SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **The Padres recorded their second walk-off win of the season** (also: May 12 vs. STL).
 - It was the club's first walk-off win on an error since April 27, 2013 vs. SF (error by Marco Scutaro in the 12th inning).
- **Clayton Richard** pitched his sixth quality start of the season...in his last five outings, he has posted a 3.22 ERA (13 ER, 36.1 IP) and 29 strikeouts against five walks.
 - His 2.76 ERA against MIA is the second-lowest career ERA against any team in which he has made at least six starts, behind only his 2.38 career mark against PIT.
- **Franmil Reyes** became the second Padres rookie this season to homer in three consecutive games, joining Christian Villanueva (April 14-16)...has now hit four home runs in his last seven games (owns at .783 SLG in that time).
- **Eric Hosmer** has reached base safely via hit or walk in 17 of his last 18 games, owning a .355 OBP with seven walks during that span.
 - Leads the club with 19 multi-hit games.
- **Freddy Galvis** has gone 7-for-24 (.292) with five doubles and a home run in his last seven games.
- **Matt Strahm** earned his first win as a Padre.

MIAMI NOTES

- **José Ureña** made his third career start against the Padres and first since Aug. 27, 2016...tossed his fifth quality start of the season and has worked six-or-more innings in his last four starts.
- **J.T. Realmuto** extended his hitting streak at Petco Park to nine games, going 12-for-38 (.316) with two triples, a homer and six RBI...is 18-for-66 (.273) in 18 career games against the Padres.
- **Justin Bour** snapped his eight-game hitting streak vs. SD, batting .462 (12-for-26) with a homer, two doubles and five RBI during that span.
