**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Mets finish a two-game set today with the 12th meeting between the clubs this season...These two games mark the Mets' final trip to Atlanta this season; the Braves will travel to New York for four games, August 2-5 and then for three games, September 25-27.

**A** The Braves have won eight of their first 11 games with the Mets this season, outscoring New York 65-37...They won seven games against the Mets all of last season.

**A** Rookie RHP Mike Soroka is set for his second start against the Mets and his first start overall since going to the 10-day disabled list on May 17, retroactive May 14, with a right shoulder strain... Soroka beat the Mets with 6.0 innings in his MLB debut on May 1 at Citi Field.

**A** RHP Jacob deGrom is set for his fourth start against the Braves this season...The righty has allowed just one run over 18.0 innings (0.50 ERA) against the Braves so far this season, but has no decisions...For his career, deGrom owns a 1.84 ERA (18 ER/88.0 IP) in 14 games against Atlanta.

**GRAND SLAM:** 2B Ozzie Albies hit a 1-1, sixth-inning pitch out to right field last night for his second career grand slam (also, May 10 at Miami off Drew Steckenrider)...Albies became the first Braves player with multiple grand slams in a season since 2012, when Brian McCann also had two.

**A** Albies is just the second second baseman in Atlanta franchise history with two grand slams in a season, joining Davey Johnson, who had two in 1973...

**A** He became the first player 21-years-old or younger to hit multiple grand slams in a season since 2000, when Adrián Beltré hit two for Los Angeles (NL).

**A** Since the end of World War II, seven other players hit multiple grand slams in a season at 21 or younger: Mickey Mantle (1952), Faye Throneberry (1952), Eddie Mathews (1953), Tony Conigliaro (1965), Ken Griffey Jr. (1991), Alex Rodríguez (1996) and Beltre (2000).

**VS. THE N.L. EAST:** The Braves are 26-14 (.650) against the N.L. East this season, and the club's 40 games against division rivals are the most interdivision games any MLB team has played so far this season.

**A** The Braves are 5-2 against Miami, 8-3 against New York, 7-5 against Philadelphia and 6-4 against Washington.

**A** Following this two-game set with the Mets, the Braves will play 27 games outside the division... They make return to N.L. East play with the first series out of the All-Star break, a three-game set in Washington, July 20-July 22.

**A** The Braves went 33-43 against the division last season and have not had a winning record against the East since 2014 (40-36).

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves returned RHP Mike Soroka from his rehabilitation assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day disabled list...In order to make room on the active roster, the club designated RHP Luke Jackson for assignment.

**A** Soroka missed 24 games with a right shoulder strain.

**FREEMAN:** 1B Freddie Freeman finished 1-for-2 with two walks and a home run last night, and has now hit safely in 22 of his last 23 games, dating to May 19... Freeman is hitting .380 (35-for-92) over the stretch, with a .620 slugging percentage and a .441 on-base percentage.

**A** Freeman leads the league with a .341 batting average, a .434 on-base percentage and a .579 slugging percentage.

**STOLEN BASES:** OF Ender Inciarte swiped two bases last night and now leads the majors with 20 steals this season...The Braves rank third in the National League with 42 stolen bases.

**A** Inciarte is just the ninth Braves player in Atlanta franchise history to reach 20 steals prior to the All-Star break and the first since Michael Bourn had 25 in 2012.

**A** Inciarte is two steals shy of his career-high total set last season.

**AT SUNTRUST:** Since losing a season-high four consecutive home games, May 4-May 15, the Braves have gone 9-4 in Atlanta, while compiling a 3.02 ERA (41 ER/122.0 IP).

**A** The Braves can improve to 7-1-2 in home series play with a win today...Their only loss was a three-game sweep by San Francisco, May 4-May 6.

**A** The Braves are averaging a N.L.-high 5.17 runs per game at home this season, while holding the opposition to 4.14 runs.

**A** The Braves have allowed 0.83 homers per home game this season, the second fewest in the majors... Only San Francisco at 0.67 is better.

**A** The Braves will play 11 of their next 13 games in Atlanta.

**RISP:** The Braves went 4-for-12 (.333) with runners in scoring position last night, and are leading the majors with a .288 (159-for-553) batting average in such situations...The club's .505 slugging percentage and .377 on-base percentage in these situations is also tops in baseball.

**A** 1B Freddie Freeman leads the majors with a .446 batting average with runners in scoring position, while SS Dansby Swanson ranks seventh in the National League with a .341 average.

**A** In these situations with two outs, Freeman has a N.L.-leading .600 on-base percentage.

#### Today's Game

- A Returned from his rehabilitation assignment to Triple-A Gwinnett and activated off the 10-day disabled list today.
- A Missed 24 games with a right shoulder strain...Was placed on the disabled list on 5/17.
- A Made a pair of rehabilitation starts, including one game each with Single-A Rome (6/1 vs. Columbia) and Triple-A Gwinnett (6/6 vs. Lehigh Valley)... Combined to allow three hits and one run with 10 strikeouts over 8.0 innings.
- A Set for the fourth start of his major league career...Made his major league debut, 5/1 at NYM.
- A Is the youngest pitcher in the majors at 20 years, 313 days.
- A Faces the Mets for the second time in his career...Beat New York, 3-2, in his major league debut, 5/1 at Citi Field.
- A Won his debut at the age of 20 years, 270 days, becoming the youngest Braves pitcher to win his debut since LHP Charlie Vaughan beat Houston in game one of a doubleheader on September 3, 1966.
- A At the time of his debut, the Mets were leading the N.L. East...The last time a pitcher as young as Soroka won his major league debut against a team in first place at the time was 1997, when the Dodgers' Denny Reyes beat the San Francisco Giants on 7/13...Reyes was 20 years, 85 days at the time, while the Giants were 52-39 and leading the NL West by four games over the Dodgers.
- A Became the eighth Braves pitcher to start against the Mets in his major league debut...The eight starters, including Hall-of-Famer John Smoltz on 7/23/88, have combined to go 5-2 with a 1.95 ERA (11 ER/50.2 IP).
- A Entered the 2018 season tabbed by Baseball America and MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 3 prospect...MLB.com named him as the No. 27 prospect overall in the minors.

#### 2018 Recap

- A Went 4.1 innings in his final rehab start, 6/6 vs. Lehigh Valley while with Gwinnett... Took his first minor-league loss of the season after allowing three hits and one run in 4.1 innings...Threw 73 pitches, including 52 strikes, while fanning seven.
- A Tossed 45 pitches in his first rehab turn, 6/1 vs. Columbia with Single-A... Completed 3.2 perfect innings.
- A Struck out a career-best seven in his last start with Atlanta, 5/12 at MIA...Allowed eight hits and five runs (one earned) in 4.2 innings.
- A Made his first career start at SunTrust Park, 5/6 vs. SF...Allowed seven hits and four runs over 4.0 innings to take the first loss of his career.
- A Beat the New York Mets in his major league debut, 5/1 at Citi Field...Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball and allowed six hits with five strikeouts.
- A Needed just 80 pitches to complete his 6.0 innings, becoming just the second Braves pitcher to go that long in as few pitches during his major league debut... RHP Ryan Weber went 6.0 innings in 74 pitches on September 8, 2015.
- A Made his major league debut at the age of 20 years, 270 days...Became the youngest pitcher to make his debut in a start for Atlanta since RH Julio Teheran debuted at 20 years, 100 days on 5/7/11.
- A Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only five starting pitchers have debuted at a younger age than Soroka - LH Charlie Vaughan (18 years, 332 days - 9/3/66), LH Mike McQueen (19 years, 033 days - 10/2/69), LH Steve Avery (20 years, 060 days - 6/13/90), Teheran and RH Al Santorini (20 years, 114 days - 9/10/68).
- A Went 2-0 with a 1.99 ERA (5 ER/22.2 IP) in four starts for Triple-A Gwinnett prior to his contract selection...Opponents batted just .207 (17-for-82).
- A Tossed the first minor-league shutout of his career, 4/23 at Rochester...Allowed just six total baserunners and fanned four over 7.0 innings in the first game of a doubleheader.
- A The effort was the second career complete game for Soroka and his first since also going 7.0 innings in a doubleheader on 6/28/16 while with Single-A Rome.
- A Soroka's shutout was the first of any length in the International League this season.
- A Allowed season highs in hits (6) and runs (3) over 5.0 innings on 4/17 vs. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre...Left the game trailing 3-0 before Gwinnett scored eight unanswered runs to win 8-3.
- A Named Gwinnett's Opening Day starter and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings on 4/6 at Norfolk...Yielded just three hits and one walk while striking out five.
- A Became the youngest Opening Day starter in the 10-year history of Gwinnett's franchise...Soroka (20 years, 8 months, 2 days) was nearly two years younger than the previous youngest, RHP Tommy Hanson (22 years, 7 months, 12 days), who pitched the inaugural game in Gwinnett history, 4/9/09.

- A Selected by Atlanta with the 28th overall pick in the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.
- A Is 22-20 with a 2.81 ERA (113 ER/361.1 IP) over 67 career minor league games, including 65 total starts.

**Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63**

**Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 19/13 Inherited Runners/Scored: 4/3**

- Right-handed batter has just five hits in 51 at-bats (.098) against him...Lefties are hitting .419/.500/.806 with 13 hits, four walks, three doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.
- Blew the first save of his career, 6/12 vs. NYM, after allowing two runs (one earned) in 0.1 innings.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
- Five of his 19 appearances this season have gone at least 2.0 innings, most among Braves relievers.
- Made his MLB debut, 4/21 vs. NYM with 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first ATL reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley, 9/3/16 at PHI.

**Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51**

**Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 8 1st Batter/Retired: 28/18 Inherited Runners/Scored: 14/3**

- Has allowed six earned runs on nine hits and four walks in his last eight appearances (7.2 IP) dating to 5/21 at PHI...Made 14 consecutive appearances totaling 15.1 innings without allowing a run just ahead of his recent skid, and in his first 26.0 innings of the season, 3/30-5/19, allowed just two earned runs.
- Inherited a pair of runners and stranded them both, 6/12 vs. NYM...Has stranded 11 of the 14 runners he has inherited this season.
- Holding batters to a .161 (9-for-55) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-32, .094) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .273 (18-for-66) with no one on base.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .232 (16-for-69) average...Lefties are hitting .208 (11-for-53).

**Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39**

**Saves/Opp: 0/2 Holds: 5 1st Batter/Retired: 33/22 Inherited Runners/Scored: 26/6**

- After making 28 appearances (22.1 IP) to open the season without allowing a home run, has given up two in his last five outings (4.1 IP).
- Blew his second save, 6/2 vs. WSH, after allowing a leadoff homer to lefty Juan Soto...Left-handed batters are hitting just 6-for-37 (.162) against him, but each of his two home runs allowed have come off lefties.
- Ranks tied for eighth in the majors with 33 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Has inherited 26 runners on the season, and has stranded 20 (77%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

**Luiz Gohara • LHP • 6-3 • 265 • 21 yrs • #53**

**Saves/Opp: 1/1 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 5/3 Inherited Runners/Scored: 2/1**

- Allowed a career high-matching six runs (all earned) in just 0.2 of an inning last Monday, 6/4 at SD...Prior to that outing, had allowed just one run and four total base runners over 7.0 IP (1.29 ERA) spanning three relief app.
- His appearance on 6/4 at SD was his first since 5/23 at PHI in a 4.0-inning start...Reinstated from the Restricted List on 6/3...Was originally placed on the Bereavement/Family Medical Emergency List on 5/25.
- Earned his first professional save in his season debut (3.0 IP, 1 R/ER), 5/10 at MIA.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 5/8, for his first appearance on the active roster this season...Opened the season on Atlanta's disabled list (left ankle sprain), before being returned from his rehab and optioned to Gwinnett on 4/27.
- Made four starts between Mississippi (AA) and Gwinnett (AAA)...Went 0-3 with a 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP).
