NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals will face the Colorado Rockies in game two of this four-game weekend set tonight... Washington dropped game one, 5-1, on Thursday night...The Nationals tallied a season-low four hits, while **Trevor Gott** (2.0 IP, SO) and **Shawn Kelley** (1.0 IP, H, SO) combined to toss 3.0 innings of scoreless relief... Making his second appearance in a Washington Nationals uniform, **Moisés Sierra** laced a pinch-hit double in the sixth inning.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick clubbed his first home run of the season on Thursday night, a solo shot in the fifth inning off Chad Bettis...The home run extended his hitting streak to 10 games, tied for the second-longest streak in Major League Baseball (**Brian Dozier** -11, **Marcell Ozuna** - 11)...Kendrick's longest career hitting streak is an 18-gamer from June 20 to July 7, 2011 as a member of the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

- Kendrick has reached base safely in each of his first 11 games of the season...He was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded five multi-hit efforts along the way, while seven of his 15 hits have been extra base hits (6 2B, HR).
- Kendrick ranks among National League hitters in doubles (T3rd, 6), batting average (6th, .349) and hits (T9th, 15).
- Since joining the Nationals prior to the 2017 trade deadline, Kendrick is hitting .304 with 14 doubles, two triples, eight homers, 31 RBI, four stolen bases and 24 runs scored in 63 games...He has posted a .350 on-base percentage and a .507 slugging percentage.

LEADING MAN

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season on Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs lead Major League Baseball and he is tied for first with 16 walks...Harper ranks among National League hitters in slugging percentage (1st, .714), runs scored (1st, 13), OPS (2nd, 1.181), on-base percentage (T3rd, .467), and RBI (T3rd, 12).

- Of his 12 hits this season, six have been home runs...Moreover, Harper has 16 walks and just 10 strikeouts through the first 13 games of the season.

FUN IN THE FIRST

The Nationals have scored two runs in the first inning in three of their last five games...For the season, Washington's offense has scored at least one run in the first inning in nine of 13 games...In total, the Nationals have scored 18 runs in the first inning, ahead of the Arizona Diamondbacks (15) for the most in Major League Baseball.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has reached base safely in 15 of 30 plate appearances (.500 OBP, 8 H, 2 HBP, 5 BB)...He has hit safely in six of his eight games played, including five straight games.

- In seven starts, he is hitting .364 (8-for-22) with two doubles, three RBI, five walks, one stolen base and three runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the seven starts.

MINIMAL INHERITANCE TAX

Nationals relievers have allowed just two of 14 inherited runners to score this season...Their 14.3% inherited runners scored percent is tied for third in the National League and tied for fifth in Major League Baseball... They are one of three National League teams (and one of seven in MLB) to allow two or fewer inherited runners to score.

STOLEN MOMENTS

Washington stole five bases on Saturday, the most in a game since July 27, 2017 vs. CHI and tied for the fourth most in a single game in Nationals history (2005-pres)...The Nationals lead MLB with 15 stolen bases.

- **Trea Turner** leads the National League (tied for 2nd in MLB) with five stolen bases this season.
- **Michael A. Taylor** ranks tied for second in the NL and is tied for fourth in MLB with four stolen bases.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 13 (4-7 on this date)

2012 - **Xavier Nady** hit a game-tying pinch-hit homer in the eighth inning and **Jayson Werth's** one-out bases-loaded single up the middle rendered a Nationals' 2-1 win in 13 innings over the Reds. **Jordan Zimmermann** and five relievers combined to limit Cincinnati to just one run on five hits despite playing four extra innings. **Jayson Werth** became the first big leaguer since 1963 to record a game-ending RBI in the 13th inning on Friday The 13th. Jayson's Friday The 13th predecessor was **Willie Stargell** (HOF, '88), who tripled in **Dick Schofield** in the 13th inning as the Pirates bested the Giants, 5-4, on Sept. 13 at Forbes Field. **Dick Schofield** is **Jayson Werth's** grandfather.

IN THE COMMUNITY

April 15: Jackie Robinson Day

On Sunday the Nationals, Major League Baseball and the entire baseball family will pay homage to the contributions of **Jackie Robinson** and his enduring impact on society and the game of baseball. The Nationals are honored to be joined by Medal of Freedom winner and civil rights icon, Congressman **John Lewis**, who will be throwing out the ceremonial first pitch.

COLORADO ROCKIES

Henry Blanco spent the 1999 season with the Colorado Rockies...**Ian Desmond** spent seven Major League seasons in Washington from 2009-15...This will be his his first action against his former team, as he was on the disabled list during the 2017 matchups.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Rockies will play four games this weekend in D.C. and will not match up again until the final series of the season, Sept. 28-30 at Colorado...The Rockies have won five of the last six games at at Nationals Park since Aug. 27, 2016.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#57 - TANNER ROARK - RHP

Right-hander is one of MLB's top unheralded pitching performers...Since 2013, is 51-36 with a 3.46 ERA in 113 starts...He has eclipsed the 13-win mark in each of his seasons as a full-time starter (2014, 2016-17)...Since 2014, he ranks third among MLB starting pitchers in hard-hit rate (25.2%), according to FanGraphs.com...Has tossed 7.0 innings in 43 of his 113 career starts (38%), going 26-9 with a 1.47 ERA in those 43 starts...Helped Team USA bring home the Gold Medal in the 2017 World Baseball Classic...Is stellar with the glove, having committed just two errors in 108 games (514.1 IP) since the start of 2015.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: Is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA in three games (two starts) against the Rockies...Lone relief appearance came on Aug. 18, 2015 at COL (1.0 IP, H 2 SO)...Both starts against the Rockies came in 2017.

LAST START: Allowed five earned runs on five hits with nine strikeouts and four walks in 5.0 innings of work on April 8 vs. NYM...His nine strikeouts were the most since he struck out 10 on Sept. 1 at MIL.

2018 NOTES

- Has allowed just one hit to right-handed batters in 2018...They are 1-for-16 (.063) with two walks and six strikeouts.
