NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees are **1-0 on their six-game homestand...are 10-2 in their last 12 games...are a season-high-tying 24 games over .500.**
 - Are a Major League-best 34-3 (.919) when allowing four-or-fewer runs this season.
 - Are 4-2 in their first six completed Interleague games this season...are 10-2 in Interleague play since 7/25/17.
- Are 18-4 in their last 22 home games...are 23-9 (.719) at Yankee Stadium this season, the Majors' best home winning percentage and tied for the most home wins (also Boston).
- Today marked the second day of the Yankees' 10th annual HOPE Week...the Yankees are 31-12 (.721) since the event began in 2009...have won 19 of their last 23 games during HOPE Week.
- Yankees pitchers** shut out their opponent for the fourth time this season and first time at Yankee Stadium...have posted a 1.86 ERA (92.0IP, 19ER) in 10 games in June...have allowed a run in just three of their last 50.0IP (6ER).
 - Yankees relievers** own a 21.2-inning scoreless streak since 6/4 (Game 2), striking out 30 batters over the stretch (8H, 6BB, 2HP).
- LHP CC Sabathia** (5.2IP, 4H, 0R, 3BB, 3K, 1HP) started and earned the win...marked his second scoreless appearance of the season (also 5/4 vs. Cleveland, 6.0IP)...threw 101 pitches, his most since 8/31/17 vs. Boston (102).
 - Collected his 1,500th *strikeout as a Yankee* in the fourth inning (Taylor, swinging).
 - Was his 521st career start, tying Andy Pettitte and Jim Palmer for 38th place on Baseball's all-time starts list.
 - Is 11-0 with a 2.55 ERA (98.2IP, 28ER) in 17 regular season starts following a Yankees loss since the start of 2017.
 - Was his 241st career win, surpassing Frank Tanana (240) and tying Herb Pennock for 54th place on Baseball's all-time wins list...also surpassed Tanana and tied Pennock for 13th place on the all-time wins list among left-handers...was his 124th win as a Yankee, surpassing Mike Mussina (123) for sole possession of 12th place on the Yankees' wins list.
- Yankees batters** have had a Major League-best 14 multi-HR games in 2018, trailing the 1996 Mariners (15) for the most by any team in MLB history through their first 63G of a season...the MLB single-season record is 24 individual multi-HR games by the 1961 Yankees and 1966 Braves.
- SS Didi Gregorius** (2-for-4) hit two solo HRs, collecting his fourth career multi-HR game and third of the season first since 4/16 vs. Miami...his three multi-HR games *as a shortstop* are a single-season franchise record.
 - Is batting .295 (13-for-44) over his last 12 games (since 5/28)...over his previous 16 games (5/4-27), hit .060 (4-for-67).
- C Austin Romine** (1-for-2, 1RBI, 1SF) has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games (since 4/30), batting .410 (16-for-39) with 10R, 4 doubles, 4HR and 14RBI.
- RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-3, 1BB) is batting .348 (39-for-112) with 28R, 7 doubles, 12HR, 33RBI and 34BB in 32 home games this season.

WASHINGTON NATIONALS NOTES

- The Nationals fell in the first game of their five-game road trip...suffered their first loss in Interleague play, falling to 5-1 vs. the AL East (also 2-0 vs. Tampa Bay and 3-0 vs. Baltimore)...fell to 21-12 (.636) on the road this season...fell to 27-15 when their starter goes at least six innings...dropped to 13-16 all-time vs. the Yankees and 3-3 at the current Yankee Stadium.
- Have been shutout for two consecutive games, which ties a franchise record since moving to Washington in 2005 (12th time, first since 4/27-28/2016)...have been shutout four times this season...have not scored in their last 19.0IP (since the eighth on 6/9)...are a combined 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position in their last two games and have stranded 13 runners on base over the span.
- RHP Tanner Roark** (6.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 2BB, 5K, 2HR) completed at least 6.0IP for the 11th straight start (since 4/13), extending the longest such streak of his career...tied his season high by allowing 2HR (third time, last on 4/24 at San Francisco)...is winless in his last six *road* starts (since 4/18 at New York-NL), going 0-3 with a 3.40 ERA (39.2IP, 15ER)...has received 2R-or-fewer runs of support in seven-of-13 starts this season.
 - Is now 8-8 with a 3.03 ERA (124.2IP, 42ER) in 21 games/18 Interleague starts...was his first career start vs. the Yankees.
- C Pedro Severino** (1-for-4, 2K) snapped an 0-for-17 stretch (last hit was in the second on 5/31 at Atlanta) with his second-inning single.
- RF Bryce Harper** (0-for-0, 2BB, 2HP) reached base four times before being removed for pinch runner Brian Goodwin in the eighth after being hit by a pitch...is just the fifth time he has reached base at least four times without a hit in his career (last on 5/18/16 vs. New York-NL, four times on base)...his 2HP tied a career high (twice, also on 8/16/13 at Atlanta).
- CF Michael A. Taylor** (1-for-3, 1BB, 1K) extended his hitting streak to seven games with his sixth-inning infield single...is hitting .346 (9-for-26) with 4R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 5RBI, 3BB and 4SB over the stretch...is tied for the second-longest streak of his career (longest is nine games from 6/19-28/15).
