**SAN DIEGO NOTES**

- **Luis Perdomo** made his first start of the season...Perdomo struck out seven batters for the first time since August 8, 2017...he struck out seven-or-more batters in just three of his 29 starts last season with the first one coming on May 10, 2017.
- **Freddy Galvis** belted a two-run homer in tonight's game...Galvis has a club-leading five hits and also leads the club in multi-hit games with three.
  - This is the first time in his career that he's had consecutive multi-hit games to start a season...has hit safely in each of his first three games to start the season, one shy of his four-game hitting streak to open his 2016 campaign (April 4-8, 2016).
- **Hunter Renfroe** hit a triple on just his second at-bat of the season...this was the second triple of Renfroe's career, having hit his first one on June 28, 2017 vs. ATL.
- **Robbie Erlin** made his first appearance since April 17, 2016 vs. ARI...his 3.2 innings pitched are the most since he pitched six innings, also on April 17, 2016 vs. ARI.
  - Recorded the fourth hit of his career and his first since May 17, 2014 at COL.

**MILWAUKEE NOTES**

- **Brent Suter** made his first career appearance against the Padres tonight, working 5.0 innings and allowing three earned runs...allowed three or fewer earned runs in 19 of his 22 games played last season.
- **Christian Yelich** and **Lorenzo Cain** went a combined 15-for-28 with seven runs in this series.
- **Christian Yelich** had five hits in tonight's game, tying his single-game career-high (also: October 3, 2015 at PHI).
  - Has hit safely in all three games of the series...he's chasing his longest career hitting streak to start the season, which dates back to 2016 when he hit in 11-straight (April 5-15 2016).
- **Lorenzo Cain** went 8-for-14 (.571) this series with three doubles, three RBI and three stolen bases...has recorded multiple hits in each of his first three games to start the season.
- **Travis Shaw** recorded his second consecutive multi-hit game.
