RED HOT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are 29-16 post All-Star Break and 30-16 under manager **Mike Shildt** since he took the post on July 15. The Cardinals have the most wins in MLB since the All-Star Break (29), while St. Louis .644 winning pct. ranks 3rd in MLB, over that period. St. Louis has won 19-of-their-last-26 games overall, including a season-best eight-game winning streak (August 7-15). Entering July 15, the Cardinals had T9th-most wins in the NL (47) and currently have the T3rd-most wins (78) in the NL.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals are at 15 games over .500 entering play tonight and currently reside in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games out of first place and hold the 2nd spot in the NL Wild Card standings, trailing Milwaukee by 1.5 games. The Cardinals currently carry the 3rd-best record in the National League and have 6 games remaining against teams ahead of them in the standings, the Cubs and Brewers.

LONG BALL LORE: St. Louis have homered in 100 of 139 games this season, going 69-31 (.690 win pct.) in those games (8-31 when not homering)...their 69 wins lead the NL and rank 5th in MLB (Yankees, 77)...among MLB clubs, only the Yankees (77-34, .694) and Astros (73-29, .716) have better winning percentages when going yard...St. Louis' 181 home runs are 3rd-most in the NL, trailing MIL (183) & LAD (194). On the road, St. Louis is an NL-best 38-17 (.691) while homering, trailing only Oakland (117) in road home runs (109).

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: Last night marked the Cardinals 8th time this season hitting back-to-back home runs, T3rd-most in MLB (Dodgers & Yankees, 9) and T5th most in franchise history (2000, 15).

ALL OR NOTHING: Last night was the 7th time in franchise history that the Cardinals hit at least five home runs in a game without hitting a double or triple (6-1 record). The club also achieved the same feat this season on May 11 at San Diego (5 HR).

IN BUNCHES: Last night, the Cardinals at least five home runs in a game for the 3rd time this season (3-0 record), including going yard three times in the same inning (6th inn.) for second time this season (May 11 at San Diego, 3rd inning).

CHICKS DID THE LONG BALL: Cardinals pitchers have an MLB-leading five home runs (**John Gant 2, Miles Mikolas 2, Carlos Martinez 1**) and have knocked in an MLB-best 20 RBI this season.

WONG ACTIVATED: The Cardinals today activated second baseman **Kolten Wong** from the 10-day disabled list. The 27-year-old has missed the last nine games with a left hamstring strain, suffered while running out a ground ball on August 25 in Colorado. The Cardinals currently have 31 players on their active roster, with seven players on the disabled list.

WALKS WILL KILL YOU: The Cardinals have walked double-digit batters in consecutive games (21 total walks) for the second time in franchise history (since 1908) and first since July 12-13, 1929 at the Brooklyn Robins (24 walks). The Cardinals are the only MLB team to walk 10+ batters in consecutive games this season. St. Louis has walked 8 or more batters in the last 3 games, done so only once in franchise history (June 22-24, 1999). St. Louis has issued an MLB-leading 178 walks since the All-Star Break, while its 501 free passes this season rank 4th in the National League and are the most since 509 during in 2007. Tonight's starter, **Miles Mikolas**, has issued 27 walks the entire season, compared with 29 by St. Louis pitching the last three games.

PACE OF PLAY: Last night marked St. Louis' second 9-inning game lasting four hours or longer (both 4:10), which matches a franchise record of most games of that duration (1999 and 2000 seasons), and ties Philadelphia for 2nd-most in MLB and trails Boston (3) in 2018. This season, the Cardinals have played 6 games lasting longer than four hours (5-1 record), T3rd-most in franchise history (1999, 8), and T7th-most in MLB (Giants lead with 8).

POSTCARDS: Three Cardinals full season minor league affiliates are currently in the postseason, as the organization finished with a 492-402 overall record and .550 winning percentage that ranked 3rd behind Tampa Bay (.604) and Houston (.562). The defending Florida State co-champion **Palm Beach Cardinals** (High-A) currently trail the the Fort Myers Miracle (Twins), 0-1, in the best-of-three-game FSL Semifinals. Tonight, the defending PCL Champion **Memphis Redbirds** (AAA) travel to Oklahoma City to face the Dodgers for the first two games of the best-of-five PCL Semifinals, while the **Peoria Chiefs** (A) host the Quad City River Bandits (Astros) in the first game of a best-of-three Midwest League Quarterfinals.

DANCING IN SEPTEMBER: Since the turn of the decade in 2010, the Cardinals have posted a stretch of winning Septembers going 136-99 (.579) in the month, trailing only Cleveland (138-99, .581).

BIG MAC FLASHBACK (Sept. 5, 1998) Home Run #60: Two games after hitting No. 58 & 59, **Mark McGwire** wasted no time joining **Babe Ruth** and **Roger Maris** in the illustrious 60-HR club as he hit a towering two-run homer off Reds starter **Dennys Reyes** in the first. Nearly 48,000 fans witnessed the moment with **Jack Buck** describing the crowd as "going berserk" upon Big Mac reaching the feat in 12 fewer games than Ruth.

The 2018 season marks the 20th anniversary of the 1998 Home Run Race that ultimately concluded with Mark McGwire belting 70 homers while establishing a new MLB single-season home run record. Cardinals.com/McGwire

WASHINGTON CONNECTIONS

Tyson Ross' younger brother, **Joe Ross**, is a pitcher for the Nationals (2015-17).

Cardinals pitcher **Brett Cecil** was born in Dunkirk, Md...graduated from DeMatha High School in nearby Hyattsville...2004 NHBSCA and Maryland Louisville Slugger Player of the Year...pitched three seasons at the University of Maryland (2005-07)...left school as the Terrapins single-season (13) and career saves (23) leader and single-season appearance leader (30).

Matt Adams played in 94 games for the Nationals this season before the Cardinals claimed him off waivers (August 21, 2018).

Tyler Webb was born in Nassawadox, Va...graduated from Northampton High School in Eastville, Va.

John Gant made his Major League debut against the Nationals (April 6, 2016) while with the Atlanta Braves...his first career MLB strikeout was Wilson Ramos (swinging).

Cardinals pitching coach **Mike Maddux** served in the same role with the Nationals for two seasons (2016-17)...also pitched parts of two seasons (1998-99) for the Expos.

Cardinals bullpen coach **Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in 25 games for Montreal in 1995.

Greg Holland appeared in 32 games for St. Louis this season.

Max Scherzer is a native of Chesterfield, Mo...graduated from Parkway Central (Mo.) High School...originally selected by St. Louis in the 43rd of the 2003 MLB Draft, but did not sign...pitched at the University of Missouri (2005-07).

Mark Reynolds played in 140 games for the Cardinals in 2015.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the GM **Bob Gebhard** was a player/coach in the Montreal organization from 1974-75...coached in Montreal's system through 1986, including on the Major League coaching staff in 1982.

Nationals Bench Coach **Chip Hale** played in 132 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization during his final season (1998).

Nationals Pitching Coach **Derek Lilliquist** spent 16 years in the Cardinals organization, serving as St. Louis' pitching coach (2012-17), bullpen coach (2011-12), minor league pitching coordinator (2008-10), and pitching coach for Palm Beach (2004-07), Peoria (2003), and pitching coach and Johnson City (2002).

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, serves as the Cardinals Director of Major League Administration.

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX (1984-86).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 28th start of the season (38th career start) and 65th career appearance.
- Is T2nd in NL to NYM's Jacob deGrom (14.8) in fewest pitches per inning (15.0), the lowest average by Cardinals pitcher since John Lackey (14.3 in 2015).
- Has limited the opposition to 3 runs or fewer in 11 of last 13 starts (2 or fewer in 10).
- On the road, he is 7-0 with a 3.72 ERA in 13 road starts; his seven road wins are T5th-most in the NL and he is the only NL pitcher with a perfect 1.000 win percentage with seven or more wins.
- His last road loss came on August 2, 2014 at Cleveland (with Texas).
- Trying to become first Cardinal to post 14 wins in the team's first 140 games since Michael Wacha (15 in 2015) and the first to do so in his first season with the Redbirds since Mark Mulder did so (15 in 2005).
- Ranks among NL leaders in wins (13, T6th), winning pct. (.765, 3rd), ERA (2.96, T5th), innings pitched (167.0, 7th), WHIP (1.11, 6th), strikeout/walk ratio (4.33, 5th), baserunners/9 IP (10.29, 6th), starts (27, T12th), fewest walks/9 IP (1.46, 1st), HR/9 IP (0.75, 5th), ground ball pct (51.1, 4th), OPP SLG (.358, 8th) and quality starts (17, T6th).
- Limiting opposing right-handers to a .271 opponent slugging pct. which currently is T7th-lowest in Cardinals single-season history...Jose DeLeon's .240 from 1989 is 1st.
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in nine starts (T5th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 20 of his 26 starts this season (T4th NL).
- 18 of his 60 runs (30%) allowed have come in the 4th inning (5.67 ERA).
- Sports a 13-0 record with six no-decisions (St. Louis is 18-3) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.

LAST TIME OUT

- Had his 5-game wining streak snapped in a 2-0 loss to PIT last Wed. (8/29), losing for the first time since June 29 vs. the Braves.
- The Cardinals have given Miles 0 runs of support in each of his four losses this season.

- Ranks 6th in the National League in home ERA (2.31). All four of his losses this season have come at home, despite allowing three runs or fewer in all three outings.
- Selected by Major League Baseball to represent the Cardinals on the 2018 National League All-Star team...it was his first MLB All-Star nod and second recognition of his career (2010 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star with Fort Wayne).
- Missed the All-Star Game in Washington D.C., as he returned home to Jupiter, Fla., with his wife Lauren, as they welcomed twin daughter & son on July 16.
- Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher in franchise history to earn an All-Star nod in his first season after signing as a free agent and the only non-rookie player selected this season who didn't play in the Majors last year.
