Not Facing the Mets

RHP Mike Foltynewicz has made 82 appearances with Atlanta since the club acquired him in January of 2015, but has pitched just twice against the New York Mets while with the Braves.

Atlanta has played the Mets 67 times since acquiring Foltynewicz, and 40 Braves pitchers have made three or more appearances against New York in that span.

He last faced them in May of 2016. Tonight will mark the first time Foltynewicz pitched against the Mets in Atlanta.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Mets begin a two-game set tonight with the 11th meeting between the clubs this season...These two games mark the Mets' final trip to Atlanta this season; the Braves will travel to New York for four games, August 2-5 and then for three games, September 25-27.

- A* The Braves have won seven of their first 10 games with the Mets this season, outscoring New York 57-35...They won seven games against the Mets all of last season.
- A* RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set to face the Mets for the first time since 2016...He is 0-1 with a 10.45 ERA (12 ER/10.1 IP) in three games, two starts, against the Mets.
- A* RHP Zack Wheeler, who grew up in Smyrna, Ga., and made his MLB at Turner Field in 2013, is set to face Atlanta for the first time since 2014...He is 4-2 with a 2.94 ERA (16 ER/49.0 IP) in eight career games, all starts, against the Braves.

VS. THE N.L. EAST: The Braves are 25-14 (.641) against the National League this season, and the club's 39 games against division rivals are the most interdivision games any MLB team has played so far this season.

- A* The Braves are 5-2 against Miami, 7-3 against New York, 7-5 against Philadelphia and 6-4 against Washington.
- A* Following this two-game set with the Mets, the Braves will play 27 games outside the division... They make return to N.L. East play with the first series out of the All-Star break, a three-game set in Washington, July 20-July 22.

HOME GAMES: The Braves will play 12 of their next 14 games at SunTrust Park, after they entered play today having played the fewest home games in the majors at 28.

- A* The Braves are averaging 5.07 runs per game at home, the best mark in the National League and the fourth-highest average in the majors...Only Cleveland (5.84), New York (5.84) and Boston (5.74) are better.

SCHEDULE: The Braves' next 14 games are all against teams with a record below .500...Three of the teams are in last place, while the other two are in fourth place.

- A* The Braves have played 19 games against teams below .500, the fewest in the majors among teams not in last place...Only Miami (16) and Texas (18) have played fewer such games.
- A* The Braves have gone 10-9 against teams with a losing record this season.

LENGTH: The Braves are 22-7 when their starting pitcher goes at least 6.0 innings and 8-1 when he pitches at least 7.0.

ALL-STAR VOTING: 1B Freddie Freeman leads all National League players in fan balloting for the 2018 MLB All-Star Game...Freeman, who has been named to two All-Star teams as a reserve, has received 633,342 votes...The next closest N.L. player is Colorado's Nolan Arenado at 527,683.

- A* 2B Ozzie Albies also leads second baseman with 398,816 votes, while OF Nick Markakis is second among outfielders with 494,206.
- A* The Braves last had three position players in the All-Star game in 2012, when OF Michael Bourn, 3B Chipper Jones and 2B Dan Uggla all made the squad.
- A* The last Braves player to start an All-Star game was Dan Uggla at second base in 2012.
- A* The last time the Braves had three All-Star starters was 1998, when 3B Chipper Jones, SS Walt Weiss and RHP Greg Maddux started in a 13-8 loss to the American League at Coors Field.
- A* The last time the Braves had three position players start an All-Star game was 1960, when C Del Crandall, 1B Joe Adcock, 3B Eddie Mathews and RF Hank Aaron started both All-Star games that season.

FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman is tied for first in the National League with 85 hits, while his .998 OPS is the best...He is also tied for first with 19 doubles, is second with a .340 batting average, a .430 on-base percentage and a .568 slugging percentage, and first with 142 total bases.

- A* He has hit safely in 21 of his last 22 games, going 34-for-90 (.378) over this stretch with seven doubles and four home runs.
- A* Freeman also leads the majors with a .455 (25-for-55) batting average with runners in scoring position, while his .522 on-base percentage in these situations is second to Los Angeles' Mike Trout (.525).
- A* Since the franchise moved to Atlanta in 1966, only two qualifying Braves have finished a season with a batting average over .400 with runners in scoring position: Freeman in 2013 (.443) and Lonnie Smith in 1989 (.418).
- A* Freeman also holds three of the four highest on-base percentages with runners in scoring position in Atlanta franchise history...He compiled a .541 mark in 2013, a .512 mark in 2015 and a .509 percentage last season...David Justice reached at a .536 clip in 1994.

OZZIE: 2B Ozzie Albies hit his 15th home run of the year on Sunday, becoming just the third second baseman in Atlanta franchise history to reach that mark in a season prior to the All-Star break...Davey Johnson hit 23 in 1973, while Dan Uggla had 18 in 2013 and 15 in 2011...Albies is tied for second in the league with his 15 homers.

Tonight's Game

- A* Set to make his 14th start of the season and the 79th of his career...Is his 99th career appearance.
- A* Slated to face the Mets for just the fourth time in his career...Is 0-1 with a 10.45 ERA (12 ER/10.1 IP) and a .408 opponents' batting average in three career appearances against New York.
- A* Has never faced the Mets in his home ballpark...All three of his career outings have come at Citi Field.
- A* Did not face New York last season, and has not pitched against the Mets since 5/2/16...Allowed eight hits and four runs over 3.2 innings in that start, which marked his season debut.
- A* Foltyniewicz has made 82 appearances with Atlanta since the club acquired him in January of 2015, but has pitched just twice against New York while with the Braves...Atlanta has played the Mets 67 times since acquiring Foltyniewicz, and 40 Braves pitchers have made three or more appearances against New York in that span.
- A* Was saddled with his fourth loss of the season in his last start, 6/6 at SD, despite allowing just two earned runs over 5.0 innings of work.
- A* The outing was his 12th of the season (in 13 total starts) in which he allowed no more than two earned runs, tied for the second most such starts in the majors this season...Only WSH's Max Scherzer has more (13 starts).
- A* Foltyniewicz is 5-3 on the season when allowing two or fewer earned runs... His three losses in such starts are tied for most in the majors.
- A* Is a perfect 5-0 when getting at least four runs of support...Is 0-4, while Atlanta is 0-8 as a team, when Foltyniewicz receives three or fewer runs of support while on the mound.

2018 Recap

- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. WSH...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
- A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A* Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
- A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th game.
- A* Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI... Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
- A* Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career, and has since tossed one more...Since he joined Atlanta in 2015, his five 10+ strikeout games are most on the pitching staff.
- A* Earned his third win of the season, 5/10 at MIA, after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just three hits and one unearned run.
- A* Received eight runs of support, his most on the season and his most since also getting eight runs on 6/7/17...Entered his start against Miami averaging just 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings over his last 14 turns, fewest in the N.L.
- A* Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SF...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
- A* The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A* Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
- A* Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A* Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.
- A* The no-decision snapped of streak of seven consecutive losses after he dropped each of his final seven starts of 2017...His skid in consecutive starts was one short of the franchise record, set by Preston Hanna from 1976-1978 and matched by Shelby Miller in 2015.

Career Recap

- A* Was diagnosed with costochondritis on 9/2/15 and sidelined for the remainder of the season...Underwent surgery on 9/21/15, to remove the anterior half of his first rib...The procedure was performed by Dr. William Mayfield at Wellstar Kennestone Hospital in Marietta, Ga.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 18/12 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3

- Right-handed batters have just five hits in 50 at-bats (.100) against him...Lefties are hitting .414/.485/.793 with 12 hits, three walks, two doubles, three home runs and seven RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Five of his 18 appearances this season have gone at least 2.0 innings, most among Braves relievers.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/17 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 12/3

- Has allowed six earned runs on nine hits and four walks in his last seven appearances (7.0 IP) dating to 5/21 at PHI...Made 14 consecutive appearances totaling 15.1 innings without allowing a run just ahead of his recent skid, and in his first 26.0 innings of the season, 3/30-5/19, allowed just two earned runs.
- Holding batters to a .164 (9-for-55) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-31, .097) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .273 (18-for-66) with no one on base.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .235 (16-for-68) average...Lefties are hitting .208 (11-for-53).

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/2 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 32/21 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 26/6

- After making 28 appearances (22.1 IP) to open the season without allowing a home run, has given up two in his last four outings (3.1 IP).
- Blew his second save, 6/2 vs. NYM, after allowing a leadoff homer to lefty Juan Soto...Left-handed batters are hitting just 6-for-35 (.171) against him, but each of his two home runs allowed have come off lefties.
- Ranks tied for 11th in the majors with 32 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Has inherited 26 runners on the season, and has stranded 20 (77%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 5/3 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/1

- Allowed a career high-matching six runs (all earned) in just 0.2 of an inning last Monday, 6/4 at SD...Prior to that outing, had allowed just one run and four total base runners over 7.0 IP (1.29 ERA) spanning three relief app.
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP, 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA)...Went 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP).

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 3/1 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 0/0

- Had his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett on Monday, 6/4, for his third stint with ATL this season...Also selected on 4/4 before being DFA'd on 4/15, selected again on 5/6 before being outrighted to GWN on 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/the Stripers...Did not allow an earned run in his last 16.0 innings with GWN, while holding the opposition to a .098 batting average (dating to 4/30).
- Made his Atlanta season debut 4/9 at WSH, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning with two walks and two strikeouts.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 27/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 8/2

- Earned his eighth hold Saturday, 6/9 at LAD, after entering a 4-2 game in the sixth inning and striking out C. Bellinger...Did allow one run to score in the seventh (2B and WP)...The 1.1 IP matched his career high (6th time).
- Used 12 pitches to strike out the side in Wednesday's (6/6) seventh inning at SD...Was his second career outing that went at least 1.0 inning with him striking out each batter he faced (also 4/11/18 at WSH, 13 pitches)
- Has a 5.40 ERA (10 ER/16.2 IP) over his last 19 games...Opened his season with eight scoreless app. (8.1 IP).
- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors (tied).
- Earned a decision (3 wins, one save) in four consecutive appearances, 5/12-20.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN.
