TRIBE TOP THREE

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** collected another two extra-base hits last night in a 3-for-5 effort...he is batting .358 (19-53) in the month of May with eight doubles (T1st in MLB) and 14 extra-base hits overall (also T1st).
» **TREVOR BAUER** takes the hill this afternoon...Bauer won his previous start against Detroit on April 12 (7.0IP, 7H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 7K)...both of his wins this season have also come in series finales, where he is 2-0 with a 2.41 ERA (5ER/18.2IP) in three prior outings.
» The Indians are set to face a left-handed starting pitcher for the 16th time this season...they own an 8-7 record in their 15 previous games against lefty starters...Cleveland's 73 runs scored this season vs. left-handed pitching are the most in the Majors, while their .264 batting average ranks 7th.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Tribe offense collected 13 hits and jumped out to an 8-3 lead but ultimately fell, 9-8, in the middle contest of this three-game set at Detroit.
» **BRANDON GUYER** opened the scoring with a grand slam in the 1st inning, the fourth by a Tribe batter this season...**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** and **RAJAI DAVIS** had three hits each, and both batters doubled in runs during the Indians' three-run 6th inning...**ERIK GONZÁLEZ** homered in the top of the 2nd inning for his first long-ball of the season...**FRANCISCO LINDOR** drew a career-high four walks, but went 0-for-1 overall as his hit streak came to an end at 15 games.
» **JOSH TOMLIN** pitched into the 6th inning but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on six hits (OBB, 4K) over 5.1 innings of work and departing with an 8-4 lead...**ANDREW MILLER** suffered his second loss of the season after issuing a go-ahead walk with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 7th inning.

TIGER TALK

» The Indians and Tigers will conclude the second of six series between the clubs today...the teams will next face each other from June 8-10, in another set at Comerica Park.
» Cleveland enters play tonight with a 4-2 record this season against the Tigers...the teams previously met from April 9-12 at Progressive Field, where the Indians recorded a four-game sweep.
» The Tribe's back-to-back losses vs. Detroit come on the heels of an 11-game win streak against the Tigers which extended back to September 1, 2017...since the start of 2016, the Tribe has still gone 31-12 (.721) against the Tigers, including a separate 11-game win streak from April 22 - July 5, 2016.
» Even with the consecutive losses, Cleveland has held the Tigers to three-or-fewer runs in 13 of their last 16 matchups with a 2.09 team ERA (33ER/142.0IP) over that span.

CENTRAL HEATING

» The Tribe is set to wrap its fifth series against a divisional opponent this afternoon, having gone 9-5 in their first 14 games against the A.L. Central (8-2 at Progressive Field, 1-3 on the road).
» Last night's loss ensured that the Indians will lose their first series against a divisional opponent since being swept from June 23-25, 2017 vs. Minnesota...Cleveland now has a 15-1-1 record in its last 17 series against A.L. Central opponents, including an outright 14-series win streak against intradivisional opponents from July 1, 2017 - April 12, 2018, the longest by any team in MLB's divisional era (1969-, STATS LLC).
» **Since July 1, 2017, the Indians have posted a 40-13 record (.755) overall against A.L. Central teams.**

HANDY MAN

» **ERIK GONZÁLEZ** went 1-for-2 last night in a start at first base, hitting his first home run of the 2018 campaign with a solo shot in the top of the 2nd inning.
» González has thrived in a utility role for Cleveland this season, batting .367 (11-30) with a homer, three doubles, a triple and six RBI in 20 games (seven starts).
» González is also one of just seven players in Major League Baseball (five in American League) who have appeared in at least one game at all four infield positions...his .367 average is over 90 points higher than any of the other six players.

JOSÉ CAN YOU SWING

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** put together another impressive offensive performance in last night's ballgame, going 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles and an RBI...marked his seventh three-hit effort of the season, tied with Francisco Lindor for the team lead and T2nd in MLB.
» Ramírez did not record his first double of 2018 until April 23 at Baltimore, but his 13 two-baggers in the past 23 days are the most in MLB over that span.
» His eight doubles in May are tied for the MLB lead with **Lindor**, while his 14 extra-base hits and six homers rank 2nd and T5th, respectively...both of those categories are also currently led by **Lindor**...overall on the season, Ramírez also ranks T11th in the A.L. in runs scored (28), T4th in total bases (99), 5th in slugging percentage (.627) and T2nd in extra-base hits (26).

REQUIEM FOR A STREAK

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** saw his career-long 15-game hit streak come to an end last night as he went 0-for-1 in five plate appearances...marked the longest hit streak by an Indians batter since **Mike Napoli's** 16-game streak from July 30 - August 16, 2016, and the longest streak by a Tribe shortstop since **Omar Vizquel's** 18-game run from July 14 - August 1, 2002.
» Lindor drew a career-high four walks last night, the most by a Tribe batter this season and the most since Carlos Santana also had four on July 29, 2017 at Chicago-AL.
» Lindor is batting .443 (27-61) in 14 May games, ranking 1st in the A.L. (2nd in MLB) in batting average (min. 40 PA)...also holds the MLB monthly lead in homers (8), extra-base hits (16), doubles (8, T1st) and times on base (35).
» Enters play today in the American League's Top 10 in several categories, including multi-hit games (17, T2nd), extra-base hits (26, T2nd), homers (12, T5th), runs scored (35, 2nd), hits (54, T4th), total bases (104, 3rd), doubles (14, 4th), slugging percentage (.608, 6th) and batting average (.316, T10th).

HE'S A GRAND OLE GUY

» **BRANDON GUYER** sparked the Tribe offense last night with a grand slam in the top of the 1st inning off **Francisco Liriano**, the first of his Major League career.
» Marked the fourth grand slam by an Indians batter this season, following **YONDER ALONSO's** on March 31 at Seattle and a pair by **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (May 1 vs. TEX & May 11 vs. KC)...Cleveland is tied with Toronto for the 2nd-most grand slams in MLB this season, trailing only Boston (6).
» The Indians already sit just one grand slam shy of their total of five last season...marks the Tribe's quickest ascent (41 games) to four grand slams since the 2006 campaign, when **Travis Hafner** hit the club's fourth in their 40th game.
» The grand slam gave Goyer three homers on the season in just 75 at-bats...he had hit two longballs for Cleveland in both 2016 (81 AB) and 2017 (165 AB).

TAKE A BAUER

» **TREVOR BAUER** will take the hill this afternoon to make his 9th start of the 2018 season.
» Took a no-decision in his most recent start, which came on May 11 vs. Kansas City...allwed five runs (four earned) on 11 hits over 4.2 innings (2BB, 3K) in the Tribe's eventual 10-9 loss.
» Has made one previous start against Detroit in 2018, earning the win on April 12 at Progressive Field after holding the Tigers to two runs on seven hits over 7.0 strong innings (2BB, 7K)...owns a career record of 5-5 with a 7.26 ERA (53ER/65.2IP) in 12 career starts (13 appearances) against the Tigers.
» Today will also mark Bauer's fourth start this season in a series finale, where he has accumulated a 2-0 record with a 2.41 ERA (5ER/18.2IP).

LEFTY LOOSEY

» The Indians are set to face a left-handed starting pitcher for the 16th time this season, entering play today with an 8-7 overall record against lefties.
» **Cleveland has batted .264 (7th in MLB) and scored 73 runs against left-handed pitching this season, the most in MLB.**
