### TWINS NOTES:

- **THE TWINS** won the second of the final three-game series against Detroit this season, now 11-7 against the Tigers in 2018, including 6-3 at Target Field...improve to 37-34 against the AL Central...are now 44-32 at Target Field...are now 10-13 in the month of September and 19-25 against a left-handed starter...improve to 35-53 when the opponent scores first.
- **PAUL MOLITOR** earned his 300<sup>th</sup> career managerial win tonight.
- **JAKE ODORIZZI** went just 3.0 innings in his 32<sup>nd</sup> start of the season, his second shortest start of the season...did not factor in the decision tonight after allowing four runs, five walks and just three strikeouts...will finish the season 7-10 in 164.1 innings...the seven wins are the fewest of any full season in his career and the 70 walks this season is a career high.
- **JORGE POLANCO** (2-for-4) walked in the first inning and then stole second base, his sixth stolen base of the season, second most on the team...hit a single in the fourth and a triple in the sixth inning...the triple is his third of the season and was a bases-clearing, three RBI hit...marks his 21<sup>st</sup> multi hit game...has now hit safely in nine of his last 12 home games hitting .340 (16-for-47)...in his last 18 games overall, he's hitting .329 (25-for-76).
- **ROBBIE GROSSMAN** (2-for-4) drove in the Twins first run of the game in the first inning with a single...this marked his 45<sup>th</sup> RBI this season, tying his previous career-high, done last year...with a his 27<sup>th</sup> double of the season he recorded his 28<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **TYLER AUSTIN** (1-for-3) recorded his 17<sup>th</sup> home run of the year in the first inning and his ninth with the Twins...this was his 24<sup>th</sup> career-home run.
- **JOHNNY FIELD** (2-for-4) recorded his eighth home run of the season and his second with the Twins in the second inning...recorded his second home run of the game in the fourth inning bringing his season total to nine (3 with Twins)...this marked his first career multi-home run game...this was his 10<sup>th</sup> multi-hit game of the season.
- **JOE MAUER** (1-for-4) over his last 12 games, is hitting .348 (16-for-46) and in 11 games vs. Detroit this season is hitting .333 (14-for-42).
- **WILLIAMS ASTUDILLO** (3-for-5) extended his current hitting streak to five games, hitting .476 (10-for-21) during the streak...with three hits on the night recorded his eighth multi-hit game of the season and his third three hit night.
- **CHRIS GIMENEZ** (2-for-4) recorded his fourth multi-hit game of the season with a pair of singles in the game.

## **TIGERS NOTES:**

- **THE TIGERS** are now 1-1 on their current six-game road trip...Detroit is 19-10 against the Twins over the last 29 games played at Target Field...the Tigers are now 33-42 against AL Central opponents this season, 7-11 vs. Minnesota...following the three game set vs. The Twins, their season will conclude during the weekend with three games at Milwaukee (September 28-30).
- **MATTHEW BOYD** made his eighth career start at Target Field tonight, he received a no decision, allowing eight hits and six earned runs over 3.2 innings pitched...in 14 starts vs. AL Central teams this season, he now has a 3-6 record with a 4.39 ERA (72.2IP, 38 ER) and 58 strikeouts.
- **BUCK FARMER** pitched a scoreless seventh inning, allowing one hit....has not allowed a run in seven consecutive appearances, throwing 8.1 shutout innings over that stretch.
- **DAWEL LUGO** (2-for-4) had two singles tonight, marking his 4th multi-hit game of the season and first since September 4 (23 games played overall).
- **NIKO GOODRUM** (1-for-4) drove in a run in the third inning with a RBI single...he has driven 13 runs in 15 games vs. The Twins this season.
- **JAMES MCCANN** (2-for-3) drove in a run in the third inning with a RBI single...started his 116th game as a catcher for the Tigers this season...4th year in a row he starts over 105+ games.
- **CHRISTIN STEWART** (1-for-3) Christin Stewart drove in a pair of runs with a triple in the first inning and with a walk in tonight's game...Stewart has reached base safely in 13 of the 15 games he has started to begin his Major League career.
