ROSTER MOVE—Today the Rays added LH **Anthony Banda** (BAHN-da) from Triple-A Durham per MLB's 26th Man Rule...he was acquired by the Rays in a three-team trade involving OF **Steven Souza Jr.**...he will be making his Rays debut, but made 8 apps (4 starts) with the D-backs last year...went 4-2 with a 3.50 ERA (36-IP, 14-ER) and 44 SO in 7 starts for the Bulls...is tied for 2nd in the International League in wins and strikeouts.

LET'S PLAY TWO—Today's traditional, single-admission doubleheader will be the 27th doubleheader in club history and eighth traditional doubleheader...the Rays are 4-12-10 in their previous 26 doubleheaders and 1-2-4 in their previous seven traditional doubleheaders...this will be the sixth time the Rays play the Orioles in a doubleheader, their 3rd-most against any opponent behind the Yankees (7) and Red Sox (7)...it will be their first doubleheader since June 10, 2017 vs. OAK (won 6-5, lost 7-2) and their first on the road since June 25, 2016 at BAL (see chart).

Doubleheader Record vs. BAL: 1-2-2

RAY MATTER—The Rays have lost four consecutive games, matching April 11-15 for their 2nd-longest losing streak of the season (8, March 30-April 8)...the Rays are 2-6 in their last 8 games and 3-7 in their last 10 games on the heels of an 8-game winning streak from April 18-28.

- + Yesterday the Rays allowed 4 HR, their most since Sep 28, 2017 at NYY (4) at most against the Orioles since June 25, 2016 (G2) at Camden Yards (4)...it was the first time they allowed at least 4 HR and a grand slam since July 6, 2006 vs. BOS...the grand slam hit by **Manly Machado** was the third allowed by the Rays this season, tied for 3rd-most in the majors behind the Yankees (4) and Orioles (4).
- + Yesterday the Rays recorded 15 hits, their most in a loss since June 22, 2015 vs. TOR (15)...it was the fourth time in club history the Rays scored 4 runs or fewer in a game with 15 hits or more (last Oct 1, 2015 vs. MIA)...the Rays dropped to 11-9 this season when outpitching their opponents, compared to 62-12 when doing so last year.
- + Yesterday was the third time in franchise history the Rays lost when at least seven players recorded multi-hit games, following June 5, 2007 at TOR (7) and April 1, 2003 vs. BOS (7).
- + The Rays have been shut out in 32 of their last 36 innings.

RISP-Y BUSINESS—Over this 4-game slide, the Rays have scored 7 runs despite 49 baserunners and are batting .182 (6-for-33) with RISP...this is the first time the Rays have recorded 10 baserunners or more in every game of a 4-game losing streak since Sep 24-27, 2016, and they haven't lost five straight in this fashion since May 6-11, 2007...in their last 10 games, the Rays are batting .190 (15-for-79) with RISP, compared to .374 (34-for-91) with RISP during their 8-game winning streak.

POWER OUTAGE—The Rays have gone three consecutive games without a homer, matching their season high (April 11-14)...for the record, they haven't gone four straight without one since June 30-July 3, 2015...they have been outhomered, 8-1, in their last 5 games and 10-3 in their last 8 games since the start of May...in comparison, they ended April with home runs in eight straight games, and totaled 19 HR over that span including multiple homers in 6 games and 3 HR or more in 4 games.

- + Only 33.1 pct. of the Rays runs this season have scored via the home run, compared to a club-record 48.0 pct. last year.

RAYS vs. ORIOLES—Today is the fourth and fifth of 19 games between the two clubs this season, and the Rays are 2-1 thus far...last night snapped a 5-game winning streak against the Orioles, dating back to last Sep 29, their longest against them since May 17-June 8, 2013 (5)...they are 9-3 in their last 12 games against the Orioles...last season the Rays went 11-8 against them, their first season series win over the Orioles since 2013 (13-6)...they hit 29 HR, tied for their most ever against Baltimore (2006)—but only 7 of those 29 HR were hit by players still currently with the club.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN—This is the third of four consecutive 3-city road trips to start the season—the first time in franchise history the Rays have ever had four consecutive three-city trips...this 11-game jaunt to Baltimore (4 games), Kansas City (3 games) and Anaheim (4 games) is the Rays first trip of 11 games or more since September 2016, when they went 5-6 visiting NYY (1-3), TOR (1-2) and BAL (2-2)...the Rays welcomed new hitting coach **Chad Mottola** at the onset of that trip...the last time the Rays covered had a road trip to three different time zones was June 2008, when they went 3-6 in Boston (0-3), Texas (2-1) and Anaheim (1-2)—including the famous **James Shields-Coco Crisp** brawl at Fenway Park.

OLD FRIENDS AS FOES—Today's encounter with **Alex Cobb** will mark the seventh time in the first 37 games the team will face a starting pitcher who was a former Ray...they are 2-4 thus far in games started by Cobb (1-0), **Matt Moore** (0-1), **David Price** (1-2) and **James Shields** (0-1).

- + The Rays will face **Jason Hammel** on Wed at KC, which will be the eighth time in the first 41 games the club will face a former Ray.
- + Price, Shields, Moore and Cobb all rank among the Rays Top 10 in career ERA, wins, games started and strikeouts, and were all members of the Rays starting rotation in 2012.

CLOSE SHAVES—The Rays have played a major-league-most 17 games decided by 1 run, and they are 5-12 (.294) in these games—4th-lowest winning pct. in the majors...48.6 pct. of the Rays games this season have been decided by 1 run, compared to 29.2 pct. of games in the majors.

- + The Rays are the first team in the majors with at least 12 one-run losses within the first 35 games of the season since the 1994 Phillies (12) and the first AL team since the 1989 Blue Jays (12).

ROAMING BUFFALO—Yesterday at BAL, **Wilson Ramos** singled in the 4th inning to extend his hitting streak to 17 games, the longest active streak in the majors and tied with MIN **Brian Dozier** (March 29-April 23) for the longest streak in the majors this season...it is the longest in the majors by a catcher since Ramos hit in a career-high 19 straight from April 24-May 19, 2015 (with WAS), and is the longest in club history among catchers...since returning from a torn right ACL last June, Ramos has hit .310/.333/.667 (13-for-42) in 12 games against the Orioles and has 4 HR and 14 RBI in 7 games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards.

LA PANTERA—Shortstop **Adeiny Hechavarria** has not committed an error since last July 30 at NYY, going 81 games and 271 chances since then...these are the longest streaks in franchise history for a shortstop...since last Aug 1, every other AL shortstop with as many innings (697.1) has committed at least 7 errors...since being acquired by the Rays on June 26, 2017, he has a .990 fielding pct. in 107 games (104 starts).

RAYS ON THE TUBE—A new episode of "Inside the Rays" premieres on FOX Sports Sun tonight following the conclusion of the Rays-Orioles doubleheader...titled "The Prospects," this episode focuses on four of the most highly touted positional players in the organization: INF **Willy Adames**, INF **Christian Arroyo**, 1B/OF **Jake Bauers** and OF **Justin Williams**.

- + In January, *Baseball America* listed the Rays at No. 5 in its Organizational Talent rankings of minor league prospects, their highest position since 2013 (No. 4)...the publication's Top 100 Prospects included six Rays, a figure topped only by the Braves (8).

LAST START—On Sun vs. TOR, lowered his season ERA from 6.05 to 5.32...his only run allowed was a 1-out, RBI single by **Aledmys Díaz** in the 5th inning...went 7 IP, his longest start since Aug 27, 2017 at STL (7 IP) and longest at home since July 22, 2017 vs. TEX (7 IP)...received no-decision following the game-tying, 8th-inning solo homer by **Carlos Gómez** to avoid the third loss of his career when going 7 IP or more and yielding 1 run or fewer...his line: ND, 7 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 SO, 97 pit, 64 str.

- + Did not allow a walk for the first time since Sep 2, 2017 at CWS, and for the first time in a non-injury shortened start since Aug 17, 2017 at TOR.
- + Did not allow a homer for the second consecutive start, after allowing at least 1 HR in his first 6 starts this season.

LAST TWO—Has pitched to a 2.08 ERA (13-IP, 3-ER) in 2 starts in May, though he is 0-1 and the Rays are 0-2 in those 2 starts...has received a combined 1 run of support in those two starts...through the end of April, he had a 6.61 ERA (32.2-IP, 24-ER) which was 6th-highest in the majors and 5th-highest in the AL (min. 25 IP).

vs. BALTIMORE—Is 6-8 with a 4.92 ERA (100.2-IP, 55-ER) in 18 apps (17 starts) against the Orioles...his 8 losses are his 2nd-most against any opponent (Red Sox, 12)...min. 5 starts, his ERA is his 3rd-highest against any opponent behind the Indians (5.87) and Red Sox (5.49)...is 2-5 with a 6.70 ERA (41.2-IP, 31-ER) in 8 apps (7 starts) at Camden Yards, his 2nd-highest ERA at any venue (min. 10 IP) behind Fenway Park (7.29)...last faced them on April 26 at BAL and got the win, the first Ray to win when allowing 11 hits or more since **James Shields** on April 27, 2012 at TEX.

PITCHING DEEPER—Following his season-high 7 IP on Sun vs. TOR, has a chance to go 7 IP or more in back-to-back starts for the first time since May 26–June 6, 2017 (3)...has gone 6 IP or more in consecutive starts for the first time this season, after failing to do so in nine of his previous 12 starts...has totaled 45.2 IP in his 8 starts this season, averaging just over 5.2 IP per start...doesn't have a start of at least 7 IP on the road since Aug 27, 2017 at STL (7 IP) and hasn't gone 8 IP since May 10, 2017 vs. KC (8 IP) nor on the road since Aug 20, 2015 at HOU (9 IP, CG SHO).

UPCOMING MILESTONES—Is 2 wins shy of tying **Scott Kazmir** (55) for 3rd in franchise history, and 2 starts shy of tying **Price** (170) for 2nd in club history...his 1,092 SO are 2nd in club history behind **James Shields** (1,250).

FRANCHISE FIRST—With his start on Opening Day vs. BOS, he became the second pitcher in franchise history to make four Opening Day starts (**James Shields**; 2008-10, 2012), and the first to do it in four consecutive seasons...is one of five pitchers to start on Opening Day in each of the last four seasons, along with SEA **Félix Hernández**, LAD **Clayton Kershaw**, CLE **Corey Kluber** and ATL **Julio Teheran**.

MR. DURABLE—Since June 1, 2013—the date he was recalled to the majors for good—he leads the majors with 164 starts...DET/WAS **Max Scherzer** ranks 2nd with 161 starts...made 34 starts last season, tying BAL **Kevin Gausman** for the major league lead and tying the club record (Archer in 2015, **David Price** in 2011, **Scott Kazmir** in 2007)...has made at least 30 starts in each of the last four straight seasons, one of two Rays pitchers all-time to do that (also **James Shields**, six, 2007-12)...became the third Rays pitcher with three straight years of 200 IP, joining **Shields** (six, 2007-12) and **Price** (three, 2010-12)...is one of five pitchers to throw at least 200 IP in each of the last three seasons, along with **Max Scherzer**, **Jeff Samardzija**, **Chris Sale** and **Corey Kluber**.

KING OF THE K—His 249 SO last season ranked 4th in the majors behind BOS **Chris Sale** (308), WAS **Max Scherzer** (268) and CLE **Corey Kluber** (268), and ranked 2nd in club history, behind his own record of 252 (2015)...led the majors for a third straight year in strikeouts on the slider (179), after recording 152 in 2016 and 179 in 2015...last season he made 9 starts with at least 10 SO, tying the club record...he has done that 27 times in his career, most in franchise history, ahead of **David Price** (23)...has not allowed a walk in 8 of those 27 career starts, tying **Price** for most in club history and as many as Hall of Famer **Nolan Ryan** compiled in his 27-year career.

K'S FOR KIDS—Every strikeout he records this season will benefit the local nonprofit Starting Right, Now...its mission is to combat youth homelessness through a variety of personal development programs...for every strikeout, Archer, the Rays Baseball Foundation—a 501(c)(3) organization—and Crown Automotive Group will each donate \$25...this is the fourth consecutive year Archer has conducted the strikeout campaign...any Rays fan or local business can join the strikeout challenge by making a pledge at raysbaseball.com/archer.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LH BLAKE SNELL (4-2, 2.40 ERA)

LAST START—On Tues vs. ATL, his only run allowed in the 1-0 loss was a 3rd-inning homer to **Ronald Acuña Jr.** ...took his first loss since April 4 at NYY, snapping his unbeaten streak at 5 starts (4-0, 1 ND)...lost to an opponent other than the Yankees for the first time since July 24, 2017 vs. BAL...was the first Ray to take a loss in a start of more than 6 IP and 1 run or fewer since **Chris Archer** on Sep 26, 2014 at CLE (7.2-IP, 1-ER)...his line: L, 6.1 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 2 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 105 pit, 65 str.

HARD TO HIT—Has allowed 5 hits or fewer in a club-record 12 consecutive starts since Sep 12, 2017...previous mark was 9 by **Drew Smyly** from Aug 11, 2014–May 5, 2015 and **Matt Moore** from Sep 11, 2012–April 27, 2013...this is the longest active streak in the majors, the longest by any pitcher since OAK **Sean Manaea** (16) from Aug 23, 2016–June 5, 2017 and the longest by an AL East pitcher since TOR **Marco Estrada** (13) in 2016.

PITCHING DEEPER—Has gone at least 6 IP in six consecutive starts, the longest such streak of his career (prev. 5, Aug 10–Sep 1, 2017)...has gone at least 7 IP six times in his last 16 starts since Aug 20, 2017 vs. SEA, compared to once in 35 career starts prior to that.

vs. BALTIMORE—Is 1-1 with a 3.44 ERA (18.1-IP, 7-ER) in 3 starts against the Orioles...has made 1 start at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, on Sep 15, 2016, yielding 4 ER in 4.1 IP but taking no decision...last faced them in the season finale last year, the best start of his major league career...totaled 7 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB and a career-high 13 SO in a 6-0 win...the 13 SO were the most by a Rays lefty since **David Price** (13) on Sep 25, 2012 at BOS...it was only the third time in franchise history a pitcher recorded at least 13 SO without allowing a run, joining **Price** on Aug 28, 2011 at TOR (14) and **James Shields** on May 22, 2011 at FLA (13).

OVERVIEW—Will be making his second start of the season (April 29 at BOS)...10 of his 11 apps this season have come out of the bullpen, after 17 starts and 1 app out of the bullpen last season and 44 starts and 28 apps in relief from 2015-17.

BETTER OF LATE—Last pitched on Wed vs. ATL and retired all 6 BF covering the 6th and 7th innings...over his last 6 apps (1 start) since April 21, is 0-1 with a 0.75 ERA (12-IP, 1-ER), 1 BB and 14 SO...this stretch has lowered his season ERA from 8.31 to 3.92, its lowest since April 4...his only run allowed over this span came on May 2 at DET, when he was on the mound for a walk-off loss for the third time in his career (also Sep 2, 2015 at BAL and Aug 19, 2015 at HOU)...it was his first loss since Sep 27, 2017 at NYY and his first loss in relief since July 3, 2016 vs. DET...allowed a triple and bunt single in the 12th inning.

STARTER vs. RELIEVER—In his career, has gone 14-14 with a 4.49 ERA (226.2-IP, 113-ER) in his 45 starts and 2-5 with a 3.80 ERA (73.1-IP, 31-ER) in his 38 relief apps.

vs. BALTIMORE—Is 1-4 with a 6.08 ERA (26.2-IP, 18-ER) in 8 apps (4 starts) against the Orioles and 1-3 with a 4.79 ERA (20.2-IP, 11-ER) in 6 apps (3 starts) at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...has pitched to a 3.21 ERA (14-IP, 5-ER) in his last 3 apps (2 starts) against them, since Sep 17, 2016...pitched in relief against them on April 25 at BAL, and his 2.2 IP remain tied for his season high out of the bullpen...his 4 SO remain a season high and were his most in relief since July 10, 2016 at BOS (5)...got the last two outs of the 6th inning, struck out the side in a perfect 7th and pitched around a 2-out double in the 8th.
