## CHICAGO WHITE SOX (10-27) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-17)

May 15, 2018 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA --- GAME #41/HOME #19

RHP REYNALDO LOPEZ (0-2, 3.44 ERA) vs. RHP TREVOR WILLIAMS (4-2, 3.13 ERA)

**THE PIRATES...** had the day off yesterday...Had their season-high tying five-game winning streak end Sunday after getting shut out 5-0 against San Francisco...Have won six of their last eight games after dropping four in a row...Have gone 11-6 in their last 17 games...Also won five straight games from 4/25-29...Were 17-23 after 40 games in 2017 (18-23 after 41).

**IT'S TREVOR TIME:** In his last 13 starts at PNC Park (dating back to 6/27/17), **Trevor Williams** has posted a 2.68 ERA (77.1ip/23er) while allowing two runs or fewer in 12 of the 13 assignments...In three career starts against American League teams in Pittsburgh, Williams has gone 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (20.0ip/3er) - all three starts coming in 2017.

**A WELL-BALANCED ATTACK:** The Pirates are the only National League team that features five players with at least 20 RBI and are one of three in the Majors with that distinction; Boston has six players and Cleveland also has five.

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** Indianapolis infielder **Kevin Newman** was named the International League Player-of-the-Week on Monday for the week of May 7-13...Newman hit .519 (14-for-27) with one homer, four doubles, two RBI, seven runs scored, a 1.330 OPS and two stolen bases...He ranked first among all players in average, hits and on-base percentage (.552), finished second in OPS and was tied for second in runs scored...In addition, Altoona's **Jason Martin** took home Eastern League Player-of-the-Week honors after leading the league in hitting (.522) with two homers, a double, eight RBI and seven runs scored.

**LONG TIME, NO SEE:** Pittsburgh is hosting the White Sox for the first time since sweeping a two-game series from June 15-16, 2015...Last week in Chicago, the Pirates won their two games against the Sox after overcoming a deficit of four runs in each contest...According to the Elias Sports Bureau, it marked the 10th time in franchise history in which the Bucs won two consecutive games, despite falling behind by four or more runs in each.

**CENTRAL SUCCESS:** The Pirates are 24-9 in their last 33 games against teams from the American League Central dating back to June 15, 2015...Pittsburgh has posted an 8-2 record this season (3-2 at home and 5-0 on the road) against the A.L. Central...The Bucs split a two-game series here against the Twins April 2-4 and took two-of-three from the Tigers April 25-26.

**AGAINST THE JUNIOR CIRCUIT:** The Pirates have played the most interleague games (10) in the Majors so far this season...During those 10 games the Pirates have gone 8-2 while scoring a total of 65 runs (average of 6.5 runs per game)...The Bucs have produced a 66-44 (.600) record against American League teams over the last six seasons (2013-2018); the best mark among all National League teams and the second-best in the Majors behind Boston (68-34; .667).

**INTERLEAGUE BELL RINGER:** In 32 career games against A.L. teams, **Josh Bell** is hitting .321 (34-for-106) with five home runs and 21 RBI...He has reached base safely in 15 of his last 16 interleague games.

**A STARLING SHINING BRIGHT:** **Starling Marte** is riding an eight-game hitting streak, going 14-for-35 (.400) with a double, a triple, three home runs, eight RBI and eight runs scored...Marte shares the National League lead in triples (four), is tied for fifth in hits (46) and runs scored (29) and tied for third in stolen bases (10).

**OUTFIELD OF DREAMS:** Pittsburgh's outfielders have combined to post the best OPS (.859) among National League teams and the second-best in all of baseball behind Boston (.882)...In addition, the group has produced the second-most RBI (77) among all MLB teams behind Boston (78) and trail only the Los Angeles Angels (24) in home runs hit (22).

**THE COMFORTS OF HOME:** The Pirates are 2-1 in a stretch that has them scheduled to play 15-of-18 games at PNC Park...The Bucs have won seven of their last eight games played at home and eight of their last 10...Pittsburgh has posted a 12-6 home record this season; the fourth-best home record in the Majors and the second-best among N.L. teams.

**A RISING ROOKIE:** **Colin Moran** is hitting .396 in 18 home games and has gone 6-for-17 with six RBI while hitting safely in five of his last six games overall...Moran ranks first among N.L. rookies in batting (.288) and shares the league lead in RBI (20)...In addition, he ranks second in OBP (.370) and slugging percentage (.441) while ranking fourth in total bases (49)...In addition, Moran's 18 RBI from the seventh spot in the lineup are the most among any Major League player.

**DOING SOME YARD WORK:** The Pirates have homered nine times in their last four games and 12 times in their last six contests...They have gone deep 19 times in their first 11 games played this month and enter today's action ranked fifth among all National League teams with 48 long balls hit this season.

**GOING BATTY:** The Bucs are batting .313 (66-for-211) over the last six games and .277 (172-for-622) with 26 home runs in their last 18 contests...Overall among National League teams, Pittsburgh ranks second in batting average (.261) and third in slugging (.431), OPS (.762) and runs scored (201).

**REHABBING BUCCOS:** Infielder **Josh Harrison**, on the D.L. since 4/16 with a left hand fracture, went 0-for-3 with a walk while playing seven innings at second base in his first rehab game with Double-A Altoona Monday night...RHP **Joe Musgrove** pitched 5.2 innings of no-hit ball and struck out six batters while winning his rehab start with Triple-A Indianapolis on Saturday, throwing 60 of his 79 pitches for strikes...Musgrove, on the D.L. with a right shoulder strain since 4/2, has posted a 2.13 ERA (12.2ip/3er) in three rehab starts at three different levels.

### ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 15, 1994: Jon Lieber took the loss in his Major League debut in a 1-0 shutout at Veterans Stadium. The only run of the game came in the first inning. The Pirates had runners on second and third with two outs in the ninth inning before Carlos Garcia grounded out to pitcher Doug Jones to end the game.

**JAMESON TAILLON:** The 26-year-old righthander is scheduled to make his ninth start of the season tomorrow afternoon...Tossed 3.0 scoreless innings, but left his last start Friday against the Giants due to a laceration on the middle finger on his right hand...Is 0-3 in his last six starts since tossing a one-hit shutout while whiffing seven in a 5-0 blanking of the Reds at PNC Park on 4/8...Is 2-1 in four starts at PNC Park this season...Has allowed four runs in 14.0 innings in his last three starts since giving up a season-high seven runs in 3.2 innings on 4/25 vs. Detroit.

**vs. CHICAGO (AL):** Has never faced the White Sox...Has gone 4-2 with a 3.40 ERA (47.2ip/18er) in eight career starts during interleague play; is 1-1 with a 9.00 ERA (9.0ip/9er) this year after beating the Twins on 4/2 at PNC Park and losing to the Tigers on 4/25 at PNC Park...Went 2-0 with a 2.19 ERA in four interleague starts last year.
