TRIBE HEADLINES

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** is one of just six players in franchise history to hit 25 home runs before the All-Star break and the first since **Travis Hafner** (25) in 2006...Ramírez sits one stolen base away from becoming the second player in franchise history (**Grady Sizemore** - 2008) to hit 20 homers and steal 20 bases in the first half.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR**'s 24 first-half home runs are the most by an MLB shortstop since **TEX**'s **Alex Rodríguez** (27) in 2002...Lindor is also just the 7th different player in MLB history to score 80 runs and slug 50 extra-base hits in the first half (since All-Star Game began in 1933).
» **CARLOS CARRASCO** enters play tonight with 999 career strikeouts...he is poised to become the 12th pitcher in franchise history to record 1,000 strikeouts in an Indians uniform, as well as the 44th active pitcher in MLB with 1,000 career strikeouts.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians carried a 4-0 lead into the 9th inning, but ultimately fell 7-4 to the Reds in the second game of this three-game set.
» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** each hit solo homers in the bottom of the 1st inning...marked the ninth game this season in which both players have homered, the most of any duo in MLB and the most ever by a Tribe duo before the All-Star break.
» **TYLER NAQUIN** went 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored, while **JASON KIPNIS** extended his home on-base streak to 24 games by drawing a pair of walks.
» **TREVOR BAUER** took a no-decision in a dominant effort, holding the Reds to three hits over 8.0 shutout innings...Bauer fanned 12 batters, marking his eighth start with double-digit strikeouts this season (T2nd-most in MLB).

BAUER UNPACKED

» All-Star **TREVOR BAUER** continued his dominant first half with his 12-strikeout performance vs. Cincinnati last night.
» **Bauer's 168 strikeouts are currently T3rd with Sam McDowell (168 in 1968) for 3rd-most before the All-Star break in franchise history, trailing only Bob Feller (190 in 1946) and another season by McDowell (183 in 1970).** Bauer is slated to make one more start in the first half (Sunday vs. New York-AL).
» Last night, Bauer also extended his active streak to seven consecutive starts with no homers allowed and at least eight strikeouts...per **STATS LLC**, that marks the 2nd-longest streak in baseball's live-ball era (1920-), behind an eight-start streak from Hall-of-Famer **Pedro Martínez** (July 1 - August 10, 2002).
» Bauer's 0.44 Interleague ERA (1ER/20.2IP) this season is tied with Tampa Bay's **Blake Snell** for the lowest in MLB (min. 20.0IP).

HOME SCORING

» Cleveland continues to lead Major League Baseball with 263 runs scored at home, a rate of 5.84 runs per game (2nd-most in MLB)...the Indians also lead the Majors with 432 hits at home, while they rank 2nd with a .277 home batting average (Boston - .288), 3rd with 171 extra-base hits and 4th with 66 home runs.
» Even with the Tribe's current four-game losing streak at home (first since five straight losses, May 16-27, 2017), Cleveland is outscoring opponents 76-39 across their last 12 home games with an 8-4 record in those contests.

STRIKE EARLY

» The Indians struck first in last night's game with a pair of 1st-inning solo homers from **FRANCISCO LINDOR** and **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ**.
» Cleveland has now scored 67 runs in the 1st inning this season, most in the American League and 2nd-most in MLB (Colorado - 74)...the Tribe have also hit 20 homers in the 1st inning, tied with Los Angeles-NL for 2nd-most in MLB (Colorado - 27).

BATTLE OF OHIO

» The Indians and Reds tonight will wrap the first of their two series this season as the clubs square off for the Ohio Cup...following this three-game set at Progressive Field, the Tribe will travel to Great American Ball Park from August 13-15.
» The two teams were evenly matched in the 2017 season series, as both teams went 2-2 and scored 18 runs each...the Tribe owns an 8-5-7 all-time record in season series play vs. Cincinnati.
