RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their 7-game, 8-day home stand (4-PIT, 3-MIA) this afternoon, as they seek a series win after posting walk-off 10-8 and 3-2 wins on Thu. & Sat. around Fri. night's 4-0 loss...the Cardinals began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games back of the 1st place Milwaukee Brewers...the Redbirds are 5-5 in their last 10 games and 9-11 over their last 20.

MILESTONES: Yesterday's game, the 1,000th regular season affair at Busch Stadium III, featured the 100th career home run by **Marcell Ozuna**, his first as a Cardinal at Busch Stadium.

GOMBER GOODIES: Rookie **Austin Gomber** debuted yesterday with 3.0 scoreless & hitless innings in relief, the first Cardinals lefty relief pitcher to ever do so...right-handers **Dick Hughes** (3.0 IP; 9/11/66) & **Ray Washburn** (4.1 IP; 9/20/61) are the only others to have done so in research dating to 1908.

FEELING A DRAFT: Major League Baseball's amateur draft starts on Monday, June 4 with the first 78 picks taking place that evening on MLB Network & MLB.com...the Cardinals have selections #19, #43 and #75 on Day 1...the draft will resume with rounds 3-10 on Tue., June 5 and rounds 11-40 on Wed., June 6.

POWER PLAY: The Cardinals have homered in 40 of their first 56 games, going 28-12 (.700 win pct.) in those games...they are 3-13 when they do not homer...among NL clubs, only Milwaukee (31-7; .816) & Atlanta (28-11; .717) have a better winning pct. when homering. **HOMERS AT HOME:** The Cardinals are 15-4 (.789 win pct.) in games they homer in at Busch Stadium this season...only Milwaukee & Philadelphia (both 16-3; .842) have better marks among NL clubs when homering at home.

MOLINA IN SPRINGFIELD: All-Star catcher **Yadier Molina** began his injury rehabilitation assignment last night with the Springfield Cardinals (AA)...he caught 5 innings and was 0-for-1 with a HBP & sac. fly at the plate...Molina suffered a pelvic injury with traumatic hematoma after taking a foul tip on May 5 and has missed 25 games.

IT'S NEVER TOO LATE TO BE GREAT: The Cardinals walk-off win yesterday on **Kotlen Wong's** 4th career walk off-HR (his 3rd career vs. the Pirates), was the 7th among their 17 wins at home this season...their 7 walk-off wins lead the majors and are their most since 2015 when they had a total of 9...they had 4 all of last season...the Cardinals have hit 5 walk-off homers this season, their most since 2008 (also 5)...Thu. night's win marked their first walk-off win when trailing by three or more heading into the final inning since 8/19/2005 vs SF, when down 4-0 in the 9th.

MAY'S M.A.S.H. UNIT: The Cardinals made a total of 42 transactions in May, impacting 23 different players and they placed 11 different players on the disabled list last month (**Dominic Leone, Yadier Molina, Carlos Martínez, Tyler Lyons, Adam Wainwright, Luke Gregerson, Carson Kelly, Paul DeJong, Matt Bowman, Greg Holland** and **Alex Reyes**).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates pitcher **Ivan Nova** and outfielders **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuinness** (December 30, 2013).

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Tyler Lyons** and Pirates infielder **Jordy Mercer** were teammates at Oklahoma State University for two seasons (2007-08).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and outfielder **Corey Dickerson** were teammates in Colorado in 2013.

Catcher **Francisco Pena's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004), **Matt Bowman** (April 6, 2016), and **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and **Luke Voit** (June 25, 2017) all made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** and Pirates infielder **Josh Harrison** were teammates on the United States squad in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Gregerson was previously Astros teammates with Pirates pitcher **Michael Feliz** (2015-17) and infielder **Colin Moran** (2016-17).

Infielder **David Freese** played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood (same high school as **Luke Voit**).

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis first in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Infielder **Sean Rodriguez's** father, **Johnny**, is the manager of the Cardinals' Springfield Cardinals (AA) of the Texas League.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searage** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) and Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Former Cardinals (1983-86) and Pirates (1987-94) All-Star outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** is being honored and celebrated in a pair of bobbleheads this season at Busch Stadium (April 24 vs. New York Mets) and PNC Park (August 4 vs. St. Louis).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

- Makes his 12th start of the season and the 124th of his career (133rd appearance).
- Limited his opposition to two runs or less in each of his last eight starts (1.86 ERA, 48.1 IP) ranking 4th among N.L. pitchers in ERA since April 20 (Mikolas, 3rd, 1.86).
- Is 3-0 with a 2.28 ERA (STL 4-0) in his four starts against N.L. Central opponents this season. Is looking to become the first Cardinals pitcher to win seven straight decisions since Luke Weaver (2017), which would also match his career-high win streak from the start of 2015 (4/11-5/24).

- Held the Brewers to one run on a season-low two hits over 6.2 innings in a 6-1 win.
- Has held his opposition to two runs or less in each of his last eight starts (1.86 ERA).

- Tied for 4th in the National League in wins (6) and T8th in ERA (2.71).
- His six-game active win streak is T2nd in the NL (Scherzer, WSH, 8).
- Ranks 7th in the NL with a 0.57 HR/9 IP, with only four home runs allowed.
- Opposing left-handed hitters are 23-for-115 (.200) with two doubles, while right-handers are 27-for-113 (.239) with five doubles and four home runs.
- His .217 opp SLG vs. left-handed batters is 4th among National League pitchers.
- Ranks T2nd among NL pitchers in home wins (4-0) & 12th in home ERA (2.21).
- Posted his 50th career win vs. PHI (5/19), as the Cardinals used a season-high 15 hits & socked 3 home runs in a 12-4 win over Jake Arrieta.

- Went 4-0 in April for 2nd time in his career; also did so in 2015 in route to a 17-7 season.
- Recorded strikeout No. 600 (Michael Conforto, swinging) in the 1st inning of his 4/25 start vs. NYM...became the 5th youngest pitcher in Cardinals history to reach milestone.
- Beat Cincinnati in consecutive starts (4/12 & 4/20), improving to 10-1 lifetime in 16 starts against the Reds.

- Of his 123 career starts, 76 have been at least 6.0 innings (70 quality).
- Is a lifetime 28-12 with a 3.46 ERA in 64 starts (38 quality starts) at Busch Stadium...his .700 home win pct. ranks 7th in MLB since 2013.
- His .617 winning percentage (50-31) over the past six seasons (2013-2018) ranks 11th among National League pitchers.
- Earned 2015 Major League All-Star selection (Manager's selection) for the NL.
- Was voted MVP of 2013 National League Championship Series vs. LAD as a rookie.
