FISH BITES

The Marlins concludes its 25th Anniversary Weekend with the finale of this three-game set against the San Diego Padres this afternoon at 1:10 p.m. Miami is starting RHP **José Ureña**, who is making his team-leading 14th start of the season and second against San Diego. In three career starts against San Diego, he has gone 0-2 with a 3.24 ERA (16.2 ip/6 er). The Padres are countering with LHP Clayton Richard, who in seven previous starts against the Marlins has gone 3-2 with a 2.76 ERA (45.2/14). Miami returned home Sunday after going 3-7 on a 10-game road trip to San Diego (1-3), Arizona (0-3) and St. Louis (2-1). The current homestand will continue with a four-game series against another NL West entry, the San Francisco Giants, tomorrow-Thursday. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

Miami fell behind by three runs early, but came back to tie the game in the middle innings before dropping a 5-4 decision to the San Diego Padres. After the Friars plated three runs in the first, it took the Marlins a couple innings to get going, eventually scoring their first run in the third on a **Derek Dietrich** single. San Diego answered back with a solo tally of their own in the fourth to retake the three run lead prior to Miami evening the score with a three-run sixth. In the inning, Dietrich led off with his eighth home run of the year, and the other two runs scored on a wild pitch and an error, respectively. Dietrich and **Brian Anderson** both recorded two-hit efforts, with Anderson extending his hitting streak to seven games. **Dan Straily**, who did not receive a decision, started for Miami and surrendered four runs on nine hits while walking none and striking out four over 3.2 innings.

VS. SAN DIEGO

These two teams are meeting for the second time in a week, as the Marlins dropped three of four in San Diego from May 28-31. The Marlins have gone 91-99 all-time against the Padres, including a 48-51 mark in South Florida, and are 13-8 at Marlins Park. Miami had a four-game home win streak against San Diego snapped last night, and have won six of the last nine here at Marlins Park.

UP NEXT

Miami opens a four-game series against the San Francisco Giants beginning tomorrow night at 7:10 p.m. The Marlins took the 2017 season series, 5-1, sweeping a three-game series at AT&T Park from July 7-9, and taking two of three at Marlins Park from August 14-16. Miami has gone 10-9 against the Giants at Marlins Park since 2012, and own a 41-51 mark all-time in South Florida. The all-time series is in favor of San Francisco, 106-81.

THE FIRST IS THE HARDEST

José Ureña earned his first win of the season in his last start, June 5 at St. Louis. The win snapped a 14-game stretch where the Marlins were winless when he started. The 14-game streak without a team win was the longest in Franchise history, as he passed Brian Moehler's stretch of 12 straight starts without a win from July 26, 2005-April 28, 2006. In addition, he snapped a seven-game slide to open the season, which was tied the longest such streak in Franchise history, equaling that of Joe Fontenot in 1998 and Edinson Volquez in 2017.

HOT TICKET

With two more hits last night, **Brian Anderson** recorded his fifth multi-hit game in his last seven games played. Since April 20, he has hit .335 (59x176) with 18 multi-hit games. His average in that span ranks sixth in the NL, behind league-leader Scooter Gennett (.372; 61x164). He has hit safely in each of his last seven games to tie a career-long (also March 29-April 5), and has hit .500 (14x28) with three doubles, a triple, one home run and six RBI over the streak.

SPRINT FOR FIRST

Since the start of 2016, the Marlins have scored first in 56.5% of their home games (108/191), marking the third-highest percentage in the Majors in that span behind Cleveland (57.1%) and San Francisco (56.7).

ANTI-THEFT DEVICE

On April 5 at Philadelphia, the Phillies successfully stole three bases against **Bryan Holaday** before he caught César Hernández trying to steal third. Since then, Holaday has thrown out eight consecutive attempted base stealers, including one Thursday, marking the longest catcher caught stealing streak in Club history and is tied for the longest streak in the Majors this season (Salvador Perez). The previous record had been held by Benito Santiago, who caught seven straight in 1994. The last Major League player to record a streak as long or longer than Holaday's was Arizona's Miguel Montero, who cut down nine straight in August 2011. - **Stats LLC**

LOCKED DOWN

Marlins catchers have combined to throw out 18 runners this season, marking the most in the Majors (Oakland-17). The Marlins 51.2 caught stealing percentage leads MLB, ahead of Washington (45.8) and Kansas City (38.2). Since 2016, Miami owns the fourth-best caught stealing percentage (35.4) in the Majors, behind Cleveland (36.2), Boston (35.6), and the Angels (35.6).

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 64 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, batting average (.307), at-bats (241), runs (33), hits (74), multi-hit games (22), and on-base percentage (.379); ranks second in walks (23), doubles (16), RBI (30), and slugging percentage (.427); and is tied for third in triples (2).

- Leads all National League players 25-younger in hits, in front of Ozzie Albies (70).
- Is on pace to record 113 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie and would be the third-most by any Major League rookie since 2000 (Ichiro-133 in 2001; Hideki Matsui-114 in 2003). Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 46 first-half RBI, which would rank as the fourth-most by a Marlins rookie, behind Dan Uggla (51 in 2006), Bruce Aven (47 in 1999), and Mike Jacobs (47 in 2006).

- José Ureña will make his 14th start of the season today when the Marlins close out their 25th Anniversary Weekend with the finale of this three-game set against the Padres.
- Picked up his first win of the season in his last start, on June 5 at St. Louis. It snapped a skid of 14 consecutive team losses in his starts, dating back to September 26, 2017, the longest streak in Club history.
- Picked up the win despite allowing a season-high 10 hits, and surrendering four runs. Benefitted from seven runs of support while he was in the game, the most he has received this season and just the second game with five-or-more (five on April 21 at Milwaukee).
- Opened 2018 with 5.88 ERA (26.0 ip/17 er) over his first five starts. In his eight starts since then, he has posted a 3.91 ERA (48.1/21), allowing three-or-fewer runs five times.
- His average of 3.51 runs of support during his starts ranks as 3rd-lowest among NL starters (min. 13 GS), better only than teammate Caleb Smith (3.15) and Alex Wood (3.39).
- Today will mark his fourth career start against the Padres. He is 0-2 despite a 3.24 ERA (16.2/6), and allowing just one run in each of his last two starts against them (over 5.2 innings on August 27, 2016 at home, and over 6.0 innings on May 30 this season at Petco).
- Left in line for win on April 21 vs. Milwaukee, but ended up with no decision after Brewers scored two late runs. Allowed four runs on four hits and two walks, while striking out three, over 5.0 innings.

- On April 3, held Boston to one run on four hits over 7.0 innings. Walked one while striking out a career high-tying seven. It was third career seven-strikeout game; added a fourth in his start on May 25 vs. Washington.
- Earned Opening Day start against Cubs on March 29 at Marlins Park. Was seventh different OD starter in last seven openers for Miami. Took loss, allowing five runs on six hits over 4.0 innings. Hit three batters in first inning, becoming only second Marlins pitcher to ever tally three HBP in a single inning (Sergio Mitre on Aug. 31, 2007 vs. PHI).
- Posted team-high 14 wins last season, to go with 3.82 ERA (169.2/72) and 113 strikeouts in 34 appearances (28 starts). Established career highs in wins, appearances, innings pitched, strikeouts, and ERA.
- Finished season 14-7, 3.97 (154.1/68) as starter. Did not factor in a decision and had a 2.35 ERA (15.1/4) in six relief appearances.
- Went 6-1 with 2.40 ERA (63.2/17) in 11 day-game starts. Owned fourth lowest ERA among NL starters (min. 50.0 IP), behind Max Scherzer (1.90), Stephen Strasburg (2.06) and Jimmy Nelson (2.32). - *Stats LLC*
- From May 7 through end of season, led National League with 28 starts, and 14 wins in that time tied Zack Greinke and Alex Wood for second, behind only Zach Davies (15). Among NL pitchers who made at least 25 starts in that time, average against (.232) ranked sixth and ERA ranked 10th.
- Set career high with five-game winning streak over seven starts from May 23 to June 23. Did so despite posting a 4.58 ERA (37.1/19) in that time, as he received 7.47 runs of support during stretch.
- Tossed season-high 8.0 innings in loss on July 31 vs. Washington, and again in win on Sept. 20 vs. the Mets. Allowed just one run to Nats, and two to New York. Became first Marlins' pitcher since Henderson Alvarez (4), José Fernández (2), and Nathan Eovaldi (2) in 2014 to have multiple starts with 8.0-plus innings and two-or-fewer runs allowed in a single season.

- Wei-Yin Chen tomorrow will make his ninth start of the season since coming off the 10-day disabled list on April 28. Began season on DL (left elbow strain).
- Made two rehab appearances at Single-A Jupiter, allowing just one run over 7.2 innings, with just one walk and 11 strikeouts. In first appearance, April 17 vs. Lakeland, allowed one run and three hits over 2.2 innings. In second start, April 22 vs. St. Lucie, tossed two-hit, 5.0-inning complete game. Struck out seven without issuing a walk, tossing total of 73 pitches (60 strikes).
- Will be just second career start vs. San Francisco. The first came with Baltimore on August 10, 2013 at AT&T Park. He took a loss after allowing three runs on five hits and an intentional walk over 6.0 innings, with two strikeouts.
- Made his first start of season on April 28 vs. Colorado, earning a win after allowing just one run on four hits (one home run), two walks, and a hit batter over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts. In his next two starts, went 0-2 with 16.71 ERA (7.0 ip/13 er), and an average against of .400 (12x30) with 10 extra-base hits (4 2B, 3B, 5 HR, 1.100 SLG).
- Bounced back in next three starts despite not factoring in a decision (team 1-2), combining for 1.59 ERA (17.0/3) with a .180 average against (11x61) and two extra-base hits allowed (2B, HR). Walked six (1 IBB) and struck out 14 in that time. Was in line for the win on May 20 at Atlanta, before bullpen surrendered six runs in ninth inning for a 10-9 walk-off loss.
- Has allowed two-or-fewer runs in four of his last five starts, posting a 3.52 ERA (23.0/9), but is just 0-1 in that time. Has struck out 20 and walked 10 over that span.
