**#OPENINGDAYSTL:** The Cardinals are a combined 66-60 in home openers dating back to 1892...the Cardinals are 5-7 in home openers at Busch Stadium III, with wins in their last two (2016-17)...the latest the Cardinals ever opened at home was May 1, 1919 vs. Cincinnati (L, 3-6).

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The Cardinals are 573-398 (.590 win pct.) at Busch Stadium III since 2006, 3rd-highest home winning pct. behind the Yankees (.613, 597-377) and Dodgers (.595, 581-395) for MLB's best home mark over the same time span.

**GIVE ME FIVE:** Adam Wainwright makes his 5th career Home Opener start tonight (2009-10, '12, '15), 2nd-most in franchise history behind Bob Gibson's six (1967-69, '72, 74-75)...Flint Rhem (1925-26, '30, '32), and Curt Simmons (1961, '63-64, '66) are each T3rd with four.

**BATTERYMATES:** Adam Wainwright and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 237 career games, the most in Cardinals history and most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (Elias)...Wainwright and Molina surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198-game milestone on June 15, 2016.

**TAKE YOUR BASE:** Matt Carpenter has reached base safely in all six games to begin 2018...his multi-walk game last night was the 99th of his career...his 98 multi-walk games since his first full season in 2012 are ranked 6th in all of MLB...D-Backs Paul Goldschmidt ranks 3rd on that list with 123 such games.

**BACKSTOP BREAKOUT:** Yadier Molina hit his 3rd homer of the season last night, most ever by a Cardinals catcher in the team's first six games...Lou Brock hit a club record five round-trippers in the team's first six games to begin 1967.

**BIG FLY BIRDIES:** The Cardinals have homered in each of their first six games of the season (12 HR total), their longest streak to begin a season since 1989 (7 HR), when they homered in each of their first seven games. The longest Cardinals streak to begin a season was 10 games in 1960 (17 HR). St. Louis also homered in their first eight games in 1954 (12 HR).

**BLAST OFF:** Dexter Fowler hit his 24th career lead-off HR Tuesday night, ranking 8th among active players...Tue. night's first-pitch blast was the 3rd of his career coming on the game's initial pitch...his first career home run also came on the game's first pitch on April 8, 2009 at Arizona (Doug Davis)...he also did so on June 22, 2014 at Tampa Bay.

**CENTURY MEN:** Dexter Fowler and Marcell Ozuna hit their 1st home runs of the season Tuesday night and Matt Carpenter drilled his first homer last Saturday, giving him 98 for his career...Carpenter (98), Jedd Gyorko (99), Fowler (97) and Ozuna (97) are all approaching 100 career round-trippers.

**CATCH THIS:** Yadier Molina swiped his 57th career stolen base Tue. night, tops all-time among Cardinals catchers...Molina's 57 steals are 2nd among active career catching leaders, trailing only the Blue Jays Russell Martin (100).

**IT'S GOOD TO BE DEJONG AGAIN:** Shortstop Paul DeJong as hit 28 career home run since his since his ML debut (5/28/17)...only MIN's Brian Dozier (30) has more among MLB middle infielders since...DeJong's 28 home runs in his first 114 MLB games moves past Albert Pujols for first place for the Cardinals record for most in first 114 career games (Pujols hit homer 28 in game 115).

#### TODAY IN CARDINALS HISTORY

**April 5, 1974:** The Cardinals plate two runs in the bottom of the 10th to come-from-behind and beat the Pirates, 6-5, on Opening Day at Busch Stadium. Bob Gibson allows four runs (three earned) over 8.0 frames. Closer Al Hrabosky surrendered a run in the top of the 10th, but came away with the victory after RBI singles from pinch hitter Tim McCarver and second baseman Ted Sizemore.

#### ARIZONA CONNECTIONS

Cardinals pitcher **Dominic Leone** pitched parts of two seasons (2015-16) with Arizona...originally traded by Seattle with catcher Wellington Castillo and infielder Jack Reinheimer to Arizona for pitcher Vidal Nuno and outfielder Mark Trumbo (June 3, 2015).

Cardinals assistant hitting coach **Bill Mueller** played parts of two seasons (1995-96) for the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization.

Cardinals assistant coach **Willie McGee** rehabbed for four games with the Phoenix Firebirds (AAA) as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization in 1991.

Cardinals President of Operations **John Moze-liak** attended the University of Arizona before graduating from the University of Colorado at Boulder.

Cardinals Senior Special Assistant to the General Manager **Bob Gebhard** worked for the Diamondbacks as Vice President & Special Assistant to the GM for 12 seasons (2005-16).

Diamondbacks infielder **Daniel Descalso** played parts of five seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2010-14)...appeared in 44 postseason games and was a member of the 2011 World Champion Cardinals...originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2007 MLB Draft.

Diamondbacks outfielder **David Peralta** was originally signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent pitcher (September 26, 2004)...pitched three minor league seasons (2005-07)...underwent pair of left-shoulder surgeries...released in May 2009.

Diamondbacks pitcher **Fernando Salas** pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (2010-13)...was a member of the 2011 World Series Champions...converted a team-leading 24 saves for St. Louis in 2011...originally purchased by St. Louis from Triple-A Saltillo Saraperos of the Mexican League (April 5, 2007).

Diamondbacks Vice President, Player Development **Mike Bell** is the younger brother of former Cardinals Bench Coach **David Bell**...Mike also played in eight games for the Triple-A Memphis Redbirds in 2005.

Cardinals Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** served as the Diamondbacks Chief Baseball Analyst for four seasons (2014-17).

Diamondbacks First Base Coach **Dave McKay** served in the same position for the Cardinals (1996-2011) under La Russa.

Diamondbacks Pitching Strategist **Dan Haren** was drafted by St. Louis in the 2nd round of the 2001 MLB draft...pitched two seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2003-04)...later traded by the Cardinals with catcher Daric Barton and pitcher Kiko Calero to Oakland for pitcher Mark Mulder (December 18, 2004).

Diamondbacks Pro Scout **Pete Vuckovich** pitched three seasons in St. Louis (1978-80)...later traded by the Cardinals with pitcher Rolie Fingers and catcher Ted Simmons to the Brewers for pitchers Lary Sorensen and Dave LaPoint and outfielders David Green and Sixto Lezcano (December 12, 1980).

Diamondbacks Player & Media Relations Intern **Sydney Sloas** served as the Cardinals 2017 Spring Training Intern at Jupiter, Fla.

- Appeared in two games on back fields taking part in minor league competition

**CAREER**

- Ranks 2nd among Cardinals all-time strikeout leaders with 1,583, trailing only Bob Gibson (3,117)...his 146 career wins rank 5th all-time in Cardinals history.
- Ranks 6th among all Cardinals pitchers in franchise history with a 3.29 ERA and 8th with 1,891.2 innings pitched.
- He and Yadier Molina have been a starting battery for 237 career games, the most in Cardinals history (surpassed Bob Gibson & Tim Lincecum's 198 on 6/15/16) and the most for any tandem since Tom Glavine and Javy Lopez had 248 games together for the Braves from 1994-2002 (*Elias*).
- Owens the most career wins at Busch Stadium III at 78 and has 3rd-lowest ERA at 2.81 (min. 200 IP).
- Has a career .655 home win pct. (78-41), 6th among active National League pitchers. The 78 home wins rank 2nd to Clayton Kershaw (80).
- His 3.29 career ERA ranks T5th (Max Scherzer) among active pitchers to Clayton Kershaw (2.36), Madison Bumgarner (3.01), David Price (3.21), Felix Hernandez (3.22).
- Among active MLB pitchers, ranks 4th in winning percentage (.643), 7th in wins (146), 13th in strikeouts (1,583), 7th in complete games (22) and 6th in shutouts (10).

- Shared the team lead in wins (12) while making 24 appearances (23 starts) during an injury-shortened season.
- Was 8-1 with a 3.08 ERA in 11 home starts (64.1 IP). His .889 home win pct. ranked T2nd in the N.L. Was 5-0 with a 1.16 ERA (31.0 IP/4 ER) in five day starts at home.
