Strong Starts

RHP Mike Foltynewicz enters today's start with a 2.14 ERA (20 ER/84.0 IP), the third-best mark in the National League and the fifth lowest in baseball.

Over the last eight starts dating to May 10, Foltynewicz has compiled a 0.96 ERA (5 ER/47.0 IP), allowing more than two runs in a start just once.

For the season, Foltynewicz has allowed one run or less in 10 starts, tied for the most such turns in the majors with Justin Verlander, Blake Snell and Jacob deGrom.

TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Cardinals finish a three-game set today with the third meeting between the clubs this season...The Cardinals will travel to Atlanta for three games at SunTrust Park, September 17-19.

A The Braves have won the first two games of this series to take a set in St. Louis for just the second time over the past six seasons...Since 2013, the Braves had won only one other series in Busch Stadium (2016).

A The Braves are looking to sweep St. Louis for the first time since shutting them out over the final three games of 2015, October 2-4, at Turner Field...The last time the Braves swept a series in St. Louis was May 11-13, 2012, also a three-game set.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz is set for his fourth career start against St. Louis...The right-hander went 0-2 with a 17.55 ERA (13 ER/6.2 IP) in a pair of starts last season against St. Louis...He won in his other appearance against them, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball in 2016.

A RHP John Gant is set for his first career appearance against Atlanta...The right-hander made his MLB debut in 2016 with the Braves, appearing in 20 games, seven starts, for Atlanta before the club dealt him that December with two other players to St. Louis for LHP Jaime García.

GRAND SLAM: OF Nick Markakis drove a full-count, fifth-inning pitch from Luke Weaver over the wall in right field for his fourth career grand slam and first since 2011 while with Baltimore (June 10 vs. Tampa Bay and Jeremy Hellickson) last night...He went 1,073 games in between slams.

A The drive was the Braves' fourth slam of the season and tied their total from last season...The last time they had more than four grand slams in a season was 2010, when they finished with seven.

A The Braves went from May 16, 2015 through June 2, 2017 without a grand slam, a span of 340 games... Since 1B Matt Adams broke that streak last season on June 3 at Cincinnati, the Braves have hit eight over 191 games.

MAKING THEM COUNT: OF Nick Markakis' grand slam last night was the Braves' N.L. high-tying 18th home run this with at least two men aboard...The club is tied with the Philadelphia Phillies for the league's most such homers...The clubs, along with Boston, are one off the major league lead of the Cleveland Indians.

A Markakis has four such homers, tied for the most in the N.L. and one off the MLB lead of Boston's Xander Bogaerts and New York's Gleyber Torres.

RISP: The Braves went 5-for-10 with runners in scoring position yesterday, and the clubs' slash line of .285/.373/.499 in such situations leads all major league teams in all three categories.

OZZIE HITS AND SCORES: 2B Ozzie Albies finished 3-for-5 with two runs scored last night, and the second baseman has now hit in a season-high 10 consecutive games...He has also scored in a career-best seven consecutive games, the longest run by a Braves player since last season, when Freddie Freeman scored in 10 straight, April 21-May 2.

A He is hitting .447 (21-for-47) during his hitting streak that dates to June 17...His career-best streak is a 13-game run, September 2-September 15 of last season.

A Albies started his run with a pinch-hit double on June 17, the first game he did not start all season... Since the streak began, Albies has raised his average from .248 to .275.

A His 64 runs lead the National League and are two off the major league lead of Mike Trout and Francisco Lindor.

A The franchise record for most runs prior to the All-Star game is 76, first set by Tommy Holmes in 1945 and matched by Dale Murphy in 1983...The Braves have 13 more games prior to the break.

HOME RUNS: The Braves hit two home runs last night, their first multi-homer game since June 20...Their drought stretched seven games, and the Braves hit two total home runs over the skid.

A Both home runs yesterday came with men on, as Ronald Acuña Jr. hit a two-run shot before Nick Markakis had a fifth-inning grand slam...The last time the Braves hit multiple home runs in a game with runners aboard was June 5 at San Diego.

A Following that game on June 5 at San Diego, the Braves were tied for third in the National League with 72 home runs and five off the lead of Washington...They have hit just 19 home runs since and now rank eighth in the National League, 20 behind the league-leading Dodgers.

GOOD GAME: Last night, LHP Max Fried tossed 6.2 scoreless innings, struck out a career-best 11 and collected his first career hit to beat St. Louis, 11-4.

A Fried became the first rookie to fan double digits in a game since 2016, when Aaron Blair struck out 10 on October 1 vs. Detroit.

A The last left-handed rookie to strike out double digits for the Braves was Mike Minor, who fanned 12 on August 22, 2010.

THE ROTATION: The Braves rotation ranks second in the majors with a 3.35 ERA (166 ER/446.0 IP) and trails only Houston's mark of 2.96.

A The Braves are 28-9 when their starter completes 6.0 innings this season.

Today's Game

- A** Set to make his 16th start of the season and the 81st of his career...Is his 100th career appearance.
- A** Allowed just one hit and one run in his last start, 6/25 vs. Cincinnati...Has allowed no more than two earned runs in 14 of his 15 starts on the season, and has allowed one run or fewer 10 times.
- A** His 10 starts allowing one run or less are tied for the most such starts in the majors...Is one of four pitchers to do so, joining Jacob deGrom, Blake Snell and Justin Verlander.
- A** Set to face the Cardinals for the third time in his career...Is 1-2 with a 9.95 ERA (14 ER/12.2 IP) and a .393 opponents' batting average in three career appearances against St. Louis.
- A** Faced them twice last season, going 0-2 with a 17.55 ERA...Allowed 16 hits and 13 earned runs in 6.2 innings.
- A** Opponents are batting just .191 (58-for-303) against Foltyniewicz, one of two N.L. pitchers against which opponents are hitting less than .200...WSH's Max Scherzer leads the majors with a .172 opponents' average.
- A** Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only one qualified pitcher has held opponents to an average under .200 over a full season...Opponents hit just .197 against Greg Maddux during his Cy Young Award-winning 1995 season.

2018 Recap

- A** Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/25, and started vs. Cincinnati in his last turn...Allowed one hit and one run over 5.0 innings.
- A** Missed seven games with right triceps tightness.
- A** Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, 6/12 vs. NYM, allowing just two hits while fanning six.
- A** Threw a season-low 73 pitches before exiting the game with right triceps tightness...Was placed on the 10-day disabled list, 6/16.
- A** Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. WSH...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
- A** Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A** Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
- A** According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th game.
- A** Went 5.0 innings and allowed three hits and one unearned run, 5/15 vs. CHI...Walked a season-most five, and struck out a season-most 10.
- A** Was the fourth double-digit strikeout game of his career, and has since tossed one more...Since he joined Atlanta in 2015, his five 10+ strikeout games are most on the pitching staff.
- A** Earned his third win of the season, 5/10 at MIA, after tossing 5.0 innings and allowing just three hits and one unearned run.
- A** Received eight runs of support, his most on the season and his most since also getting eight runs on 6/7/17...Entered his start against Miami averaging just 2.83 runs of support per 9.0 innings over his last 14 turns, fewest in the N.L.
- A** Allowed a season-most nine hits and six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/4 vs. SF...All six runs he allowed came in the second inning.
- A** The outing snapped a 10-start stretch in which he allowed three earned runs or fewer, the longest such stretch of his career...Went 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA during the run, which started 8/27/17...Was one of just five starters in the majors to have as long a streak of three earned runs or fewer in that span, and was the only one with a losing record -- the other four pitchers went a combined 40-5.
- A** Held the Nationals to four hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/4 at SunTrust Park...Walked two and fanned eight to earn his first win of the season and snap a career-worst seven-game losing streak.
- A** Went 0-7 with a 7.34 ERA (31 ER/38.0 IP) over the spell, the longest losing streak of his career and tied for the second longest active streak in the majors at the time...The run dated to 8/11/17 at STL and spanned eight total starts.
- A** Took a no-decision in his season debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed five hits and three runs over 5.0 innings, striking out seven.
- A** The no-decision snapped of streak of seven consecutive losses after he dropped each of his final seven starts of 2017...His skid in consecutive starts was one short of the franchise record, set by Preston Hanna from 1976-1978 and matched by Shelby Miller in 2015.

- A** Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 2 **1st Batter/Retired:** 24/17 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 5/3

- Over his last 14 appearances, has a 2.00 ERA (4 ER/18.0 IP) with a .136 (8-for-59) opponents' average.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL, and has holds in two of his last three outings...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just six hits in 65 at-bats (.092) against him...Lefties are hitting .361/.452/.694 with 13 hits, five walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- In three extra-inning outings this season, has tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with two hits and 11 strikeouts.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 34/21 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/3

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one.
- Is one of six relievers in the majors with at least four wins and 10 holds.
- His 2.38 ERA (11 ER/41.2 IP) is the sixth lowest by a qualified rookie reliever in Atlanta franchise history.
- Holding batters to a .167 (12-for-72) average with men on base and has allowed just five hits (5-for-43, .167) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .266 (21-for-79) with no one on base.
- Has a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP) in his last nine appearances dating to 6/2 vs. WSH...Had an 11.25 ERA over a four-game stretch, 5/21-30, after pitching to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season.
- Stranded the only runner he inherited, 6/12 vs. SD...Has stranded 12 of the 15 runners he has inherited this season.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 31 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/3 **Holds:** 6 **1st Batter/Retired:** 40/26 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 29/8

- Is 1-3 with an 7.80 ERA (13 ER/15.0 IP) in his last 16 appearances...Surrendered 15 hits during the spell, including a pair of home runs, and has allowed at least one run in eight of those outings.
- Has a 8.49 ERA (11 ER/11.2 IP) in 12 games in June.
- Fanned a career high-tying four batters in 2.1 innings, 6/19 at TOR, to earn his second win
- Left-handed batters are hitting just 9-for-47 (.191) against him.
- Has inherited 29 runners on the season, and has stranded 21 (73%)...His 29 inherited runners are tied for third most in the National League...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 9/7 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 2/0

- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Is 1-0 with a 3.48 ERA (4 ER/10.1 IP) in nine relief appearances with Atlanta this season...Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Has fanned 13 batters in his 10.1 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 47 batters in 31.2 combined innings (13.4 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett...Did not allow an earned run in his last 16.0 innings with GWN, while holding the opposition to a .098 batting average (dating to 4/30).

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 37/24 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Has pitched to a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) over his last 13 games, allowing opponents to hit just .128 (5-for-39)...Has recorded 14 of the 37 outs via strikeout during this stretch, and has walked just one.
- Has not blown a lead this season...Is a perfect 11-for-11 in hold chances and has converted both of his save opportunities.
