TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants begin a six-game, two-city road trip tonight with the first of a two-game set here in San Diego...the Giants snapped a four-game losing streak with an 8-5 win yesterday over Milwaukee, but are still 3-8 in their last 11 games to fall below .500.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game: **RHP Johnny Cueto** has been placed on the 10-day disabled list (retroactive to Sunday) with a right elbow sprain and **IF Pablo Sandoval** has been placed on the 10-day DL with a right hamstring strain...**IF Kelby Tomlinson** (#37) has been recalled from triple-A Sacramento and **IF Joe Panik** (#12) has returned from his rehab assignment and has been reinstated from the 10-day DL.

MANAGERIAL WINS: With SF's victory yesterday, manager **Bruce Bochy** (1,906 wins) moved past Hall of Famer Casey Stengel (1,905) for sole possession of 11th-place on the all-time managerial wins list...Bochy is now 102 wins shy of matching Hall of Famer Leo Durocher for 10th place.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Derek Holland will make his fourth career start against the Padres...he's 1-1 with a 7.04 ERA against San Diego...Holland, who has moved between the bullpen and starting rotation this year, has pitched very well since June, posting a 2.72 ERA (15er, 49.2ip) in 12 games, eight starts.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants have gone 6-5 against the Padres this season, going 1-3 here at Petco Park...over the last five seasons, the Padres' pitching staff has posted a 2.79 ERA (119er, 384.0ip) against the Giants here in San Diego...SF has lost seven of the last nine games and 14 of their last 20 here at Petco.

ON THE MOUND: Giants pitchers have the second-lowest ERA in MLB beginning June 1, fashioning a 3.33 figure...the Yankees have the lowest figure at 3.29.

ON THE ROAD: The Giants are 21-32 (.396) on the road this season, the lowest road winning percentage in the NL and sixth-lowest in MLB...SF has lost six of their last eight road games and have won just four road series all year (at LAA, at WAS, at ATL & at ARI).

POSEY AT PETCO: C Buster Posey, who went 4-for-5 with three RBI in yesterday's win, is a career .298 hitter with 10 homers and 41 RBI in 58 games here at Petco Park...his .298 batting average is the 10th-best among active players.

HAVING THE LEAD AFTER 6: The Giants are 43-5 (.896) this season when leading after 6.0 innings...that's the fifth-best record in the MLB...however, when tied or trailing through 6.0 innings, the Giants are just 10-49 (.169).

#45 LHP Derek Holland
6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)
5-8 Record, 3.92 ERA

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 20th start (23rd appearance) this season...has posted a 5-8 record with a 3.92 ERA (47er, 108.0ip) over his 23 outings.
- Started the season in the Giants rotation, but was moved to the bullpen following his start on July 1 at Arizona to make room in the rotation for **Johnny Cueto**, who was being activated from the DL...has moved back and forth between the bullpen and the starting rotation since then.
- Has made four relief appearances and allowed two runs on five hits (one home run) with 14 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...has struck out 14 of the 28 batters he's faced as a reliever.
- Has posted a 2.43 ERA (8er, 29.2ip) over his last eight games (four starts, four relief appearances).
- Is 2-2 with a 2.56 ERA (11er, 38.2ip) over his last seven games started.
- Has struck out 52 batters over his last 40.2 innings pitched, covering his past 10 appearances (11.51 SO/9).
- Lefties are hitting just .186 (16-for-86) off him, which ranks as the 10th-lowest figure in the National League...has allowed just three extra-base hits to left-handers (all doubles).
- Has received two or less runs of support in 12 of his 19 starts this season.
- Has made three career starts against San Diego, going 1-1 with a 7.04 ERA (12er, 15.1ip)...has posted a 5.59 ERA (6er, 9.2ip) in two starts against the Padres this season.
- His only career appearance at Petco Park came earlier this year on April 14...threw 4.2 innings, allowing three runs on six hits in the Giants' 5-4 loss to the Padres.
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.

NOTES: 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 10th Major League start (12th appearance)...the Giants are 7-2 overall when he takes the hill as a starter...last pitched Thursday night versus Milwaukee and did not factor into the decision after yielding a pair of runs on five hits in 6.0 innings...marked his sixth-straight start of allowing two runs or fewer...is 4-1 with a 2.91 ERA (17er, 52.2ip) in nine starts compared to a 1-0 record with a 1.42 ERA (1er, 6.1ip) in two relief outings...has faced the Padres once this year on June 24 and limited the Friars to a run on four hits in 7.0 innings...did not factor into the decision of a Giants 3-2 win.

- Has allowed 11 runs over his last 10 appearances (7.30 ERA).
- Opponents are 17-for-their-last-40 (.425) off him and are hitting .364 (20-for-55) off him over his last 10 games.

- Is 7-for-his-last-20 (.350) off lefties, but is hitting just .120 off right-handers in his past 20 contests.
- Has driven in just three runs over his last 22 games, however he has five hits in his last eight at-bats with RISP.
- 2018 All-Star was voted into Mid-Summer Classic by the fans for his first All-Star start (second All-Star appearance).
