TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** The Twins lost the third and final game of the series to drop the series to the Indians, their 16th series loss of the year and fifth time being shutout...have now lost three of their last four series played and their first of the year to Cleveland...fall to 17-17 in series finales...drop to 7-5 against the Indians this year and are now 10.0 games back of Cleveland in the A.L. Central...are 20-19 in divisional play this year...fall to 30-24 at home, their first time losing consecutive games at Target Field since losing three in a row June 21-23 against Boston (one game) and Texas (two games)...shut out for the fifth time this year and second time in four games...the Twins announced today they have extended their player development contract for another two years with the Rochester Red Wings, through the 2020 season.
- **ADALBERTO MEJIA** in his third start of the season he threw five shutout innings allowing just one hit, he walked three batters and struck out two...his three walks ties a season high and the two strikeouts are the second fewest of his three starts...this is his third scoreless start of his career, doing so twice before June 23 and June 28, 2017.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (2-for-4) singled in the fourth inning, recording the first hit of the game for the Twins...he has now reached base safely by hit or walk in every game he has played in at home this season...as recorded a hit in 11 of 14 home games, hitting .269 (14-for-52) during the streak.
- **MIGUEL SANO** (1-for-3) recorded a single in the fifth inning, extending his current hit-streak to three games...is hitting .444 (4-for-9) during the streak...has reached base safely against Cleveland via hit or walk in every game this season...hitting .281 (9-for-32) in eight games vs. Cleveland this season.
- **JOE MAUER** (1-for-3) recorded his first triple of the season and 30th of his career in the sixth inning...this was his first triple since August 27, 2017 vs. Toronto...this marked his 21 extra-base-hit of the season and 588th of his career...nine shy of Tony Oliva (597) in fourth place on the Twins all-time list since 1961.
- **MAX KEPLER** (1-for-3) recorded a single in the eighth inning, extending his hit-streak against Cleveland to five games...hitting .300 (6-for-20) during the streak...has now reached safely in 16 of his last 18 games against Cleveland...hitting .244 (40-for-164) in 42 career games against Cleveland.
- **LOGAN FORSYTHE** (0-for-1) made his Twins debut pinch hitting in the eighth inning for Ehire Adrianza, grounding into a doubleplay.

INDIANS NOTES:

- **THE INDIANS** took the last game of the three game series over the Twins to earn their first series win over the Twins since September 26-28, 2017 when they took two of three from Minnesota...improve to 32-15 against the AL Central this year, including 14-11 in divisional road games, and have now won 10 out of 15 series against divisional opponents...are now 27-27 on the road and finish the road trip 4-2...10th shutout of the year...improve to 10-29 when scoring three-or-fewer runs...will face the Twins again for a four-game series beginning next Monday, August 6.

- **CARLOS CARASCO** threw 7.1 shutout innings in his 20th start of the season, allowed four hits, walked none and struck out 10 batters...has struck out 10-or-more batters in four starts this season...marked the third start without allowing a walk and the third start without allowing a run to score.
- **FRANCISCO LINDOR** (0-for-2) walked three times, one intentionally, this is the ninth time this season he has had multiple walks in the same game and just the third time he has walked three-or-more times in a game.
- **BRANDON GUYER** (0-for-1) was hit by a pitch in the fourth inning, his sixth HBP of the season...entering today's game Guyer ranks seventh among active players in hit-by-pitches since 2011 (79).
- **JOSE RAMIREZ** (2-for-4) extended his current hit streak to three games, hitting .583 (7-for-12) during the streak...has now reached base safely by hit or walk in all games vs. the Twins this season, hitting .362 (17-for-47) with nine walks...recorded his 33rd multi-hit game of the season and third in a row.
- **EDWIN ENCARNACION** (1-for-3) doubled in the sixth inning, his 14th of the season...he has now recorded a hit in every game at Target Field this season, hitting .333 (9-for-27) with six extra-base-hits.
- **YAN GOMES** (1-for-4) recorded a single in the ninth inning, extending his hit streak to four games...since August 17, 2017, he has recorded a hit in all but one game against the Twins, hitting .341 (15-for-44) during that time.
