WASHINGTON NATIONALS (11-16)

-**1B Ryan Zimmerman** clubbed a two-run home run in the bottom of the third inning to give the Nationals a 2-0 lead...It was his fourth homer of the season and first since he hit two home runs against the Mets on April 18...Over his last 10 games, Zimmerman is batting .333 (12-for-36) with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, three walks and seven runs scored.

-In the bottom of the sixth inning, **2B Howie Kendrick** slugged his fourth home run of the season to give the Nationals a 3-2 lead...Kendrick has now hit safely in six straight games, going 9-for-20 (.450) with three doubles, two homers, five RBI, two walks and three runs scored...He entered today tied for tenth in the National League with 12 extra base hits.

-**RHP Brandon Kintzler** tossed a perfect seventh inning (1.0 IP, SO)...Since April 11, Kintzler has allowed just three hits in 9.0 inning of scoreless relief...He has 10 strikeouts and four walks over this stretch.

-**RHP Jeremy Hellickson** tossed 5.1 IP, allowing two earned runs while striking out one and walking one...Today's start marked his fifth career start against Arizona and his third since the Diamondbacks traded him away following the 2015 season.

ARIZONA DIAMONDBACKS (19-7)

-With today's 4-3 win, the Diamondbacks are the second team in National League history to win their first 9+ series of a season...The Diamondbacks join the 1907 Cubs (NL-record 11 series wins).

-Today marks **LF David Peralta's** first career multi-home run game...Peralta homered in the top of the fourth inning and in the top of the sixth inning, both off of RHP Jeremy Hellickson...Peralta is the fourth Diamondbacks leadoff hitter with a multi-home run game on the road since 2011.

-**LHP Patrick Corbin** tossed 6.2 IP and allowed three earned runs on the night...With his 6.2 IP tonight, he passed **Curt Schilling** to move to fourth all-time in club history for most innings pitched with 785.3.

-The Diamondbacks recorded their 260th strikeout as a team in the month of April following a **LHP Patrick Corbin** strikeout of **RF Bryce Harper** in the bottom of the third inning...The 264 strikeouts marks a new club record for the most recorded in a single month, surpassing the previous total of 259 that was set in Sept./Oct. 2015.
