1B Freddie Freeman, OF Nick Markakis and 2B Ozzie Albies continue to lead at their respective positions in the latest round of All-Star voting totals released today.

Freeman leads all N.L. players with over 2.9 million votes, while Markakis is second with 2,457,648. Albies has over 1.8 million votes to lead Cincinnati's Scooter Gennett.

The Braves last had three position players in the All-Star game in 2012, when OF Michael Bourn, 3B Chipper Jones and 2B Dan Uggla all made the squad.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Yankees open a three-game series tonight with the first meeting between the teams since 2015...These three games will be the clubs' only matchup this season.

A The Braves have lost nine of their last 11 games with the Yankees, dating to June 24, 2009...Atlanta has been outscored 83-44 over this stretch, including 38-11 over the last three games.

A Tonight marks the Braves' fourth game all-time at the newest version of Yankee Stadium, which opened in 2009...Only the Chicago Cubs (two) have played fewer games here.

A RHP Aníbal Sánchez has won three straight decisions over the Yankees and is unbeaten for his career in the Bronx...He is 4-0 with a 2.39 ERA (7 ER/26.1 IP) here, with three of the wins coming at new Yankee Stadium.

A RHP Jonathan Loaisiga is set for his fourth career appearance, fourth start, tonight and his third at Yankee Stadium...He beat Philadelphia on the road his last time out, allowing one hit over 5.1 innings.

WINS: The Braves finished off a sweep of St. Louis yesterday to move a season high-tying 14 games over .500, a mark they reached once before this year...They were 43-29 following play on June 19...The Braves have not been 15 games over .500 since finishing the 2013 season 96-66 and as National League East champions.

BEST RECORDS MEET: Atlanta has the N.L.'s best record at 48-34 (.585), while New York is leading the A.L. at 54-27 (.667)...Tonight will mark just the third time since interleague play began in 1997 that the two leagues' top teams will meet this late into the season...The last time was 2015, when St. Louis played host to Kansas City on July 23 for a make-up game...The first occurrence was in 2001, when Arizona travelled to Seattle on July 15 for a three-game set...Thanks to STATS and Elias.

A Kansas City lost to St. Louis in that game before going on to win the World Series...The Diamondbacks lost two of the three games to Seattle before winning the World Series in seven games.

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today made four roster moves, including selecting the contract of OF Michael Reed from Triple-A Gwinnett and recalling RHP Evan Phillips from the Stripers...The club also optioned Matt Wisler to Triple-A and placed RHP Peter Moylan on the 10-day disabled list with a right forearm strain.

A Reed, 25, hit .337 (82-for-243) in 74 games across two levels of the Braves farm system this season, including .369 (38-for-103) at Gwinnett...He will wear No. 57 with Atlanta.

A Phillips, 23, returns for his second stint with Atlanta this season...The club selected his contract on June 24, before optioning him to Gwinnett the following day...His first appearance will be his MLB debut.

100 HITS: 1B Freddie Freeman hit a two-run homer yesterday for his 100th hit of the season, and is now four behind teammate Nick Markakis for the N.L. lead in hits... This seasons marks the earliest Freeman has reached triple-digit hits; his previous best was game No. 89 in 2014.

A Markakis and Freeman are the only pair of teammates in the majors to each have triple-digit hits...The duo is also the first pair of Braves to each reach 100 hits prior to the All-Star break since 2012, when Martin Prado and Michael Bourn accomplished the feat.

A 2B Ozzie Albies has 97 hits, fourth most in the N.L. ...No trio of Braves teammates have ever reached 100 hits prior to the All-Star game.

OZZIE HITS AND SCORES: 2B Ozzie Albies finished 1-for-4 with a run scored yesterday, and the second baseman has now hit in a season-high 11 consecutive games, which is tied for the longest active run in the majors with one by Avisail García...Albies has also scored in a career-best eight consecutive games, the longest run by a Braves player since last season, when Freddie Freeman scored in 10 straight, April 21-May 2... This streak by Albies is also the longest active run of its kind in the majors.

A He is hitting .431 (22-for-51) during his hitting streak that dates to June 17...His career-best streak is a 13-game run, September 2-September 15, 2017.

SCHEDULE: The Braves entered a stretch on Friday in which they play 16 of 18 games against teams with winning records, including 10 games against teams currently in first place (three with New York, July 2-4, four with Milwaukee, July 5-8, three with Arizona, July 13-15)...They have started the stretch 3-0 after their sweep of St. Louis this weekend.

A The Braves are 30-19 (.612) so far this season against teams with winning records, the National League's best record in such games...Only New York (.738) and Boston (.667) are better this season.

THE ROTATION: The Braves rotation ranks second in the majors with a 3.31 ERA (166 ER/451.0 IP) and trails only Houston's mark of 2.95.

A The Braves starters are also holding the opposition to a .229 batting average, the best mark in the National League, and the third lowest average against in the majors.

A The Braves rotation has 18 scoreless starts of multiple innings this season, the most in the majors and four more than the closest N.L. team (Los Angeles)... LHP Sean Newcomb has six such starts, tied for the major league lead with the Yankees' RHP Luis Severino, while RHP Julio Teheran is one off the lead with five.

ON THE ROAD: The Braves enter tonight's game with the N.L.'s best road record at 25-17 (.595).

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his ninth start of the season (10th appearance) and the 271st (294th appearance) of his career.
- A* Faces New York-AL for the seventh time in his career...Is 4-1 with a 3.79 ERA (15 ER/35.2 IP) in his first six career appearances.
- A* Has allowed three runs or less in five of his six starts against the Yankees, including each of his last four turns...Is 3-0 with a 2.67 ERA (8 ER/27.0 IP) over his last four starts against them, dating to 8/10/13.
- A* Faced them once last season, 8/1/17 at Yankee Stadium...Allowed six hits and two runs over 6.2 innings to earn the win.
- A* Makes his 34th career start in Interleague Play and his 37th appearance...Is 12-11 with a 4.03 ERA (92 ER/205.1 IP) against the opposing league.
- A* Lost his only Interleague start this season, 6/20 at Toronto...Allowed five hits and four runs over 5.0 innings.
- A* Allowing opponents to hit .147/.200/.240 in his first time through the lineup, with just three extra-base hits (one double, two home runs).
- A* Opponents are hitting .266/.360/.563 when facing him a second time... Thirteen of the 16 extra-base hits he's allowed on the season have come in subsequent trips through the lineup.

2018 Recap

- A* Tossed just 4.2 innings in his last turn, 6/26 vs. CIN, and allowed five hits and two runs to take his second consecutive loss.
- A* Was removed after throwing just 73 pitches due to cramping in his right calf.
- A* Took his first loss of the season, 6/20 at TOR...Allowed five hits and a season-high tying four runs over 5.0 innings...Set season highs in walks (4) and strikeouts (7).
- A* The loss snapped a streak of three straight wins to open the season...Opened a season 3-0 for the second time in his career...Won the first four decisions of his major league career to open his rookie campaign 4-0 in 2006.
- A* Won two consecutive starts, 6/9 at LAD (5.1 IP, 2 R) and 6/14 vs. SD (7.0 IP, 0 R)...The wins were the first of his career against each team.
- A* Entered the stretch winless against just three major league teams, all three of which played in California...Was winless against the Dodgers, Padres and Los Angeles Angels (0-4) before defeating Los Angeles-NL and San Diego in his last two turns.
- A* Allowed a pair of unearned runs over a season-most-tying 7.0 innings, 6/3 vs. WSH...Allowed just four total baserunners.
- A* His 2.01 career ERA (33 ER/147.2 IP) against the Nationals/Expos is the lowest all-time mark by a qualifying pitcher against the franchise...His .900 (9-1) winning percentage is tied for the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions).
- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Strippers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts, allowing just three hits and one walk in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
- A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn...Received either one or zero runs of support in eight of the 11 games.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
- A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss
- A* Made his Braves debut with 3.0 innings of scoreless relief on 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed one hit and three walks after having his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett that afternoon.
- A* Signed by Atlanta to a minor-league contract on 3/16 after spending the bulk of spring training in camp with the Twins...Signed a one-year major league contract with Minnesota on 2/22 before the club granted him his unconditional release on 3/13.

Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.
- A* Led the American League with a 2.57 ERA in 2013.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/18 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/3

- Over his last 15 appearances, has a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP) with a .125 (7-for-56) opponents' average.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last four outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just six hits in 66 at-bats (.091) against him...Lefties are hitting .361/.465/.694 with 13 hits, five walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- In three extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with two hits and 11 strikeouts.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Has a 1.93 ERA (3 ER/14.0 IP) in 10 games at SunTrust Park.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 35/22 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one.
- Is one of six relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- Allowed five runs over his last two appearances (3.1 IP)...Allowed multiple runs in consecutive appearances for the first time in his career.
- Holding batters to a .182 (14-for-77) average with men on base and has allowed just six hits (6-for-44, .136) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .280 (23-for-82) with no one on base.
- Has a 6.35 ERA (12 ER/17.0 IP) in his last 15 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.
- Earned three of his four wins at SunTrust Park this season...Is 3-1 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER/22.0 IP) at home.
- Stranded the only runner he inherited, 6/12 vs. SD...Has stranded 12 of the 15 runners he has inherited this season.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 40/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with an 7.80 ERA (13 ER/15.0 IP) in his last 16 appearances...Surrendered 15 hits during the spell, including a pair of home runs, and has allowed at least one run in eight of those outings.
- Has a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Fanned a career high-tying four batters in 2.1 innings, 6/19 at TOR, to earn his second win
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 9-for-47 (.191) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...His 29 inherited runners are tied for third most in the National League...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 9/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/0

- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in nine relief appearances with Atlanta this season...Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Has fanned 13 batters in his 10.1 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 47 batters in 31.2 combined innings (13.4 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett...Did not allow an earned run in his last 16.0 innings with GWN, while holding the opposition to a .098 batting average (dating to 4/30).

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 3/3 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 38/25 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Has pitched to a 1.35 ERA (2 ER/13.1 IP) over his last 14 games, allowing opponents to hit just .119 (5-for-42)...Has recorded 15 of the 40 outs via strikeout during this stretch, and has walked just one.
- Has not blown a lead this season...Is a perfect 11-for-11 in hold chances and has converted all three of his save opportunities.
- Three saves are second most among rookie relievers in the majors.
- Used 12 pitches to strike out the side, 6/6 at SD...Was his second career outing that went at least 1.0 inning with him striking out each batter he faced (also 4/11/18 at WSH, 13 pitches)
- Logged his third save of the season, 7/1 at STL...Is the first left-handed pitcher with multiple saves in a season for Atlanta since Jonny Venters tallied five in 2011.
