**THE TWINS:** The Twins have gone 5-3 through eight games on their 11-day homestand... tonight they will play the first of four against the Angels through the weekend... following this series, the Twins will enjoy an off-day Monday, then begin a six-game roadtrip with three at Ron Gardenhire's Tigers June 12-14, then three at Cleveland June 15-17...the Twins are 16-15 at home this season, winning five of their last seven here at Target Field.

**TWINS FINISH SERIES WITH SOX AT A SPLIT:** The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-2... José Berrios (7-5) was the starter and winner, pitching a complete game, the second of his season/career...he allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts...the offense recorded nine hits, six going for extra bases, three for home runs by Eddie Rosario, Eduardo Escobar and Ehire Adrianza...the game lasted 2 hours and 14 minutes, the shortest Twins game this season.

**TWINS AND ANGELS:** The Twins and Angels are playing the fifth of seven games this season... they last played May 10-13 at Angel Stadium, splitting the four-game series as the Twins won the middle two...the Twins are 11-6 against the Angels since 2016, going 3-1-1 in those series...11 wins marks their most against any non-divisional opponent in that span...the Twins went 2-12 vs. the Angels from 2014-15.

☞ Brian Dozier is 8-for-15 (.533) with two home runs, five RBI and two walks against the Angels this season.

☞ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in eight straight against the Angels, hitting .412 (14-for-34) in those games...in 16 career games vs. LAA, he is hitting .306 (19-for-62) with a .394 OBP.

☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with a .392 on-base percentage in his last 13 games against the Angels.

**ARROWS FLYING:** Former Angel Fernando Rodney has converted each of his last 11 save opportunities after beginning the season 2-for-5 in save opportunities...he has held opponents scoreless in 13 of his last 14 appearances, posting to a .125 batting average with six hits allowed (1 extra-base hit - home run to Jorge Soler May 28) and five walks in that span...he is within one of tying Robb Nen for 21st place on baseball's all-time saves list:

**EXTRA-BASE ESCY:** Eduardo Escobar has hit safely in eight of his last nine games...during that stretch he is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and six multi-hit games...he enters today first in baseball in doubles with 24...he also ranks fourth in baseball in extra-base hits (36), trailing José Ramirez (38), Mookie Betts (37) and Mike Trout (37).

**ROSIES ARE RED (HOT):** Eddie Rosario has multiple hits in eight of his last 13 games...since the start of May, Eddie Rosario is hitting .364 (52-for-143) with 12 doubles, 11 home runs, 31 RBI, 27 runs scored, a .405 on-base percentage, .678 slugging percentage and a 1.084 OPS in 35 games...among AL players since the start of May, he ranks first in RBI, third in batting average, fourth in OPS, fifth in slugging and sixth in OBP.

**MWL STARS:** The Midwest League recently announced the rosters for the 54th Midwest League All-Star Game, scheduled for June 19th at Cooley Law School Stadium in Lansing, MI, and the Cedar Rapids Kernels have two starters and two reserves selected to the team... the All-Stars were nominated and selected by the field managers of the 16 Midwest League teams...Royce Lewis was selected as the starting shortstop for the MWL West squad and OF Alex Kirilloff was named a starting outfielder...pitchers Brusdar Graterol and Jared Finkel were selected as reserves for the MWL West squad.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY:** In 2006, the Twins beat the Mariners in Seattle by a score of 7-3...at the time, the Twins were 26-33 and in fourth place, 11.5 games back in the AL Central...that particular win sparked a stretch of 21 wins in their next 23 games and the Twins would go 71-33 the rest of the way, winning the division with a record of 96-66...in 2013, Joe Mauer hit his 100th career home run at Washington, a fifth inning solo shot off Gio Gonzalez...16 players in Twins history have hit 100 home runs as a Twin...Mauer has 138 for his career, 12th most in club history.

**PURPLE RAIN:** The Twins are celebrating Prince Night at Target Field tonight, honoring the late Minneapolis icon who passed away in April of 2016...some highlights of the night include: First 10,000 fans receive a limited-edition Inflatable Prince Guitar, Twins players will wear Prince-themed T-shirts during batting practice, Prince's Model C guitar will be displayed at the Twins Digital Clubhouse, and many more elements.

**LAST START:** Earned his fourth win of the season and third consecutive June 2 vs. Cleveland opposite Trevor Bauer as the Twins won 7-1...lasted 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on just two hits...issued five walks, tied for the second-most of the season (done three other times previously)...did not allow a home run for the fourth consecutive start after allowing five home runs in his first five starts...the two hits allowed marked a season-low.

**AGAINST LOS ANGELES-AL:** Lynn is making his third career-start against the Angels and second of the season...his previous start this season at Los Angeles resulted in a no decision after 4.2 innings and four runs on eight hits...the Twins won the game 5-4 after a three run ninth inning...in his career is 0-1 with a 7.59 ERA (10.2 IP, 9 ER) against the Angels...this will be Lynn's first home-start vs. the Angels.

**OH MAY!:** Lynn began the season 0-3 with a 8.37 ERA (23.2 IP, 22 ER) with 23 walks in April...this marked his worst start to a season in his career, with his previous April-high ERA being 3.63 in 2015 and issuing no more than 13 walks in an April previously...Lynn turned the corner his first start of May, earning his first win at the White Sox...since that win he has suffered only one loss and added three more wins...in May he walked 10 batters in five starts and allowed just one home run.

**LYNN ROLLIN':** He is 3-0, 1.45 ERA (18.2 IP, 3 ER) with nine walks and 14 strikeouts in his last three starts after starting the season going 1-4, 7.47 ERA (37.1 IP, 31 ER) with 29 walks and 41 strikeouts in his previous eight starts...his 1.45 ERA ranks fifth best among American League starters and ninth in baseball during that span.

**ALL OR NOTHING:** In his 11 starts this season, Lynn is boasting an 8.84 SO/9, which ranks in the top 25 in the American League (22nd)...on the other end of the charts, Lynn has a 6.11 BB/9 ratio, highest in the AL among pitchers with 10-or-more starts and highest of his career...his next highest BB/9 was in 2013 with a 4.03 ratio and his best walks-per-nine mark was in 2012 with 2.00 BB/9.

**MR. 1,000:** Lynn eclipsed the 1000.0 inning mark for his career in his start on April 30 against Toronto...there are 71 active players in MLB that have 1,000-or-more innings, 12 of those have 2,000+ IP and just two have 3,000 IP or more...Lynn ranks 71st in innings among actives with 1033.2 innings.

- First pitcher in Twins uniform to reach 1,000.0 innings pitched since Phil Hughes in April of 2015.
- Lynn currently has 974 career-strikeouts, 26 short of the 1,000 strikeout mark.

**WALK-A-LOT:** In 2017 Lynn ranked second in MLB and in the NL for most BB/9 (3.77) behind Arizona's Robbie Ray who had a 3.94 BB/9...his 3.77 mark was the highest of his career (2015 - 3.49, 2014 - 3.18, 2013 - 3.39, and 2012 - 3.27)...in his first season back from "Tommy John" surgery Lynn issued 78 walks in 186.1 innings...Lynn issued 44 walks on the road vs. 34 walks at home and of his 78 walks last season 53 came against left-handed batters...Lynn is among the league leaders in walks in 2018, yielding 38 free passes in 11 starts, which is tied for second-most in the AL.

### 2017 RECAP:

- Lynn ranked tied for first in the NL in games started (33) sixth in AVG (.223), sixth in fewest H/9 (7.29), and seventh in ERA (3.43).
- Lynn had five starts of 7.0 or-more innings and 19 starts of 6.0 or-more innings, going 9-2 across those starts with 92 strikeouts.
- On May 5 against Los Angeles-NL, Lynn went 8.0 innings pitched while allowing just two hits, one run and 10 strikeouts.
- From April 17-May 5 Lynn had a season-high four-game win-streak posting a 0.72 ERA (25.0 IP, 2 ER) while striking out 23.

**TOUGH TO HIT:** In 2017 Lynn was among the top-10 pitchers in average against...batters hit .219, ranking him ninth in MLB and sixth in the NL...Lynn ranked 10th in the NL for lowest average against righties with a .203 mark...lefties had more success against Lynn with a .245 average against.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - KYLE GIBSON [SEASON: 1-3, 3.54 ERA ; CAREER: 45-51, 4.60 ERA]

Gibson will be making his 13th start of the season and seventh at Target Field...is 2-2 with a 5.05 ERA (51.2 IP, 29 ER) against the Angels across nine starts in his career...started against Los Angeles-AL earlier this season on May 12, did not earn the decision after going 6.0 innings and allowing two runs on three hits, walking four and striking out six...Gibson is 1-0 at Target Field against the Angels.
