#### **Defense**

SS Dansby Swanson has 12 defensive runs saved this season, tied for the fifth most by any major league player this season.

He is tied for first among shortstops with San Diego's Freddy Galvis, and is one ahead of Los Angeles' Andrelton Simmons and Chicago's Addison Russell.

The club has made just one error in their last six games and none in their last three. For the season, the Braves have made 40 total errors, the fifth fewest in the majors and the fourth fewest in the N.L.

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Braves and Blue Jays open a two-game set tonight with the third meeting between the clubs this season...The teams split a two-game series in Toronto, June 19-20.

- ⚠ Over the last two season, the Braves have won four of six games with Toronto...Over their last 16 home games against the Blue Jays, Atlanta is 11-5.
- A RHP Julio Teheran is 0-1 with a 10.00 ERA (20 ER/18.0 IP) in four career appearances against Toronto...Lost, 9-0, to tonight's opposing starter, Marcus Stroman on May 18 of last season... Teheran allowed a career-most nine runs, earned, and surrendered a solo homer to Stroman in that start
- A RHP Marcus Stroman is set for his second career appearance against Atlanta...The righty beat Atlanta and tonight's opposing starter, Julio Teheran, last season, 9-0...He tossed 5.2 scoreless innings while hitting his only career home run, a solo shot off Teheran as part of consecutive home runs with Luke Maile.

**ALL-STARS:** The Braves had four players named to the All-Star team, with 1B Freddie Freeman and OF Nick Markakis voted to start...RHP Mike Foltynewicz and 2B Ozzie Albies were selected as reserves.

- ✓ Freeman is set to be the first Braves first baseman
  to start since Andres Galaragga in 2000...Only
  three other Braves first baseman have started the
  game: Fred McGriff (1995, 1996), Hank Aaron
  (1973) and Joe Adcock (1960).
- Markakis, who has played in 1,928 career games, was named to his first All-Star team this season... No other player in MLB history has played more games prior to their first All-Star game...Ron Fairly held the previous record, playing in 1,866 games before being selected to the 1973 N.L. squad.
- ⚠ The Braves have four All-Stars for the first time since 2012 (3B Chipper Jones, RHP Craig Kimbrel, 2B Dan Uggla, OF Michael Bourn)... The last time the Braves had at least two starters in the game was 2003, when Javy Lopez and Gary Sheffield started a 7-6 loss at U.S. Cellular Field.

**INTERLEAGUE:** The Braves will play all of their three remaining Interleague series in Atlanta, starting with these two games against Toronto... Tampa Bay will visit for a two-game series, August 28-29, before Boston comes for a three-game set, September 3-5.

A The Braves are 6-7 (.462) against the American League this season, including 1-2 in Atlanta...They dropped two-of-three to Baltimore, June 22-June 24, on their last homestand.

**REACHING BASE:** 1B Freddie Freeman has reached four times in each of his last two games, going 3-for-4 with a walk in both contests....Freeman went 11-for-69 with 22 strikeouts and a .247 on-base percentage over his previous 17 games, dating to June 17.

A Freeman ranks second in the National League with a .406 on-base percentage.

**HOME AGAIN:** The Braves will play 12 of their next 17 games at SunTrust Park and 22 of their next 34... The Braves do not have any more scheduled three-city road trips this season.

- Atlanta is 23–17 (.575) at SunTrust Park this season, the fifth-best home record in the National League.
- A The club has allowed 33 of their 93 home runs here, and the team's 0.78 HR/9 ratio at home is the second lowest in the majors...Only San Francisco has a better mark (0.64 at AT&T Park).

**MINTER:** Since the start of June, LHP A.J.Minter has compiled a 1.17 ERA (2 ER/15.1 IP) with six hits allowed, two walks and 20 strikeouts in 16 games.

✓ In his first 24 games of the season, Minter walked 13 on his way to a 3.74 ERA (9 ER/21.2 IP).

**TWO-OUT RUNS:** The Braves continue to lead the N.L. with 176 two-out runs, while their slash line of .270/.355/.445 in such situations leads the majors in all three categories.

∠ OF Nick Markakis (.351) and 1B Freddie Freeman (.341) are fourth and fifth in two-out batting average.

**HOME RUNS:** The Braves failed to homer in their four games against the Brewers last weekend, marking the first time in franchise history the club went an entire series in Milwaukee without going deep at least once.

- ★ The Braves are 41-18 (.695) when they hit at least one home run this season, the seventh-best record in the majors.
- A The club has gone homerless in 30 games this season, and has won nine of them.

**BACK IN THE LINEUP:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. is back in the starting lineup tonight, hitting seventh and playing left field...Acuña Jr. left the game on July 6 with left groin tightness and only had one pinch-hit appearance on Sunday following his injury.

A The Braves are 22-15 (.595) with Acuña Jr. in the starting lineup, and since his debut on April 25 at Cincinnati, the rookie is tied for second on the team with five game-winning RBI.

**DOUBLES:** 2B Ozzie Albies has a N.L.-high 29 doubles this season and with one more will set the franchise record for most two-base hits prior to the All-Star break...Marcus Giles first set the mark in 2003.

#### Tonight's Game

- A Set to make his 18th start of the season and the 180th (183rd appearance) of his career
- Returned to Atlanta following his last start, 7/4 at NYY, with an illness... Was not with the club during its four-game series in Milwaukee.
- A Faces Toronto for the fifth time in his career, his most such starts against an American League team...Is 0-1 with a 10.00 ERA (20 ER/18.0 IP) in his first four career turns
  - Made one start against the Blue Jays last season, 5/18 at SunTrust Park...Went just 3.0 innings and allowed eight hits and a career-high nine earned runs.
- Makes his 23rd career Interleague start, and his 13th against a team from the A.L. East...Is 1-8 with an 8.07 ERA (55 ER/61.1 IP) in his career against the division, including a 1-5 stretch over his last six starts.
  - Since Teheran first faced a team from the A.L. East in 2012, his 8.07 ERA against the division is second highest in the majors (min. 10 starts), while his .111 winning percentage (1-8) is tied for lowest.
  - ★ Atlanta has been outscored 88-42 in Teheran's starts against the A.L. East
- Molding right-handed batters to a career-low .184 (33-for-179) batting average, the sixth-lowest mark in the majors.

#### 2018 Recap

- - Was his fifth scoreless start of the season of at least 6.0 innings and four or fewer hits, tied with teammate Sean Newcomb for the most such starts in the majors.
- Allowed a season-most seven runs, 6/23 vs. BAL...Surrendered a first-inning grand slam to Mark Trumbo, the fifth grand slam allowed by Teheran in his career...Five grand slams are third most among active pitchers since his debut in 2011.
- → Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17... Was the first hitless start of his career.
  - Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.
  - Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing...Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).
- ★ Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16...Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.
- A Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion... Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.
  - ♣ Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5...The D.L. stint was
    the second of his career and his first since 2016.
- Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM...Has gone 7.0 innings three times this season, and all three have come against the Mets.
  - ✓ Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning...His streak was the longest in the majors against the Mets since Teheran also had a 29.0-inning run from 6/21/15 to 9/9/16.
- Turned in a "quality" start, 5/25 at BOS, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings of work...Threw a season-most 109 pitches.
  - ✓ Took the loss after Atlanta fell 6-2....The loss snapped a career high-tying fourgame winning streak that dated to 4/16 vs. PHI...Went 4-0 with a 2.06 ERA
    (8 ER/35.0 IP) over the run, which spanned six total starts.
- ✓ Allowed a then season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/20 vs. MIA...Left the game trailing 6-0 before Atlanta rallied for a 10-9 win...The Braves are 10-6 in his 16 starts this season.
  - All six runs scored in the fourth inning, the third time in his career he's allowed six or more runs in one inning...Also did so on 7/28/17 at PHI (5th) and 5/26/15 at LAD (4th).
- - Allowed two runs in the bottom of the second to snap a 16.0-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest such stretch of his career...Tossed a career-most 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings in 2016.
- ★ Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/9 at TB...Allowed four hits and fanned seven...

  Logged consecutive scoreless starts for the fifth time in his career.
  - ★ The outing vs. TB snapped a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East, dating to 9/6/17.

✓ Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

Holds: 2 Saves/Opp: 0/1 1st Batter/Retired: 27/19 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/3

- Over his last 17 appearances, has a 2.11 ERA (5 ER/21.1 IP) with a .155 (11-for-71) opponents' average
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... In four extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 8.0 scoreless innings with four hits and 14 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last five outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just nine hits in 75 at-bats (.120) against him...Lefties are hitting .333/.429/.619 with 14 hits, six walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

#### Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

1st Batter/Retired: 36/23 Holds: 11 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3 Saves/Opp: 0/1

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one
- Is one of 10 relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL...Had allowed five earned runs over his previous 3.1 frames, spanning two appearances.
- Holding batters to a .182 (14-for-77) average with men on base and has allowed just six hits (6-for-44, .136) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .253 (23-for-91) with no one on base.
- Has a 5.40 ERA (12 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 16 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.

- with a 7.13 ERA (14 ER/17.2 IP) in his last 19 appearances, dating to 5/23...Surrendered 17 hits and 11 walks during the spell, including a three home runs, and has allowed at least one run in nine of those outings.
- $Had\ a\ 8.49\ ERA\ (11\ ER/11.2\ IP)$  in 12 games in June.
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 10-for-50 (.200) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

- Recalled, 7/4, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his second stint on the active roster...Also up from 5/8-6/16...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- In three starts with the Stripers after being optioned, went 1-1 with a 4.09 ERA (5 ER/11.0 IP)...Fanned 13. Earned his first win of the season in his last appearance, 6/30 at Charlotte (5.0 IP, 2 ER).
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3... Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP. 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.

- Was recalled, 7/7 for his third stint on the active roster... Optioned to Gwinnett, 7/4, and was eligible for recall following LHP Max Fried's placement on the disabled list.
- Made his major league debut, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed two runs in 2.1 innings and fanned one.
- In his last three outings with Triple-A Gwinnett, tossed 3.2 scoreless innings and recorded eight of his 11 outs via strikeout...Allowed just one hit
- Was 4-4 with a 2.09 ERA (9 ER/38.2 IP) in 29 relief appearances with the Stripers this season, and had converted even of his eight save chances.
