**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Giants and Cubs play the middle game of this three-game series tonight...SF won a 2-1 contest in game one last night as **IF Pablo Sandoval** recorded his fourth career game-ending hit.

**#BELTTHEBALLOT: IF Brandon Belt** is currently in second place in the NL Final Vote...Milwaukee first baseman Jesús Aguilar is the current NL leader...voting is open until 1 p.m. PST tomorrow...vote for Brandon at [sfgiants.com/vote](http://sfgiants.com/vote).

**ALL-STAR MATERIAL: IF Brandon Belt** would make a good All-Star because he leads all first basemen in defensive runs saved with eight, so he's an ideal defensive replacement...he's also a middle-inning hitter, batting .379 with a .429 on-base pct. and .620 slugging pct. in innings 4-6...he also hits relief pitchers well, batting .314 this season (*Baseball Info Solutions*).

**2018 ALL-STARS: IF Brandon Crawford** will be the starting NL shortstop in this year's All-Star Game in Washington, D.C....it's Crawford's second All-Star selection and his first as a starter...**C Buster Posey** earned his sixth All-Star selection and his third as a reserve...Posey will not participate in the Mid-Summer Classic as he's been battling hip inflammation this season and will receive a cortisone shot next week.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY!:** Giants **LHP Will Smith** turns 29 years old today.

**LEANING LEFT:** San Francisco has lost 10 of their last 15 games with an opposing starting left-handed pitcher on the mound...the Giants are hitting just .237 against lefties this year with an OPS of .685...the Giants did defeat Quintana the last time they faced him on May 26 at Wrigley (4.1ip, 5h, 4r, 4er, 1hr, 2bb, 6so).

**ON THE SHORES OF McCOVEY COVE:** The Giants are 29-16 (.644) here at home this season, the third-best home record in the NL behind Philadelphia (30-16, .652) and Chicago (28-15, .651)...the Giants have won seven of their last 10 home games and 17 of their last 23.

**HOME SERIES WINS:** The Giants have gone 9-0-2 (win-lost-split) in their last 11 home series...they haven't lost a home set since dropping two of three to Arizona from April 8-10.

**FLANNERY BEHIND THE MIC: Renel Brooks-Moon** will be emceeding the inauguration of San Francisco Mayor Elect, London Breed at City Hall tomorrow at 11am...pinch hitting for Renel will be former Giants Third Base Coach, **Tim Flannery**, filling in as Guest Public Address Announcer.

**TRAVEL CHANNEL'S FOOD PARADISE:** Former MLB outfielder, Bay Area native and MLB Network analyst Eric Byrnes will be at AT&T Park today to participate in a filming of Travel Channel's Food Paradise, which is making a stop at the ballpark to showcase various food offerings including some of most creative and over-the-top dishes in the Majors...as part of a new episode premiering in Fall 2018, the show will serve up hefty plates of the country's tastiest, most mouthwatering and decadent meals and give travelers a guide, counting down all the must-eat spots across the country to have a one-of-a-kind dining experience.

**NOT A LOT OF REST:** The Giants are currently in a stretch of playing 16-consecutive games before their next off day, which is this Thursday...beginning June 8 and leading up to the All-Star Break, the Giants will have played 36 games in 38 days.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#45 LHP Derek Holland**  
**6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)**  
**5-7 Record, 4.35 ERA**

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 18th start in a Giants uniform...has posted a 5-7 record with a 4.35 ERA (45er, 93.0ip) over 19 outings (17 starts).
- Is making a spot start tonight to give Cueto an extra day of rest.
- Was moved to the bullpen following his start on July 1 at Arizona...with **Johnny Cueto** being activated from the DL on July 5, the Giants needed to move one of their starters to make room for him in the rotation.
- Made two relief appearances and allowed two runs on four hits (one home run) with seven strikeouts in 4.1 innings of work.
- The Giants have posted a 9-8 record in his starts and have won six of the last seven.
- His last start came on July 1 at Arizona...threw just 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits and four walks with four strikeouts in the Giants 9-6 victory over the Diamondbacks.
- Is 2-1 with a 3.08 ERA (9er, 26.1ip) over his last five games started.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .189 clip (14-for-74), but has allowed a .368 average over his last four games...his .230 slugging percentage vs. lefties ranks as the fifth-best figure in the NL
- Has struck out 33 batters in his last 25.2 innings pitched, covering his past six outings (11.57 SO/9).
- Cleanup hitters are batting .378 (14-for-37) off him with a 1.223 OPS, which ranks as the sixth-highest figure in the Majors (*Baseball Info Solutions*).
- Has made three career starts against the Cubs, going 1-1 with a 1.89 ERA (4er, 19.0ip)...faced them earlier this season on May 25 and tossed 6.0-innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on five hits with six strikeouts.
- Has allowed 38 extra-base hits, tied for the seventh-most in the National League (23 doubles, two triples, 13 home runs).
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.

**NOTES:** The two-time All-Star (2014 & 2016) returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the disabled list on July 5...is scheduled to make his seventh start of the season...was placed on the DL on May 1 with right elbow inflammation...saw Dr. James Andrews on May 7 and was diagnosed with an elbow sprain...missed 61 games...struggled in his first start back from the disabled list last Friday...allowed five runs on 10 hits in 5.0 innings of work in the Giants' 11-2 loss to the Cardinals...his 10 hits allowed marked the most he's given up in a game since Oct. 1, 2017 vs. SD (12)...has posted a 9-9 record with a 3.35 ERA (58er, 156.0ip) in 25 career starts against the Cubs.

- Earned his sixth win of the season last night to improve to a 6-5 record with a shutout inning in the 11th.
- Has allowed eight runs on 11 hits covering his last six outings (6.2ip).
- Opponents are hitting .313 (21-for-67) off him over his last 11 outings and are 11-for-their-last-30 (.367).
- Was moved to the bullpen following his start on May 27 after going 3-5 with a 4.90 ERA in 12 starts.

- Combined to post a 0.79 whip and struck out 58 in 31.2ip in 32 games between double-A and triple-A this season.
- Has a fastball that regularly hits 100 mph and has gone as high as 104 mph.
- Was in Giants big league camp in 2016 and 2017...was designated for assignment prior to the 2017 season.
- The 28-year-old was originally drafted by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2011 draft.
- Missed his first two professional seasons (2012-13) after undergoing shoulder surgery to repair a torn labrum.
- Underwent an arthroscopic elbow cleanout last year that limited him to just three end-of-season appearances.
