THE TWINS: The Twins have gone 5-3 through eight games on their 11-day homestand... tonight they will play the first of four against the Angels through the weekend... following this series, the Twins will enjoy an off-day Monday, then begin a six-game roadtrip with three at Ron Gardenhire's Tigers June 12-14, then three at Cleveland June 15-17...the Twins are 16-15 at home this season, winning five of their last seven here at Target Field.

TWINS FINISH SERIES WITH SOX AT A SPLIT: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon by a score of 7-2... José Berrios (7-5) was the starter and winner, pitching a complete game, the second of his season/career... he allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and 10 strikeouts... the offense recorded nine hits, six going for extra bases, three for home runs by Eddie Rosario, Eduardo Escobar and Ehire Adrianza... the game lasted 2 hours and 14 minutes, the shortest Twins game this season.

TWINS AND ANGELS: The Twins and Angels are playing the fifth of seven games this season... they last played May 10-13 at Angel Stadium, splitting the four-game series as the Twins won the middle two... the Twins are 11-6 against the Angels since 2016, going 3-1-1 in those series... 11 wins marks their most against any non-divisional opponent in that span... the Twins went 2-12 vs. the Angels from 2014-15.

☞ Brian Dozier is 8-for-15 (.533) with two home runs, five RBI and two walks against the Angels this season.

☞ Miguel Sanó has hit safely in eight straight against the Angels, hitting .412 (14-for-34) in those games... in 16 career games vs. LAA, he is hitting .306 (19-for-62) with a .394 OBP.

☞ Robbie Grossman is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with a .392 on-base percentage in his last 13 games against the Angels.

ARROWS FLYING: Former Angel Fernando Rodney has converted each of his last 11 save opportunities after beginning the season 2-for-5 in save opportunities... he has held opponents scoreless in 13 of his last 14 appearances, posting to a .125 batting average with six hits allowed (1 extra-base hit - home run to Jorge Soler May 28) and five walks in that span... he is within one of tying Robb Nen for 21st place on baseball's all-time saves list:

EXTRA-BASE ESCY: Eduardo Escobar has hit safely in eight of his last nine games... during that stretch he is hitting .441 (15-for-34) with six doubles, five home runs, 15 RBI and six multi-hit games... he enters today first in baseball in doubles with 24... he also ranks fourth in baseball in extra-base hits (36), trailing José Ramirez (38), Mookie Betts (37) and Mike Trout (37).

ROSIES ARE RED (HOT): Eddie Rosario has multiple hits in eight of his last 13 games... since the start of May, Eddie Rosario is hitting .364 (52-for-143) with 12 doubles, 11 home runs, 31 RBI, 27 runs scored, a .405 on-base percentage, .678 slugging percentage and a 1.084 OPS in 35 games... among AL players since the start of May, he ranks first in RBI, third in batting average, fourth in OPS, fifth in slugging and sixth in OBP.

MWL STARS: The Midwest League recently announced the rosters for the 54th Midwest League All-Star Game, scheduled for June 19th at Cooley Law School Stadium in Lansing, MI, and the Cedar Rapids Kernels have two starters and two reserves selected to the team... the All-Stars were nominated and selected by the field managers of the 16 Midwest League teams... Royce Lewis was selected as the starting shortstop for the MWL West squad and OF Alex Kirilloff was named a starting outfielder... pitchers Brusdar Graterol and Jared Finkel were selected as reserves for the MWL West squad.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2006, the Twins beat the Mariners in Seattle by a score of 7-3... at the time, the Twins were 26-33 and in fourth place, 11.5 games back in the AL Central... that particular win sparked a stretch of 21 wins in their next 23 games and the Twins would go 71-33 the rest of the way, winning the division with a record of 96-66... in 2013, Joe Mauer hit his 100th career home run at Washington, a fifth inning solo shot off Gio Gonzalez... 16 players in Twins history have hit 100 home runs as a Twin... Mauer has 138 for his career, 12th most in club history.

PURPLE RAIN: The Twins are celebrating Prince Night at Target Field tonight, honoring the late Minneapolis icon who passed away in April of 2016... some highlights of the night include: First 10,000 fans receive a limited-edition Inflatable Prince Guitar, Twins players will wear Prince-themed T-shirts during batting practice, Prince's Model C guitar will be displayed at the Twins Digital Clubhouse, and many more elements.

• Has started 31 games...hit in three-hole in first 30 he has started...hit 5th last night.
• XBH in 6 straight games 3/31-4/7, one shy of the longest such streak for a Twins player in March/April...Joe Judge has the franchise record of 8 set with Washington (4/23-30/22).
