**FINAL SERIES:** The Giants and Dodgers face off for the final series of the 2018 season...San Francisco has gone 9-7 against the Dodgers this season, including a 4-2 record at home...SF pitchers have posted a 1.99 ERA (14er, 63.1ip) over the last seven games vs. Los Angeles-NL.

**ON THE MOUND: LHP Madison Bumgarner** is scheduled to face the Dodgers for the 32nd time in his career...he's posted a 15-10 record with a 2.61 ERA (57er, 196.2ip) and held LA to a .227 opponents average over his 31 starts...his 15 wins against the Dodgers are the most he has against any team and are the most of any active player.

**MADISON BUMGARNER:** Made his 250th career start on September 15...among pitchers who have taken the ball that many times in the era of divisional play, only five have lower ERAs (Stats, LLC).

**SCORELESS STREAK: LHP Madison Bumgarner** has tossed 20.0-consecutive scoreless innings here at home, dating back to his start on Aug. 7 vs. Houston.

**THANK YOU FANS:** The Giants topped three million in attendance for the ninth-straight season and for the 17th time in 19 years at AT&T Park...entering tonight's game, San Francisco's attendance of 3,031,970 this season ranks as the fourth-highest in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3,809,684), New York-AL (3,482,865) and St. Louis (3,403,587).

**WILLIE MAC AWARD:** Prior to tonight's game, the Willie Mac Award will be given to a Giants player who best exemplifies the inspiration, character and leadership that **Willie McCovey** demonstrated during his playing days in San Francisco...the Giants and Willie McCovey will honor the Willie Mac Award winner with a pre-game on field ceremony that will also celebrate past winners.

**DRIVING IN RUNS:** No Giant has driven in 10 runs this month, **IF Evan Longoria** leads the club with nine...since RBI became an official stat in 1920, there has never been a September when no Giant reached double figures in RBI...the departed Andrew McCutchen still leads the club with 55 RBI this season, which is the lowest for a Giants team leader in a full season as long as RBI have been an official statistic...**IF Brandon Crawford** and **IF Evan Longoria** each have 54 RBI (Stats, LLC).

**RISP MANAGEMENT:** San Francisco has just three hits in their last 24 at-bats (.125) with runners in scoring position...dating back to Sept. 1, the Giants' .169 average with RISP ranks as the lowest figure in the Majors.

**SECOND HALF STRUGGLES:** San Francisco's .220 batting average since the break is on pace to be the lowest second-half mark in franchise history, and would be the lowest post-All Star average by any team since the 1974 Padres (.212) (Stats, LLC).

**GIANTS PITCHERS:** Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.45 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors.

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** San Francisco is 21-67 (.239) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 52-19 (.732) when plating four-or-more runs.

### This Date in Giants History: September 28, 1993

The Giants reclaimed a share of first place in the NL West with the Braves, as SF defeated Colorado, 6-4...**Will Clark** hit his 14th homer of the season, **Rod Beck** earned his 45th save, and the Giants won their 100th game of the season.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#40 LHP Madison Bumgarner**  
**6-4, 243, 29 years old (August 1, 1989)**  
**6-6 Record, 3.20 ERA**

- The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the mound today for his 21st and final start of 2018...the Giants are 9-11 in his outings this year, going 6-3 at home and 3-8 on the road.
- Last pitched last Friday at St. Louis where he allowed three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings in a no-decision in the Giants' 5-3 loss to the Cardinals...struck out five and walked one in the 98-pitch outing.
- Has allowed three runs or fewer in 15 of his 20 starts.
- Owns a 1.34 home ERA (9er, 60.1ip) in nine starts at AT&T Park this season...his 1.34 home ERA is the lowest in the National League (min. 60.0 home innings pitched) and second-lowest in the Majors behind Tampa Bay's Blake Snell (1.24 home ERA).
- Has not allowed a run at home in his last 20.0 innings spanning three starts...the last time he allowed a run at home was July 27 vs. Milwaukee...his 20.0-inning home scoreless streak is the longest by a Giants' starter since **Johnny Cueto** had a 29.1 inning scoreless streak at home from April 21-May 23, 2016.
- Bumgarner has an 1.65 ERA (11er/60.0ip) in innings 1-3 this season...he has a 4.66 ERA (33er, 63.2ip) through the rest of the game.
- Has been given a total of just 39 runs of support in his 20 starts (2.84 RSA).
- Will face the Dodgers for a third time this season and his first time at home...is 0-1 with a 3.75 ERA (5er, 12.0ip) in his two prior starts vs. LA...last faced the Dodgers at Dodger Stadium on August 13...was saddled with a no-decision after allowing two runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings in the Giants' 5-2 win.
- Is facing the Dodgers at home for the first time since Sept. 30, 2016, a 9-3 Giants' win that saw him allow three runs on nine hits in 7.1 innings for the win...is 6-3 with a 2.91 ERA (22er, 68.0ip) in 11 career starts vs. the Dodgers at home...SF is 7-4 in his 11 home starts vs. LA.
- Is averaging 7.50 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the lowest rate of his career since 2010...his 3.06 walks per 9.0 is the highest of his career.
- Has walked four batters in his four starts this month (23.0 innings) after walking 14 batters in six starts during August (39.0 innings).
- Was reinstated from the 60-day DL June 5...Missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand.
- Had never been on the DL in his first eight MLB seasons but has now twice been placed on the DL the last two years, missing a total of 135 games...SF is 59-76 (.437) with Bumgarner on the DL.
- His 110 career wins are the third-most in SF-era history (since 1958) behind **Juan Marichal** (238) and **Gaylord Perry** (134).
- Has 32 double-digit strikeout games, the second-most in Giants franchise history behind **Tim Lincecum** (36)...needs 21 strikeouts to match **Gaylord Perry** (1,606) for the fourth-most in SF-era history...is still seeking his first double-digit strikeout game this year (2018 season-high in strikeouts is eight).

**Last Home Run:** Sept. 3, 2017 vs. STL (off RHP Luke Weaver)

**HITTING NOTES:** Is 7-for-42 (.167) with four RBI this year...delivered a pinch-hit, walk-off RBI single on Tuesday in the Giants' 5-4 win in 12 innings...was the first Giants pitcher with a walk-off RBI since **Don Robinson** did so as a pinch-hitter vs. Houston on July 31, 1990...has hit 17 homers in his 10-year career, the most of any active player and the most in Giants franchise history...is the first pitcher to total at least three homers in four consecutive seasons since Earl Wilson achieved the feat in five-straight seasons between 1964 and 1968...has yet to homer in 2018.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER: RHP DERECK RODRIGUEZ**  
**2018: 6-4, 2.50 ERA / Career: 6-4, 2.50 ERA**

**NOTES:** 26-year-old right-hander is slated to make his 19th and final start of the 2018 season...tomorrow's outing will mark his 21st appearance this season...the Giants are 9-9 overall when he takes the hill as a starter, going 5-6 at home and 4-3 on the road...the Giants have lost each of his last six starts and eight of his last 10...was charged with four runs on seven hits in 6.0 innings in his last start on Saturday at St. Louis in a 5-4, 10-inning loss to the Cardinals...it marked the first time since his second big-league start that he allowed more than three earned runs in a game...he also did it at Washington on June 9 (5er)...prior to his most recent outing, Rodriguez had 15 consecutive starts of allowing three runs or fewer...has never faced the Dodgers.

- Has held opponents to a .125 (4-for-32) average with runners in scoring position dating to June 26.
- Has induced 13 double plays, tied for the fourth-most among NL relievers.
