**THE GIANTS:** Continue their current homestand with a three-game series against the Arizona Diamondbacks...San Francisco is 2-2 over its first four contests against the Mariners (1-1) and Dodgers (1-1).

**AGAINST THE D-BACKS:** The Giants are seeking their 200th all-time win versus the Arizona Diamondbacks tonight...since the D-Backs began play in 1998, the Giants have posted a 199-154 record...San Francisco's 199 wins versus Arizona are the fourth-most against a single opponent among NL teams from 1998-2018 (STATS, LLC).

**KEEPING IT IN THE YARD:** The Giants have allowed only two home runs this season, which is the fewest for a San Francisco team through eight games since 2002, when they gave up only one in their first eight contests (STATS, LLC).

**THE TIMES THEY ARE A CHANGIN':** Tonight's 7:15 p.m. game time marks the Giants ninth different start time this season.

**ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland** is scheduled to make his second start of the season...it also marks his second career start at AT&T Park and his first here since June 20, 2009 (allowed just one run on four hits in 7.0 innings of work).

**ON THE OTHER SIDE:** RHP Zack Godley will make his third career start (fifth appearance) against the Giants...he's 1-1 with a 7.84 ERA (9er,10.1ip) and a .341 opponents average over his first four career outings against San Francisco.

**NOTABLE MATCHUPS:** A couple Giants have enjoyed some success off D-Backs starter Zack Godley...**OF Hunter Pence** is 4-for-5 (.800) with one double and two home runs, **OF Andrew McCutchen** is 3-for-4 (.750) with a double and **C Nick Hundley** also has a double, HR and walk in just four PAs.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** The Giants went 3-for-21 (.143) with runners in scoring position over their two game set with the Dodgers this past weekend and are now hitting just .127 (8-for-63) with RISP overall this season, which ranks as the lowest figure in the Majors.

**BEGINS WITH THE STARTERS:** San Francisco starters have allowed three earned runs or less in seven of their first eight starts...their combined 3.30 ERA (16ER, 43.2IP) ranks as the third-best figure among National League starting staffs.

**PANIK ATTACK: IF Joe Panik** is off to a hot start batting .344 (11-for-32), which is tied for third in batting average among National League second basemen...he's recorded a multi-hit game in four of his first eight contests.

**IN THE 'PEN:** San Francisco's bullpen has combined to go 2-1 with a 2.51 ERA (9er, 32.1ip) and 35 strikeouts in the first eight games of the season.

**GETTING AHEAD:** The Giants are 4-0 this season when scoring first and 0-4 in games their opponent scores first.

#### This Date in Giants History: April 9, 2012

**Barry Zito** tossed his first shutout in nine years as the Giants beat the Rockies by a score of 7-0 at Coors Field...the win prevented SF from beginning the season winless in their first four games...Zito allowed only four hits, while striking out four batters.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#45 LHP Derek Holland**  
**6-2, 213, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)**  
**0-1 Record, 5.40 ERA**

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his second start in a Giants uniform and the 186th of his career.
- Suffered the loss on March 31 at Dodger Stadium... tossed 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (three earned runs) on three hits and three walks with four strikeouts in the Giants' 5-0 loss to Los Angeles-NL.
- Was originally scheduled to start this past Friday against Los Angeles-NL, but was pushed back after the game was postponed due to rain.
- Appeared in six games this spring, going 1-1 with a 4.05 ERA (9er, 20.0ip) and 23 strikeouts...entered camp as non-roster invitee after signing a minor league contract with SF on Feb. 9.
- Made 26 starts (29 games) for the White Sox last season, going 7-14 with a 6.20 ERA (93er, 135.0ip)... his 26 starts were his most in a season since 2013.
- His 14 losses, 6.20 ERA, 1.71 WHIP and 75 walks in 2017 were all career-highs.
- Held left-handed batters to a .237 clip (28-for-118) last season, compared to a .305 average (128-for-420) against right-handers.
- Was released by Chicago-AL on Sept. 5 last season.
- Spent the first eight years of his career with the Texas Rangers, going 62-50 with a 4.35 ERA (476er, 985.0ip)...among Rangers all-time leaders he ranks eighth in starts (158) and strikeouts (790), ninth in wins (62) and 10th in innings pitched (985.0).
- Was originally drafted by Texas in the 25th round of the 2006 First-Year Player Draft.

**NOTES:** The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) is slated to make his third start of the season...is 1-0 with a 0.69 ERA in his first two outings, allowing just one run in 13.0 innings of work...the Giants are 2-0 in his starts this year and 39-20 (.661) overall since Cueto joined the team in 2016...earned his first 2018 win in his last start on Wednesday vs. Seattle in the Giants' 10-1 victory...logged 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on eight hits...matched up with Felix Hernandez for the first time...is 11-3 with a 3.38 ERA (35er, 93.1ip) in 15 career starts against Arizona...the only team he's defeated more is the Pirates (20 wins).
