The Mariners and Yankees meet for the 5th (0-4) of 6 games this season...the Mariners are 6-20 vs. the Yankees over their last 26 meetings (6/10/14-c), including going 2-12 at Safeco Field during that stretch.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their penultimate homestand of the season – a 10-day, 8-game, 3-team set – with the 2nd of 3 games vs. the New York Yankees (0-1)...won 2-of-3 vs. Baltimore to open the homestand and after an off day on Monday will play 2 games against the San Diego Padres...went 4-5 on a recently-concluded 10-day, 9-game, 3-city road trip to Arizona (2-1), San Diego (0-2) and Oakland (2-2)... tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 13-13 in their last 26 games dating back to Aug. 9...are 23-32 in their last 55 games since July 4 after winning a season-high 8 straight games, spanning June 25 – July 3...the Mariners are 38-39 in their last 77 games since June 10...Seattle is 64-52 in its last 116 games (4/28-c) and 69-55 over its last 124 games (4/20-c)...Seattle is 23-24 during the day and 55-39 at night...Seattle is 40-30 at Safeco Field, 38-33 on the road.

- **My Cousin Vincent** - over his last 12 outings at Safeco Field, dating back to May 20, **Nick Vincent** is 1-0 with 4 holds and a 1.38 ERA (2 ER, 13.0 IP)...during this span, he has recorded 13 strikeouts and 3 walks while limiting opponents to a .125 (6x48) average against and a 0.69 WHIP (3 BB, 6 H, 13.0 IP).
- **Close Games** - the Mariners are 50-23 (.685) this season in games decided by 1 or 2 runs, the highest winning percentage in the Majors...the Mariners are 34-18 (.654) in 1-run games (most 1-run wins in MLB) and 16-5 (.762) in games decided by exactly 2 runs (2nd-best 2-run winning percentage in MLB).
- **Too Close for Comfort** - the Mariners are 64-32 (.667) this season in game decided by 3-runs-or-fewer... the 64 wins are already a franchise high passing the 62 wins in 2009 (62-47/.569).
- **Four Score** - the Mariners are 56-18 when scoring 4-or-more runs, but are 22-45 when scoring 3-or-fewer runs.
- **Get Through 8** - the Mariners are 1 of 2 Major League clubs with a 1.000 winning percentage (67-0) when leading after 8 innings this season, joining Oakland (70-0).
- **Milestones** - **Kyle Seager** (534) trails Raúl Ibañez (540) by 6 for 8th-most runs scored in club history... **Nelson Cruz** (296) is 4 doubles away from 300 in his career...Cruz (999) is also 1 RBI away from 1,000 in his career...he will become the 12th active Major League player with at least 1,000 RBI.
- **400** - **Nelson Cruz** has hit at least 400 RBI with both Seattle (402) and Texas (489)...he is 1 of 7 active players to record at least 400 RBI with 2 different teams, joining Adrián Beltré (LAD-510 & TEX-685), Miguel Cabrera (FLA-523 & DET-1,112), Adrián González (SD-501, LAD-448), Matt Holliday (STL-616 & COL-486), Víctor Martínez (CLE-518 & DET-537) and Albert Pujols (STL-1,329 & LAA-653).
- **Heating Up** - dating back to Aug. 11, **Ryon Healy** is batting .338 (23x68) with 7 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 13 RBI and 4 walks in 19 games.

GOOD TO BE HOME...**Nelson Cruz** has hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field this season, which is T2nd-most all-time at Safeco Field, trailing only **Richie Sexson's** 21 home runs as Safeco Field in 2005...Cruz, who also hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in 2017, is joined by **Bret Boone** (2001) and **Edgar Martínez** (19) as the only other players to hit 19 home runs at Safeco Field in a single season...overall this season, Cruz's 19 home run at home are T4th-most in the American League (also: **José Ramírez-CLE**), trailing only **J.D. Martínez-BOS** (22), **Joey Gallo-TEX** (21) and **Khris Davis-OAK** (20).

ELECTRIC EDDIE...**Edwin Díaz** is 6 strikeouts away from recording 300 in his career...his 294 career strikeouts are currently 7th-most in club history by a reliever, trailing only **Jeff Nelson** (471), **Mike Jackson** (383), **Bobby Ayala** (374), **J.J. Putz** (337), **Arthur Rhodes** (315) and **Tom Wilhelmson** (307)...since making his debut, his 294 strikeouts currently rank 3rd in the Majors dating back to 2016, trailing only **Dellin Betances** (327) and **Brad Hand** (312), while ranking ahead of **Craig Kimbrel** (293) and **Kenley Jansen** (284).

BULLPEN BULLIES...the Mariners bullpen has recorded 28 wins this season, which are 6th-most in club history...trail only Mariners relievers from 2002 (33-21/.611), 2001 (33-15/.688), 2017 (31-31/.500), 1996 (29-24/.547) and 2007 (29-12/.707).

MULTI-HIT MADNESS...**Jean Segura** has recorded 49 multi-hit contests this season, ranking T5th in the Major Leagues...with 1 more multi-hit game will become the 42nd player in club history with at least 50 multi-hit efforts in a single season and first since **Robinson Canó** (59) and **Nelson Cruz** (52) in 2016...**Ichiro** holds the single season franchise record with 80 multi-hit games in 2004...it will also mark **Segura's** 2nd career season with at least 50 multi-hit contests (also: 57 with ARI in 2016).

FACING HIS FORMER TEAM...**Robinson Canó** has hit safely in 20 of 26 games vs. the Yankees, including reaching base safely in 22 of 24 games as a starter...overall he is batting .333 (32x96) with 13 runs scored, 4 doubles, 4 home runs, 14 RBI, 1 HBP, 7 walks and 1 stolen base in 26 career games vs. the Yankees... since 2014, **Canó's** .337 batting average vs. the Yankees is the T5th-highest among all active players in the Major Leagues (also: **Francisco Lindor**, .333/38x114), trailing **Adam Eaton** (.427/35x82), **José Ramírez** (.368/43x117), **Michael Brantley** (.341/31x91) and **Adeiny Hechavarria** .338/31x92).

THE EDWIN DÍAZ REPORT...in 67 games this season, **Edwin Díaz** is 53-for-57 (92.98%) in save opportunities with a 1.87 ERA (14 ER, 67.1 IP) with 117 strikeouts and 16 walks...he has limited opposing batters to a .155 (36x233) average against with a 0.77 WHIP (16 BB, 36 H, 67.1 IP)...here are some notes on Díaz's standout season:

- Leads the Major Leagues with 53 saves...**Craig Kimbrel-BOS** and **Wade Davis-COL** are 2nd with 38.
- Is the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in ML history to record at least 50 saves in a season.
- Ranks 2nd in Major League relievers with 117 strikeouts...**Josh Hader-MIL** is 1st with 121.
- Leads the Major Leagues with 26 one-run saves...**Blake Treinen-OAK** is 2nd with 17.
- Is 26-for-29 (89.6%) in one-run save opportunities with a 0.92 ERA (3 ER, 29.1 IP) with 54 strikeouts and 5 walks...the Mariners are 29-0 this season when he enters with a one-run lead.
- Has struck out 46.0% (115 K, 250 BF) of batters faced this season, the top mark this season and the 4th-best single-season strikeout rate by a reliever in Major League history.
- His .155 opponents average against is the lowest in American League history among pitchers with at least 45 save opportunities (93 such seasons in AL history).
- His 0.77 WHIP is 2nd-lowest in American League history among pitchers with at least 45 save opportunities...only **Dennis Eckersley-OAK** (0.61, 1990) has posted a lower WHIP in a season with at least 45 save opportunities (93 such seasons in AL history).
- Has struck out his 1st batter faced 32 times this season, most in the Majors (**Adam Ottavino-COL**, 30). The Mariners are 62-0 when he enters with a lead, including 29-0 when he enters with a 1-run lead.

AS YOU KNOW...**Nelson Cruz** has hit 160 home runs in his first 4 seasons with the Mariners...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...his 160 home runs with Seattle are T7th-most in first 4 seasons with a single team (also: **Albert Pujols-STL** - 2001-04 & **Cecil Fielder-DET** - 1990-93)?...he trails **Mark McGwire-STL** (1997-2000, 191 HR), **Babe Ruth-NYY** (1920-23, 189 HR), **Álex Rodríguez-NYY** (2004-07, 173 HR), **David Ortiz-BOS** (2003-06, 173 HR), **Ralph Kiner-PIT** (1946-49, 168 HR) and **Jimmie Foxx-BOS** (1936-39, 162 HR) for most home runs in first 4 season with a single team.

ABOUT FÉLIX...

- 32-year-old right-hander is making his 403rd career appearance (402nd start), his 27th start of the season and his 23rd career start vs. New York-AL tonight.
- Is the only active pitcher in MLB who holds his current club's all-time record for career wins and career strikeouts (see more in "He's Our Leader").
- Is the second pitcher in franchise history to record 300 games started as a Mariner (also: Jamie Moyer, 323 GS w/Seattle 1996-2006).
- Signed a 7-year deal through the 2019 season on Feb. 13, 2013.
- In 2010 won the AL Cy Young, garnering 21 of 28 first-place votes... joined Randy Johnson (1995) as only Mariners pitchers to win the Cy Young... named Sporting News AL Pitcher of the Year... was 2nd in Cy Young voting in 2014.
- ML debut Aug. 4, 2005 at Detroit... Safeco debut vs. MIN Aug. 9, 2005.
- At 19 years, 118 days old at debut, was the 3rd-youngest player to debut in Mariners history & 2nd-youngest pitcher... youngest pitcher since Jose Rijo worked as reliever in '84 (19 years, 54 days, 7/6/84 at MIN).
- Born in Valencia, VZ... signed as 16-year-old non-drafted FA 7/4/02.
- A.L. All-Star: 2009, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 (starter) & 2015, most by any Mariner pitcher and 4th most overall behind Ken Griffey Jr. (10), Ichiro Suzuki (10) and Edgar Martinez (7).
- Threw the first Perfect Game in Mariners history, and 23rd in ML history, Aug. 15, 2012 in a 1-0 victory over Tampa Bay at Safeco Field (9,0,0,0,0,12)... 7th PG in MLB history to be decided in a 1-0 game, and 1st in the AL since 1984.
- Is 24-23 with a 3.43 ERA (157 ER, 412.0 IP) in 64 career games started in September.

LAST OUTING... took the loss in his last start, as the Mariners fell 2-8 at Oakland on Sept. 2... allowed 4 runs on 4 hits and 2 walks while striking out 3 batters across 5+ innings pitched... held the Athletics scoreless until a 5th-inning solo home run by Stephen Piscotty... faced 3 batters in the 6th without recording an out (1B, BB, 1B) with 2 wild pitches... 2 runs scored on a single by Marcus Semien and Nick Vincent came on in relief; Semien came around to score.

CLIMBING THE RANKS... has 2,461 career strikeouts, T38th-most in Major League history (also: Jim Kaat)... with 4 more strikeouts, Félix will pass Jim Kaat and Mark Langston (2,464 K) for 37th-most strikeouts in ML history with 2,465... he is averaging 7.25 K's per 9.0 innings this year.

HE'S BACK... was placed on the 10-day disabled list July 10 (retro. to July 8) to July 21 with lower back stiffness.

IMPRESSIVE START... since 2005, has recorded 55 starts in which he has thrown at least 6.0 innings and not allowed a run... that total ranks 2nd among starting pitchers behind only Clayton Kershaw (64)... the next closest pitchers are Justin Verlander and Jon Lester with 53... during this stretch Félix has recorded 255 quality starts, the 2nd-most in the Major Leagues, behind only Verlander (275).

2017 SEASON RECAP... went 6-5 with a 4.36 ERA (42 ER, 86.2 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 26 walks in 16 starts... placed on the 10-day DL on April 26 with right shoulder inflammation... activated on June 23 after making three rehab starts (6/6, 6/11, 6/17 w/AAA Tacoma)... spent a second stint on the 10-day DL on Aug. 5 (retro to Aug. 2) with right shoulder bursitis... activated on Sept. 14.

HE'S OUR LEADER... became the Mariners all-time career leader in strikeouts on April 23, 2016 at the Angels (previous: Randy Johnson, 2,162)... became the club's all-time career leader in wins on May 9, 2016 vs. the Rays (previous: Jamie Moyer, 145)... is the only active pitcher in MLB who holds his current club's all-time record for career wins and strikeouts... Chicago-AL's James Shields holds both records for Tampa Bay, while Arizona's Jorge De La Rosa owns both records for Colorado.

VENEZUELAN PRIDE... Félix is one of two pitchers from Venezuela to win the Cy Young (also: Johan Santana, 2004 & 2006)... among pitchers born in Venezuela, Félix holds the all-time record for wins, starts, innings pitched and strikeouts.

CAREER... has spent entire pro career with Seattle... 6-time All-Star (2009, 2011-15), 2-time ERA champ (2010, 2014), 2010 AL Cy Young Award winner... is 168-127 with a 3.33 ERA (981 ER, 2650.0 IP) in 402 career appearances (401 starts) with 25 CG, 11 ShO, and 1 Perfect Game... holds Mariners all-time career records for wins, starts, quality starts (255), innings pitched and strikeouts (2,461).

28-year-old right-hander will be making his 7th start of the season tomorrow against the Yankees, his 5th since being activated from the DL on Aug. 12... W#2 in his last start, a 2-1 Mariners win vs. BAL on 9/3 (5.1,2.1,1.0,5,HR)... went 1-0 with a 1.13 ERA (2 ER, 16.0 IP) in 3 starts from Aug. 12 to 24... was on the 10-day DL with a right Teres Major strain, May 1-Aug. 12... opened the season on the 10-day DL with right lat strain, March 28-April 7... made 2 starts, April 22 at TEX (4.2,5.5,5.1,1.2 HR) and April 27 at CLE (5.0,9.6,6.0,5,HB,HR-5) before heading back to the DL... CAREER: 32-38 with a 4.27 ERA (297 ER, 626.0 IP) in 189 games (89 starts) in parts of 7 seasons from 2012-18... made his MLB debut with the Mariners on April 9, 2012 (3.0,2.1,1.1,3,HR-1)... vs. NYY: Is making his 18th career appearance (5th start) against the Yankees... is 2-2 with a 3.66 ERA (16 ER, 39.1 IP) in 17 career games (4 starts) against New York-AL... in 4 career starts vs. the Yankees, is 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (3 ER, 24.0 IP) with 2 quality starts, holding New York to a .139 average (11x79).
