - A Is one of 12 Atlanta players to debut this season, and one of four starting pitchers...RHP Mike Soroka started against the New York Mets on 5/1, LHP Kolby Allard debuted with a start vs. Miami on 7/31, and RHP Bryse Wilson started at Pittsburgh on 8/20.
  - A LHP Jesse Biddle (4/21), OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (4/25), OF Dustin Peterson (5/28), RHP Evan Phillips (7/3), LHP Adam McCreery (8/9), RHP Wes Parsons (8/9), RHP Chad Sobotka (8/10) and RHP Kyle Wright (9/4) have also debuted this season.
- A Made his made his major league debut in the first game of a doubleheader, 8/13 vs. MIA, and was returned to Gwinnett postgame.
  - A Tossed 6.0 two-hit innings in his debut, allowing one run and two walks while fanning four.
  - A Became just the third Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to go at least 6.0 innings and allow no more than two hits in his debut, joining James Parr (9/4/08 vs. WSH) and Armando Reynoso (8/11/91 vs. HOU).
- A Earned the win in his major league debut and became the third Braves starter to win his MLB debut this season, joining Mike Soroka (5/1 at NYM) and Kolby Allard (7/31 vs. MIA).
  - A Since Toussaint won his first game vs. Miami, Bryse Wilson has debuted and defeated the Pittsburgh Pirates on 8/20.
  - A The Braves are just the second team in the last 110 seasons to have four different starters win their MLB debut in the same season...The 2009 Baltimore Orioles had five such pitchers.
- A Ranked in the Top 10 among Atlanta's starting farmhands in strikeouts (1st, 163), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (1st, 10.8), wins (T2nd, 9), hits per 9.0 innings (3rd, 6.7), WHIP (3rd, 1.130), starts (T3rd, 24) and innings (4th, 136.1).
- A Entered 2018 with 201 career walks in 393.2 innings (4.97 BB/9.0 IP)...Has walked just 53 batters in 136.1 innings (3.5 BB/9.0 IP) this season.
  - A Has three starts this season in which he has not walked a batter...Had six starts without a walk in his first four professional campaigns.

#### Career Recap

- A Is 26-38 with a 4.08 ERA (240 ER/530.0 IP) over 106 career minor league games, including 101 starts.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.
