## CARDINALS NOTES

- **Miles Mikolas** made his 13th start of the season, second against the Padres in 2018 (1-1) and in his career...suffered his second loss in his last three games after winning his first six decisions of the season...did not issue a walk for the 6th start this season...pitched his 9th quality start of the season (T3rd NL)...surrendered his first home run since 5/10 at SD by **Raffy Lopez** (35.0 innings).
- **Marcell Ozuna** recorded career hit No. 750 with an RBI single in the 7th inning...extended his hitting streak to six games (8-23, .348) and has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (16-41, .390)...has an RBI in four straight games, tying the club high.
- **Tommy Pham** has hit safely in seven straight games (9-30, .300) establishing his season high streak for 2018...has scored in 31-of-36 games in which he has a hit this season...has scored in three straight games.
- **Yadier Molina** has an RBI in 3 of his last 4 games (5 total RBI).
- **Jordan Hicks** struck out the side in the 8th and has three or more strikeouts in back-to-back appearances for the first time this season...has 16 strikeouts in his last seven appearances after fanning 12 in his first 24 appearances...tied his season-high with four strikeouts...has pitched 2.0 or more innings for the 4th time this season, all scoreless appearances.
- **Greg Garcia** has hit safely in all three games vs. SD this season (4-8, .500).
- *The Cardinals challenged the safe call on Freddy Galvis at home plate in the 4th inning. Call stands (Time: 1:47).*
- The Cardinals tied their fastest game of the season at 2-hours 25-minutes...have been held to two runs or less for the 18th time this season (1-17)...did not walk an opposing batter for the 3rd game this season (4/22 vs. CIN & 5/4 vs. CHI), all three were starts by **Miles Mikolas**.

## PADRES NOTES

- **Matt Strahm** made his third start (11th app.) of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and in his career (2nd app.)...had made 56 career appearances with 51 coming in relief (4-7, 2.93 ERA) going 1-2 with a 6.19 ERA in his five starts entering tonight...had not pitched more than 2.1 innings in his two starts this season...achieved season-high's with 3.0 innings with four strikeouts.
- **Adam Cimber** tied his season-high with 3.0 innings pitched (3rd time) and the second time it has been a scoreless outing (4/16 vs. LAD)...is now tied for the MLB lead for wins by a rookie reliever with three.
- **Jose Pirela** has hit safely in each of his last seven starts (9-29, .310).
- **Eric Hosmer** hit his 3rd home run of the season on the first pitch, ranking 3rd on the Padres behind **Christian Villanueva** (5).

- **A.J. Ellis** tallied his 4th career game with multiple RBI vs. STL and first since 8/8/2013 at Busch Stadium.
- **Christian Villanueva** recorded his 3rd pinch-hit RBI of the season.
- **Craig Stammen** allowed two runs, his 2nd-highest total in an appearances and most since three vs. LAD (4/18).
- **Brad Hand** locked down his 20th save of the season, tied with **Wade Davis (COL)** for the National League lead. Becomes the first Padres pitcher since **Huston Street** (2012-14) to have consecutive seasons of 20 or more saves.
- The **Padres** have 14 wins from their relief pitchers this season...did not issue a walk for the second consecutive game for the first time since 5/21-23/2017...marked 4th game this season without issuing a walk (all on the road: 4/8 at HOU, 5/19 at PIT, 6/11 at STL)...held their opponent to two runs or less for the 23rd game this season (19-4)...are 23-4 when scoring first this season.
